NEW HOME Fox Run Golf Links, seen here in summer dress, recently opened a new clubhouse.

Several courses stayed open later than expected with snow missing from the winter menu until late December. One was Fox Run Golf Links in Elk Grove Village, where the muni has opened a new clubhouse and was getting boffo business with the white stuff absent.

Cog Hill always has a course open, and hosted the 59th Eskimo Open on Sunday, Jan. 2.

SHACK OPENS: The Shack Indoor Golf Club in Glenview, with four simulators and a restaurant and bar under one roof, opened on Ryder Cup weekend. Players can select from over 100 courses that will pop up on the big screens, with all the electronic distance-measuring trimmings. It should be a big hit in the northern suburbs, which doesn't have a lot of indoor golf beyond the domes in Buffalo Grove and Highland Park. (The largest spot remains the Indoor Golf Links of America in Orland Park, with 14 simulators.)

TECH TALK: The Bridges of Poplar Creek in Hoffman Estates has added Toptracer technology to its practice center. The high-tech tracker is available in the 10 indoor-outdoor hitting bays. There are also heaters, so one can get down to shirtsleeves, or at least a

sweater, on cold days.

ON THE BLOCK: Recent listings of courses for sale include Red Hawk in downstate Tamaroa, offered at \$900,000 for 18 holes on 150 acres. It's west of Interstate 57 between Mount Vernon and Marion. ... Or you can pick up the D-Lux Budget Inn, a 24-room motel down Archer Ave. from Cog Hill, for a cool \$1.5 million, owner's suite included. ... The new owners of Balmoral Park Race Track bought Balmoral Woods, the 18-holer across Route 394, in the package deal and plan to keep it open while revitalizing the race track..

SHOW A NO-GO: The plan was for the Chicago Golf Show, canceled in 2021 because of COVID-19, to return in 2022. Corcoran Expositions blocked out Feb. 25-27 at the Stephens Convention Center in Rosemont. But booth sales, the lifeblood of the operation, stalled at less than 75, and the show was called off.

RADIO STAPLE SHIFTS: Saturday's gabfest on WSCR (670) is moving to WMVP (1000) effective April 3, 7-9 a.m., with **Barry Cronin** staying the co-host. The CDGA, whose glossy *Chicago District Golfer* magazine Cronin helms, is the presenting sponsor.

A line drawn in the sand (trap), sort of

The most interesting contest in golf, and with the highest stakes, is going on right now, hidden in plain sight.

It's the showdown between Greg Norman, the front man for a band of suddenly golf-crazy oil sheiks from Saudi Arabia, and Jay Monahan, commissioner of the PGA Tour.

It was, at least, until Phil Mickelson opened his mouth, saying his interest was in pressuring the PGA Tour to turn over the rights to video of his accomplishments. In so doing, Mickelson noted the Saudi government were killers, called them a name we won't print, ripped his home tour, and effectively sabotaged both his reputation and, at least for the moment, the second attempt at Norman's conquest of big-time golf.

The stakes: What the top tier of professional golf will look like in the future, and who runs it. Especially who runs it.

Now it's more like what might have been, part 2, for Norman.

Back in 1994, Norman, Australian-born and worldly in his outlook, came up with an idea for a global tour, with big-money tournaments scattered about the planet, connected by big-money purses and the stars playing for them. He got Fox Sports to back a quest to start an eight-tournament series called the World Golf Tour, scheduled to lead into the majors. The top 30 available players from the world ranking would play.

Tim Finchem, the then-new PGA Tour commissioner, was not amused. It would take

players from the American circuit and hurt its tournaments, reducing them to second-tier status. Finchem threatened to suspend anyone playing in a Norman-backed tournament, and a few months after firing that salvo, came up with the World Golf Championships, effectively heisting Norman's idea and putting it under the aegis of the PGA Tour and the other majors tours worldwide. Norman was on the outside looking in.

So here we went again, only this time, Norman having Saudi Arabia oil money behind him. The Saudis kicked in \$300 million to goose the fortunes of the Asian Tour, plus wooed a slew of stars to the Saudi International, played the same week as Pebble Beach's annual clambake.

Monahan has threatened to suspend any player who joins Norman's larger series, which would involve guaranteed money for 48 players in return for guaranteed appearances – and \$20 million purses on top of the guarantees – should it take off. Myriad legal questions come up if an independent contractor is banned. If the majors get involved, the legal issues get even stickier.

At the same time, Monahan allowed those

who have signed up for the Saudi sandbox to play, providing they drop by Pebble Beach once or twice, depending on how often they've played there in the past, in the next couple of years.

This is known as buying time. Norman's first tour never flew thanks to Finchem's threat. Bluster of bans aside, Monahan has a lot to figure out. So does Keith Pelley, his counterpart at the DP World (nee European) Tour.

Many in golf have harrumphed about the new tour's funding, noting Saudi Arabia's execrable human rights record. The guess here is most everyone doing the harrumphing still fills their gas tanks. In the U.S., 8 percent of imported oil is Saudi Arabian. (It's 7.7 percent in Europe.) To now protest that golfers will fill their pockets from the same well is a bit of a stretch.

The Saudis could finance a golf tour from now to forever if they cared to. They've hosted two Formula 1 races within four months. Some call this "sportswashing," the idea that playing games will reduce the stain from their real-world exploits. On the contrary, it likely draws more attention to the exploits.

Norman and Co. have found courses, including Rich Harvest Farms – more about that in our next issue – but still need TV arrangements, and most of all, willing players. Threats aside, the latter will be the most difficult part of the equation.

Do the greats want to settle for money in the desert or the prestige of winning majors?

Medinah's \$23.5 million gamble

Renovation of No. 3 could lead to more majors, climb up top 100 rankings

Even with inflation, \$23.5 million can buy a lot of grass seed.

And rental of bulldozers. And tree removal and replacement. And so on, and so on, and so on.

That's what Medinah Country Club has budgeted for the sweeping renovation of its championship course, formally Course No. 3 but at one time called "the monster."

It's not been very monstrous in recent championships held by the big west side club. To the membership, the scores have been, and that's one of the reasons the members voted – nearly 80 percent in favor – on Dec. 18 to tear up the final six holes and replace them with something new.

OCM Golf, an all-Australian trio consisting of Geoff Ogilvy, Mike Cocking and Ashley Mead, came up with a plan to create a half-dozen new holes while reshaping the rest of the course with an Australian Sand Belt look, one reminiscent of Alister MacKenzie, and adding a pitch-and-putt course near the entrance. Construction starts in the fall, and No. 3 will reopen in the spring of 2024, well in advance of the 2026 Presidents Cup.

Of the \$23.5 million price tag, checks will be written to cover \$18.5 million, or a little over \$1 million a hole. The other \$5 million is the lost

revenue from guest fees on No. 3 over the end of 2022 and all of 2023 – a cost that surely will begin to be recouped once the revamped layout opens in 2024.

As Medinah board member Ryan Potts explains it, there was more than a blood-red scoreboard – such as the 11-under 61 posted by Justin Thomas en route to his 25-under 263 in winning the 2019 BMW Championship – that prompted the changes.

"As part of our strategic planning process, we poll our membership as to what is important to them and what we, as stewards of the club, should try to accomplish as part of our strategic plan,"

Potts said. "Our members, for better or worse, we could argue, told us they prioritize hosting championships, would like to host majors and desire to remain in the top 100.

"So, that kicked off the investigative process over two years ago as to how to accomplish those goals as set out in our strategic plan, as that's our responsibility as board members and stewards."

Architects were considered and the OCM trio was brought on – in the COVID-19 era, by Zoom meetings and armed with aerial photos and topographical maps, never setting foot on the property because of travel restrictions – to better the course designed by Tom Bendelow and so often tweaked since much of Bendelow's original work has been plowed under. Now, his most famous hole, the daunting par-3 13th – the critical 17th during the 1949 and 1975 U.S. Opens – will disappear as well.

The members must think it's worth it.

Club president William Kuehn said the plan "encapsulates a continuing vision to provide compelling tournament play and a world-class golf experience for members, guests, and the professional tournament player."

OCM, led by Ogilvy, the 2005 U.S. Open champion, only in 2020 dipped their toes into the American market, renovating Shady Oaks Country Club, the course designed by Ben Hogan in

Fort Worth, Tex. That was high-profile. Medinah is more so, with its history of Opens, PGAs, Western Opens and the 2012 Ryder Cup proudly displayed in the lobby adjacent to the men's locker room. A successful renovation could lead to more majors, and that's what the members want.

"It's a huge sign of confidence that the members are as excited with our concept as we are, and we can't wait to get planning started in 2022," Ogilvy said when the club offered details of the plan. "We feel incredibly humbled and honored."

Any Medinah member will tell you No. 3 is tough enough for them. The luxury of belonging to Medinah is having three courses to choose from. Most members will play No. 1, itself renovated by Tom Doak several years ago, before they tee it up on No. 3. Others will select No. 2, the course that most closely resembles what Bendelow built in the 1920s after a recent restoration by Rees Jones, all the better to not get beat up.

In wider circles, No. 3 is still considered a daunting test. But the scores posted from the 1990 U.S. Open onward show that the best can go under par, and sometimes well under par.

At most clubs, this would be considered the price of hosting. The best players in the world, if they had handicaps, would range up to plus 8. They should take apart par 5s and occasionally run the table, no matter how hard the setup.

However, sometimes those low scores influence those who are on golf course ranking panels. The first modern ranking of American courses was the *Golf Digest* America's Toughest 200, in 1966. Since renamed and renumbered America's Greatest 100, it has since been joined by similar rankings by *Golf Magazine* and *Golfweek*, the now-quarterly which separates courses into pre- and post-1960 layouts.

The most recent rankings have No. 3 sitting 60th in the *Golf Digest* survey (the fourth-best course in Illinois behind No. 13 Chicago Golf, No. 49 Butler National and No. 54 Shoreacres), was unranked in the *Golf Magazine* top 100 poll (Chicago Golf is 14th, Shoreacres 24th), and tied for 76th with Fenway of Scarsdale, N.Y. among *Golfweek*'s classic courses (Chicago Golf is eighth, Shoreacres 19th, Old Elm 59th, Olympia Field North 61st, and Skokie is tied for 90th).

That's well down in the rankings from where Medinah used to be. For instance, No. 3 ranked 11th in *Golf Digest* in May 2007.

Part of it, at least in the *Golf Digest* and *Golf* rankings, is the number of high-quality new courses, from the Bandon Dunes Resort complex to any number of layouts designed by Tom Doak, Bill Coore and Ben Crenshaw, and Gil Hanse in the last 20 years. Those have pushed many classics down the lists, or out, in the case of Medinah and the *Golf* survey.

A high ranking burnishes a club's reputation, and often leads to inquiries for membership along with guests clamoring to get on the course.

However, not every renovation achieves its goal. Witness Cog Hill, where the Jemsek family sank \$5.2 million into a renovation of No. 4 with the hope that the toughest course would gain Cog a U.S. Open. Not only has the USGA not come calling, but the BMW Championship left the premises – though that had more to do with BMW North America's leadership at the time than the fact the pros complained the course was too hard.

Still, not every redo does what's expected. In Medinah's case, eliminating an iconic par 3 is considered the price of doing business given the finish that OCM has concocted. It wows the membership. We'll see if it wows the world.

Jim Nelson finds a calling

Veteran helps fellow vets through PGA Hope program

Jim Nelson caddied at Tam O'Shanter as a kid, which immediately lets one know he's not quite a kid anymore.

"I was like a Z caddie," Nelson said of his first experience at golf.

Today, he's an A – as in ambassador. A long-time player and more recently as a member of the course maintenance crew at Steeple Chase in Mundelein, Nelson was recently named an ambassador for the PGA HOPE program in the Illinois Section.

HOPE stands for Helping Our Patriots Everywhere, and that attracted Nelson, who served in the U.S. Army from 1962 through 1966.

"There are people who ride horses for therapy," said Nelson, who at 78 has the stamina and drive of someone 30 years younger. "This is golf therapy."

For Nelson, golf is a diversion that was long diverted by a busy schedule. His delving into course maintenance after retirement from a career in communications technology – constructing cellular telephone networks at the end of his time with Lucent after a long stint with AT&T – was a way to connect more closely with a game he loved but hadn't had a great deal of time for.

"When I retired in 2009, I started to fiddle around with golf," Nelson said. "I was struggling, hadn't had any lessons. So I went to Steeple Chase. In the course of four sessions of three

hours (in group lessons), I realized how intriguing it was to get everything right."

A pal happened to be the superintendent for the Buffalo Grove-owned courses and needed help one day a week. Nelson was a quick enough study that soon enough, he was cutting greens,

the most exacting job for a crew member. Part of his payment was complimentary green fees.

Today, he works up to 27 hours a week, most every morning, cutting greens and tee boxes at Steeple Chase.

"I can look at a green and say, 'That was my

green.' It gives me a real sense of satisfaction," Nelson said.

So has volunteering for the PGA HOPE program, which came about through his membership in Mundelein's American Legion post. That led to volunteering for the Mundelein Park District's "Healthy Minds, Healthy Bodies" program, where veterans are given aid in coping with the stresses of life.

"We all have issues," Nelson said. "It might be physical, it might be mental."

A course of training prepared him to help, and that led to the fledgling PGA HOPE program. Attending a one of the program's golf clinics at Pine Meadow – "I can actually get myself out of a bunker now," Nelson said – led to working with leader Christine Lopez.

"There's a feeling of satisfaction and accomplishment with the HOPE clinics," Nelson said. "Most participants have some issues. Maybe they're missing a leg. But in the clinic, your focus is now on golf and off your problem, whether medical or mental."

"I remember playing with a guy who got his first eagle. He forgot about everything else at that point."

Nelson's enthusiasm for the program led to the ambassador ranking, which means he spreads the message of the program's aid to fellow veterans.

Training for that posting took place in and near Washington, D.C. in mid-October. It included wellness training, social media training, hobnobbing with notables, including two-time PGA champion and U.S. Open winner Larry Nelson, himself a veteran, and a fair amount of golf.

Nelson not only aced the educational aspects of the program, he won the putting contest and

was on a team that all cashed in at the Congressional Country Club pro shop at the end of the day.

He promotes the program via talks to groups. An evening might find him at a veteran's group meeting, or at lunch with a fraternal organization. Bringing one or two vets at a time into the program is the goal. The groups themselves average from 15 to 20 veterans each, with perhaps 100 participating in the Illinois Section over the course of the year. That number is expected to grow.

Clinics are held at Pine Meadow in Mundelein and at Veterans Memorial Golf Course (the retitled Willow Glen) at the Naval Station Great Lakes in North Chicago. Pine Meadow was the first site, in 2020, Veterans Memorial joined the rotation this year, and there's a possibility it will be extended to Harborside International on Chicago's south side in 2022.

Therapist Donna Strum and LPGA teacher Kathy Williams, who for over 15 years have conducted similar programs under their non-profit Revelation Golf banner, lead the clinics. Without their groundbreaking work, the Illinois Section HOPE program would have been far longer in the making.

Some of Chicago's most notable teachers are among the professionals offering the finer points of the game: Dennis Johnsen, head pro at Pine Meadow, along with Tim O'Neal, Robert Powers, Gary Groh, Terry Russell, Bob Koschmann and Adam Anderson, the latter the head pro and general manager at Veterans Memorial.

"At one of the clinics, there was one fellow who hadn't golfed before, and another who hadn't played in 10 years," Nelson said. "Without PGA HOPE, they probably wouldn't be golfing."

Life on the firing line

Once upon a time, Jim Nelson had a small hand in the possible end of the world. Such is the life of an Army communications officer attached to a Pershing mobile missile group, with nuclear weapons on them.

It was the mid-1960s, and the Pershings, relatively new, were being shuttled around West Germany to be used if the Soviet Union attacked. Nelson didn't have his finger on the button, but worked for a time as a senior switchboard operator for field operations. He put together the telecommunication unit that connected the group with European headquarters, which in turn was connected to the Pentagon, which in turn was connected to the White House.

If the word came through to fire, it would come through Nelson's hookup. The missiles would be launched and then everyone would try to evacuate.

"We were told that if we ever fired, our life span was estimated at seven minutes," Nelson said. "We were being tracked even in the 1960s."

Duel for the ages

Cantlay outlasts DeChambeau at Caves Valley

Caves Valley Country Club is one of those places where members love to talk about the round that got away.

It's easy to do. The Tom Fazio design in Owings Mills, Md., scant miles from downtown Baltimore, is a challenging test up, down and across hillsides. Fazio said not long after the course opened that the layout was essentially dictated by the topography, that "it just so happened to fit here that the short holes were short and the long holes were long. And the long holes tended to be at the end of the round. That's kind of how it evolved."

That routing made for great drama down the stretch of the BMW Championship on Aug. 28. Down the stretch and past the finish line, in fact.

In a duel worthy of the Preakness Stakes, Patrick Cantlay and Bryson DeChambeau just couldn't play enough golf. After 72 holes, they failed to break the tie they were in following 54 holes of play. Each shot 6-under-par 66 on the rolling ground to settle in at 27-under-par 261, a stroke off the record that Keegan Bradley and

Justin Rose established at Aronimink in 2019. But whereas Bradley dispatched Rose with a par in one sudden-death hole, Cantlay and DeChambeau traded birdies like brickbats in a bruising playoff that lasted six holes – long enough that the leather-lunged gallery ran out of beer – before Cantlay’s 17-foot, 6-inch birdie the fifth time he played the 18th in the late afternoon fell into the cup, and DeChambeau’s bid to match his birdie from 8 feet 9 inches fell short.

With that, the usually reserved Cantlay, for whom the phrase Happy Hour rarely applies, broke unto a big smile, basking in both the moment – the crowd was roaring – and the achievement.

Cantlay, who had pressured Justin Thomas down the stretch at Medinah in 2019’s BMW, not only knocked off the previous year’s U.S. Open champion in winning for the third time in the 2020-21 season, he jumped into the lead for the PGA Tour’s playoff pot of gold.

How good was that? To Cantlay, it was great. He even liked the Patty Ice chants.

“I got it all week. There was maybe one or two guys that followed me around maybe all four days, and just every hole, screaming it,” Cantlay said. “I’m as focused as I can be on every single shot, and I try not to let my mind get past the moment that I’m in, and maybe that’s why I come across a little sedated out there.”

“But I’m locked in, and I’m as focused as I can be. Then I kind of let the chips fall where they do. Try not to get caught up in being out-driven 45 yards or whatever it is. I just try and lock in and do my absolute best in that moment, and my best is pretty good.”

It was good enough to pile up 31 birdies and an eagle in the regulation 72 holes, then play the six playoff holes 2-under. He had to be that good

to knock off DeChambeau, who used his power game to score 27 birdies and four eagles in the four rounds to match Cantlay’s 27-under mark.

Cantlay’s 21-foot birdie at the last in regulation forced the playoff. Over an hour later, with the skies growing dark, he rolled in the 17-footer that would allow him to hug the J.K. Wadley Trophy for the first time.

DeChambeau ducked reporters, but Cantlay was like Chatty Cathy after his success.

“I thought the course was great theater, obviously,” Cantlay said. “Lots of birdies and a great finishing hole. It was easy; I knew it was going to play easy and you were going to need to make a lot of birdies. When I was playing the practice rounds, I mentioned to the guys it’s going to be well into the 20s, and that’s just mostly to do with it being as soft as it was.”

“I think this golf course would be very different if it was firm, but it’s wide and there’s not a ton of trouble, so it was a birdie-fest out there, and it felt like your foot was on the gas from the word ‘go.’”

Go was everyone’s mantra. The field averaged 68.449 strokes in the final round on the par 72 test, and 69.203 strokes for the week. The entire field finished under par.

It became a two-man race in the third round, and not because others faltered. Cantlay and DeChambeau just ran away from the stellar field. Sungjae Im took second at 23-under 265, and Rory McIlroy was fourth at 22-under 266 with an opening 64 and a closing combination of 65-67. But his second round 70 was no match for Cantlay’s 63 or DeChambeau’s eye-popping 60, the second-lowest round in championship history behind the 59 Jim Furyk punched into the scoreboard at Conway Farms in 2013.

WGA keeps BMW in driver's seat through 2027

In contrast to last time, when the renewal of BMW as the title sponsor of the Western Golf Association's championship was up in the air past the 2019 playing of the BMW at Medinah Country Club, the five-year renewal announced on Nov. 22 came over a year in advance.

That's a sign that the new management of BMW North America, which signs the checks for the sponsorship, is more than pleased with the exposure the automaker gets.

The new deal extends the sponsorship through 2027. It began in 2007 with some controversy, as the Western Open's name was changed, the full-field tournament became a 70-man playoff, the date shifted from July to September, and began to be played outside Chicago every other year.

Schedule tweaks now have it in August, crowds flock to it, and the list of big names winning it have added luster to one of the grand occasions on golf's annual calendar.

It's also brought in a great deal of money for the Evans Scholars Foundation, the WGA's caddies-to-college program.

"Since 2007, BMW has been our valued partner and a steadfast supporter of both our championships and the Evans Scholars Foundation," said John Kaczkowski, WGA president and CEO, in a release. "As title sponsor, BMW has fully embraced our mission, helping us transform the Evans Scholars Foundation into a truly national program. We're excited and grateful for the opportunity to continue working together to change

In the last 15 years, the BMW Championship has raised over \$40 million on behalf of the Evans Scholars Foundation, helping send more than 3,000 students to college. In 2021-22, a record 1,070 caddies are attending 21 major colleges and universities on Evans grants.

"For the past 15 years, we have worked with our partners at the PGA Tour and the Western Golf Association to host the top 70 players in the world at what has become one of the best, and most exciting events on the golf calendar," said Sebastian Mackensen, president and CEO, BMW of North America. "The BMW Championship is not only a great way to showcase our brand and engage customers, but also a wonderful opportunity to raise money for the Evans Scholars Foun-

dation and help so many young students to follow their dreams."

The COVID-19 pandemic caused alteration of the now-usual schedule of playing in Chicago in odd-numbered years. Instead, the 2020 tournament was moved to Olympia Fields Country Club, which was expected to be the 2021 site. The 2021 affair went to Caves Valley near Baltimore, and 2022 is slated for Wilmington Country Club in Delaware, the second time in three years it will be played near Philadelphia, on Aug. 18-21.

The 2023 BMW gets back on the regular schedule, with Olympia Fields getting it again, and this time, there will be spectators on hand. They were barred from the premises in 2020 because of COVID fears. Next year, it's expected more than 100,000 will attend.

Thorbjornsen solves Glen View Club

Beats Sargent to capture Western Am

Michael Thorbjornsen ran the table at the Glen View Club this week, doing everything but crashing the Saturday night wedding reception.

The 19-year-old will have to settle for setting the course record – 62 – winning the stroke-play medal and capturing the 119th Western Amateur through four difficult matches, the last a 4 and 3 victory over Gordon Sargent.

And what does a champion teen golfer do to celebrate? He and his caddie will trek downtown on Sunday to take in Lollapalooza.

The 27th medalist to win the title and first since co-medalist Cole Hammer in 2018, Thorbjornsen, from Wellesley, Mass., closed out Sargent with a 35-foot two-putt on the 15th green, but he really won the title by winning the 11th, 12th and 13th holes with birdies to forge a 4-up lead. He was 4-under across 15 holes, including the usual concessions.

“I was 3-up through eight; it’s always nice to have that cushion,” Thorbjornsen said. “Then he won nine and 10 and you can kind of feel the momentum switch. He’s starting to build some confidence, but I’ve got to remember I’m still leading.”

He ran down a 12-foot downhill putt for birdie on the par-3 11th to take the momentum back, then dropped his approach on the par-4 12th to two feet for another birdie, then sank a 8-footer for a birdie 4 on the 550-yard 13th. With that, the Stanford sophomore all but sealed the fate of Sargent, a two-time Alabama Amateur champ from Birmingham who enters Vanderbilt this fall.

"Gordon got a little unlucky with his tee shot (on No. 12)," Thorbjornsen said.

"I never had too much momentum," Sargent said. "I kinda gave him some holes. He made a great birdie on 11 and I gave him 12; I tried to lay up and I hit a 5-iron 240. From there, I really struggled. And he played really well, so, not much I can do."

Thorbjornsen came from 1 down with four holes to play to beat Austin Greaser 2 up in the morning semifinal, which was not only dramatic, but gave him momentum after lunch.

"Those last three holes against Austin were pretty heated," Thorbjornsen said. "I guess that flowed over. I was pretty zoned in, focused, and tried to keep that same mentality in the afternoon.

"I hit some good drives when I needed to, good irons, good chips, and had some good lag putting."

Sargent knocked off defending champion and world No. 2 Pierceson Coody 1 up in his morning semifinal. That and his appearance in the championship match helped persuade the USGA to award Sargent one of the five remaining places in the U.S. Amateur. He went into the Western Am 64th in the world amateur rankings. Thorbjornsen came in 71st.

"These's nothing negative you're going to take away from this week," Sargent said. "There are only positives I can take. This is probably the

best amateur field, and I still beat a lot of good players."

Thorbjornsen collected a miniature of the George Thorne Trophy, the traditional gold medal, the medalist's plate, and one more thing he might be too busy for. The Western Am winner also gets an exemption into the Evans Scholars Invitational on the Korn Ferry Tour. That's usually on Memorial Day weekend, but Vanderbilt might be involved in NCAA Tournament play that week.

Friday's quarterfinals also offered drama.

Down two holes with six holes remaining in

his Western Amateur quarterfinal match at the Glen View Club with Luke Potter, Coody had to make something happen.

He did. Coody birdied the next two holes while Potter did not, briefly squaring the match, and while Potter took the lead with a par on the par-4 16th, Coody had made the point. He wasn't going away.

Coody, the pride of Plano, Tex., and a Longhorn junior in the fall, would knock off Potter, an Arizona State freshman in the fall, in 20 holes to advance to the semifinals.

The birdies on the 13th and 14th were important. The birdie on the 17th, a 24-foot downhill putt with what he estimated as eight feet of break, fell into the cup to keep him alive, as Potter subsequently matched with a 14-footer.

"That was a must-make," Coody said on the driving range, to which he repaired after his match to straight out what he considered a flaw in his swing. "It was almost a 90-degree putt. It took the fall line and went right in the center with good pace."

That forced the match to the last with Potter still 1-up, but he pulled his drive into the hazard to the left and couldn't recover for better than a double-bogey, while Coody hit the fairway and green on the 450-yard par-4 in regulation. It was back to the first tee for sudden death, and after Coody and Potter halved the first hole, Coody hit the green on the par-3 second while Potter missed the putting surface. Potter couldn't get up-and-down and Coody was through to the semis.

Coody won last year at Crooked Stick, and never went past the 18th hole, but was challenged in each match. He would have been the first defending champion to repeat since fellow Texas Longhorn Justin Leonard in 1992-93.

Kelly breaks through at Stonebridge

Pride of Medinah captures first state Open, third state major

From the start, it was clear Tim “Tee-K” Kelly was playing with a purpose. This final round of the 72nd Illinois Open at Stonebridge Country Club on Aug. 4 was anything but a casual round of golf for him. This was business.

He and brother-caddie Will talked about the line on every tee, every approach, every putt. Kelly’s game was sharp, undistracted by the many family members and friends from Medinah Country Club watching him. Draining a downhill 15-foot curler for birdie after hitting his approach into a shortside greenside bunker on the par-5 first hole was the first clue.

Put it this way. To beat him, Luke Gannon of Mahomet, who started the day in second, would have to score five strokes under whatever Kelly shot.

When Kelly went out in 4-under-par 32, Gannon understood that wasn’t going to happen. (Back in the pack, Daniel Hudson was matching the Stonebridge course record with a 10-under 62, about which more later.)

Even when Kelly pulled his tee shot on the par-5 14th out of bounds, and stumbled to a three-putt double-bogey 7, it wasn’t going to happen.

"I knew an eagle would be huge there, and made a bad par," Gannon said, hoping for a four-shot swing.

Kelly, from Wheaton, birdied the next two holes anyway, sinking putts of 10 and 15 feet to erase the double and Gannon's last hope for an upset.

Only scoring records were in question by then. Kelly cruised to a 4-under 68 and total of 17-under 199 to annex Illinois Open and add it to his two Illinois Amateur titles from the previous decade. In so doing, he collected a record \$25,080 from the professional purse of \$105,010, and became the 10th player to score the Open-Am career double.

The 27-year old proved he was in form the previous week with a tie for third in a Forme Tour tournament at Purdue. His opening-round 6-under-par 66 to take the first-round lead reinforced the notion.

Kelly birdied four of his last eight holes, including the last two, in crafting his bogey-free opening round. He credits the ability to play golf again with something on the line for his improved form.

"It was tough (last year)," Kelly said of the COVID-created halt to the stepping-stone tours where he plies his trade. "When you're trying to play golf for a living and you can't, you don't feel like you're doing anything."

He did plenty at Stonebridge.

"Winning golf tournaments is never easy, but it sure is a lot of fun when you pull it off," said Kelly, who had three top-nine finishes in his previous four starts, including a tie for third last year. "I've never had too close of a call, but I feel I've put myself in contention a fair bit."

His wire-to-wire lead this year made sure

that only Gannon, and barely, had something of a close call this year. Kelly hit 12 of 14 fairways, as did Gannon, and 13 greens in regulation, and took 31 putts. Gannon, who birdied the first two holes, hit one more green and had 28 putts, but his second straight 67 for 14-under 202 didn't get him the trophy. But the consolation prize of \$14,765 will heal any mental wounds.

"I kinda figured I had to play pretty close to perfect," Gannon said.

That category was already taken by Kelly, who still eyes the PGA Tour.

"Every year, I've gotten better and better," Kelly said. "Until that shuts down and I'm not improving, I'll keep playing."

Hudson fires a 62

Daniel Hudson is a 26-year-old Chicagoan who, like many others in the Illinois Open field, wants to make it to the PGA Tour. The Lyons Township and Kansas grad displayed tourish skills in the final round, equaling the Stonebridge course record with a 10-under 62.

He equaled Joe Jimenez's score from the third round of the 1995 Ameritech Senior Open — when Jimenez was merely 69 — and the numbers Rosie Jones and Annika Sorenstam posted in the first round of the 2003 Kellogg-Keebler Classic.

Hudson did so from a greater distance — 6,932 yards — than any of the others. It vaulted him from mid-pack to solo third with a total of 10-under 206 and earned him \$9,029.

"I had no idea about the course record, so that's a bonus," Hudson said. "I think the toughest thing is when you get to a certain point (under

par), you want to keep going, but you don't want to make decisions that would alter the progress of the round. So mentally that's the toughest thing, when you get to 6-, 7-, or 8-under and you've got some holes left. But it was a great day."

"I set a goal at the start of the day to shoot the lowest round of the tournament, so I think I've got that."

Hudson bogeyed the fourth and 11th holes, but eagled the par-5 ninth with a 230-yard hybrid and 30-foot putt, and birdied 10 others, including six of the last seven.

"I was able to get over the mental battle of commitment and conviction, just doing it, which was really good," Hudson said. "I've struggled with that pretty much all summer."

If a 62 doesn't brighten the attitude, nothing will.

Around Stonebridge

Mac McClellan of Hinsdale and Iowa's golf team was low amateur, finishing with a 2-under 70 for 7-under 209. ... Kelly's 17-under score to par across three days of near-windless conditions matched the mark set by Carlos Sainz at Royal Fox and Royal Hawk in 2016. His 199 aggregate matches second-best in Illinois Open history, tying David Cooke in 2015 and behind only Sainz's 197 in 2016. ... Kelly pulled the trigger on the \$5,250 entry fee for Korn Ferry Tour qualifying, saying the money he won for tying for third on the Forme Tour stop at Purdue covered it. ... The field averaged 71.91 strokes, even with many cups tucked in locations than Stonebridge members have never aimed at. ... Brandon Holtz eagled the par-4 second hole, a 346-yard test. He shot 4-under 68 and tied for 18th at 1-under 215. ... Illinois Amateur champ Ethan Farnam posted two final-round eagles, his 67 good for 4-under 212 and joint ninth.

100TH ILLINOIS PGA Mickelson makes it happen

*Mistwood pro only player
to finish under par*

Seven years ago, Andy Mickelson was a PGA professional without a golf course.

He was working a desk job in a packaging facility. Then Mistwood called, and his life changed.

On Aug. 25, a sun-splashed Wednesday, he celebrated again, winning the 100th Illinois PGA Championship by four strokes via his third straight 1-under-par 71. His total of 3-under 213 on the difficult Ivanhoe Club layout earned him his first Illinois major, a year after he tied for second and two after he was joint fifth.

“It’s five years since I did something special,” Mickelson said, recalling a victory at Pebble Beach in a TaylorMade-sponsored tournament. “I truly did take it one shot at a time today.”

Mickelson kept his game together, hitting most of Ivanhoe’s narrow fairways and, by his counting, 17 greens. That led to 15 pars, two birdies and a solitary bogey as the only player to finish under par. In comparison, the others in his group, Garrett Chaussard and Tim Streng, scored 76 and 81, respectively.

“Garrett has a bad start and Tim has a bad start, and I almost make it (with an approach on No. 3), and I think, ‘Why not me?’ ” Mickelson said.

Why not indeed. He trailed Chaussard by a

stroke entering the day, and was four ahead of was him and Kurt Rogers of Champaign Country Club at the turn.

“I’ve been in the last group the last three years,” Mickelson said. “The rut I got into was playing match play against the guys in my group. I didn’t do that today.”

He didn’t check a leader board until the back nine and loved what he saw. He finished with eight straight pars, agonizing over missed birdie chances on several occasions.

“I could have shot a special number,” Mickelson said. “I put a lot into every shot. That’s why I’m exhausted right now.”

Rogers, 60, was encouraged to make the long trip from his home in Forsyth, a Decatur suburb, by Illinois Section tournament director Brad Slocum, who thought his arrow-straight driving game would buoy his chances on the narrow course. That proved correct.

“I probably hit driver 10 (of 14) times,” Rogers said. “I tried to stay patient. You can’t go firing at every flag.”

He made 11 birdies in three days, including three in the final round, with two in the last four holes.

Mickelson earned \$9,800 from the purse of \$81,650 for the victory, with Rogers and Chaussard, who tied for second at 1-over 217, collecting \$5,690.50 each. Chris French of Aldeen Golf Course in Rockford was solo fourth at 2-over

218, and earned \$4,333.

All of the above made the PGA club pro championship – formally the National Professional Championship – set for April 17-20, 2022 at Barton Creek in Texas. It'll be Mickelson's third appearance.

"I thought I was prepared for it last time and wasn't," Mickelson said. "I couldn't have been more uncomfortable. I learned so much. Now I know better where I rank among pros around the country."

Higher than before, to be sure, and with limitless possibilities.

The three-day test began with Mickelson's colleague, Frank Hodenadel, grab the lead in Monday's opening round with a sparkling 3-under 69 on Ivanhoe's championship layout in a quest for a second Illinois PGA title.

"That was two jobs ago," he quipped.

Hodenadel was an assistant at Midlothian when he beat the field by four strokes at Medinah No. 1 a decade ago. His opening 69, good for a one-stroke advantage on his 115 peers, came about, he said, because of a swing adjustment urged on him by Mickelson.

"I've been fighting a hook my whole life," Hohenadel said. "Andy is always telling me I'm shut coming back."

That means the clubface will promote a hook coming through the ball. Hodenadel's slight adjustment opened the face of the club and voila! No more hook.

Instead, after a quiet first 13 holes, he birdied three of the last five to sit ahead of Streng, whose 2-under 70 was the best afternoon score, and a gaggle at 1-under 71 including both Mickelson and 13-time winner Mike Small, the coach of Illinois' men's team. Chaussard and Eric Ilic were

also at 71, while Steve Gillie and Travis Hall scored even par 72.

Small was the defending champion. Hodenadel won when the iPhone was new.

"I was a kid," Hohenadel said. "It was my first year of eligibility (as a Class A pro). Now the event means a lot more to me."

Hohenadel, finishing on the front nine, birdied the fifth, eighth and ninth holes to race to 3-under and the lead.

Streng played quietly, saving pars along the way, scoring a brace of birdies, including one at the par-5 ninth, his last hole of the day, achieved this way: 5-iron, 7-iron, wedge, 8-foot putt.

"Just tried to keep it in play," Streng said. "I hit two drivers all day, a lot of 4-irons. Maybe my driving iron once. The fairways narrow where you'd hit driver."

Small credited salvaging a par on the fifth hole from an unplayable lie in weeds as a key to his 71. He said in comparison to Sunday's practice round, "it probably exceeded my expectations."

Small, in winning 13 times, has come from behind and led the parade. In 10 of his victories, there's at least one round of 67 or better, no matter where it's been played. If he does that on Tuesday, the field could well be chasing him in Wednesday's final round.

Mickelson, 40, picked a 20-foot birdie on the par-4 16th as his highlight, noting he was wary all day.

"It's not an easy golf course to be comfortable on," Mickelson said. "There are some angles on tee shots, and there's always some water or out-of-bounds present."

Chaussard took over the lead with a 2-under 70 for 3-under 141 in Round 2, surviving a day with a heat index of 103 before a thunderstorm

stopped play. He played the last three holes 1-under after the delay, which put him in the final group with Mickelson and Streng. Chaussard, a two-time Illinois PGA Match Play winner, was just happy to be finished.

"It's very tough out there," Chaussard said. "I'm glad I got it done. The break was actually good. It slowed me down. I happened to birdie No. 16 coming in and scrape together a couple of pars. It was very refreshing, especially because I was one of three people to wear pants today."

"Plus those last three holes are pretty hard, so it was good to get them without wind."

The break and a quick restart might have cost Small his bid for a 14th title. He was 3-under, having gone birdie-eagle on the two holes immediately before the stop, including an eagle on the par-5 15th. But he came out and promptly double-bogeyed the 16th, bogeyed the par-3 17th and made a quadruple-bogey 8 on the watery final hole, a 7-over train wreck that added up to 77 and 4-over 148, seven strokes in arrears. He triple-bogeyed the first hole in the final round. Had he played those four holes in even par, he beats Mickelson by two.

Around Ivanhoe

The 10 club pro qualifiers: Mickelson, Rogers, Chaussard, French, Hohenadel, Matt Slowinski, Brian Carroll, David Pagelow, Streng and Reece Bartlet, the latter beating Curtis Malm, Andrew Godfrey and Jim Billiter for the last contested spot. Counting the earlier championships under the name of the Middle States PGA, this was the 103rd section championship since the 1916 founding of the PGA of America. ... The 2022 championship is set for Makray Memorial Golf Course in Barrington.

Six enter Illinois Golf Hall of Fame

Six individuals influential in developing golf in Illinois were inducted into the Illinois Golf Hall of Fame on Oct. 1. In some cases, it was a long time coming.

Bessie Anthony, for instance, goes back to the turn of the last century. Mason Phelps, almost as far back. And Herbert J. Tweedie? How about to the start of golf in Chicago?

Tweedie was there when Chicago Golf Club opened in Belmont – now Downers Grove – in 1893. He took over the layout when Chicago Golf moved to Wheaton for more room. He designed most of the early golf courses in the area, including the layouts for Flossmoor and Midlothian, which are still in use with minimal changes.

Anthony won the first three Women's Western Amateurs in 1901-02-03, and the U.S. Women's Amateur in the latter year, weeks before she got married and retired from competitive golf.

Phelps was part of the WGA's gold-medal winning Olympic team in 1904 while attending Yale, and won a pair of Western Amateurs in 1908 and 1910.

Those three key members of early Illinois golf were joined as members of the 2021 class by the late Phil Kosin, whose *Chicagoland Golf* newspaper and radio show was a must-read and must-listen, five-time Illinois Open champion Gary Pinns, and teacher extraordinare Dr. Jim

Suttie, whose career is going into its sixth decade.

That sextet was feted by a sellout crowd at The Glen Club, with Pinns and Suttie in attendance and the other four inductees represented by family.

Kathy Rachick, widow of Phil Kosin, spoke of his dedication to his craft, of the long hours he worked putting together each issue of *Chicagoland Golf*, which was issued from 1989 through mid-2008, and then waking up early on a Saturday to act as "ringmaster," to use his word, of the WSCR-AM radio show that golfers tuned into on their way to courses.

Pinns, who all but grew up at Village Links of Glen Ellyn, was typically humble in his induction speech, crediting those who came before him, including members of his family, in teaching him the game. Now, he teaches as well at Oak Brook Golf Club, and is in demand for lessons.

Suttie, who spent decades in the barn at Cog Hill and also hung his shingle at Conway Farms and in Florida, among other places, spoke of his

beginnings playing golf in DeKalb and took his audience on a journey from there to working both with champions like Paul Azinger, whom he coaches in college, to developing the video analysis techniques now employed by all.

Tenuta's tie for sixth in the Illinois Amateur at Mistwood put him over the top with 580 points. The margin came about when he birdied three of his last four holes. McClellan (second at Mistwood) scored 575, Ethan Farnam of Crystal Lake 565. Farnam won the state amateur but Tenuta's win in the CDGA Amateur was too much to overcome.
