where that happened," Montgomerie said. "It was amazing to feel and very emotional coming back. This place, this Benton Harbor, Harbor Shores place, is a very special place to me."

Montgomerie followed up his win at Harbor Shores with a U.S. Senior Open victory a few weeks later, and then successfully defended his Senior PGA crown at French Lick last year. Thus, Monty is going for a third straight Senior PGA and fourth senior major overall.

Only five players, led by **Sam Snead**'s six titles, have won three Senior PGAs. Only **Hale Irwin** won three in succession. Could Monty be the second?

"You've got a series of guys I could reel off including hall of famers and future hall of famers," Montgomerie said of the field lined up against him. "There are 20 guys you could think could easily, easily walk off with this title."

One of whom is not **Tom Watson**, out with a bad back. But newly-minted senior **John Daly** will be in the field.

"This place, this Benton Harbor, Harbor Shores place, is a very special place to me," said Montgomerie.

CATS ON THE PROWL: Illinois' men's team is on our cover, but Northwestern women's team is also having great success this season. The Wildcats tied Ohio State for the Big Ten title, and have advanced to the NCAA Championship by romping to victory in the regional held at Shoal Creek Country Club In Birmingham, Ala.

The final numbers weren't sensa-

tional – the Wildcats finished at 23-pverpar 887 – but the margin was. Northwestern beat runner-up Florida State by 18 strokes across three rounds.

Janet Mao tied Florida State's Matilda Castren and California's Marianne Li for the individual crown and led the Wildcats at 4-over 220 with a closing round of par 72, with Kacie Komoto (6-over 222, closing 77) second on the squad and fourth overall.

The totals of **Sarah Cho** (9-over 225, closing 78) and Big Ten freshman of the year **Stephanie Lau** (11-over 227, closing 72) also went on the board for the Wildcats. **Hannah Kim**, nominally the Wildcats' No. 1 player, scored 76 for 232 and didn't figure in the team total.


Eighth-ranked (by Golfstat) Northwestern, No. 22 Florida State, No. 9 Oklahoma State, No. 1 Alabama, No. 25 Tennessee and Michigan advanced from Shoal Creek to the NCAA Championship, set for Eugene (Ore.) Country Club beginning Fri., May 20.

HE'S EVERYWHERE: Mike Small will tee it up in the inaugural Lincoln Land Charity tournament in Springfield in July. The tournament extended him an invitation earlier this month.

For Small, it'll be a return of sorts to his professional roots. Before he became head coach of Illinois' men's team, Small was a touring pro, and won twice in 1997 on what was originally called the Ben Hogan Tour.

The Lincoln Land is July 14-17 at Panther Creek Country Club.

USGA, Chicago Golf: we're waiting

f there are two organizations in golf that have their ducks in a row all the time, the two are the United States Golf Association and Chicago Golf Club.

They date to the 1890s. Charles Blair Macdonald was the founder of Chicago Golf and largely the reason the USGA was founded, with Chicago Golf one of the Founding Five.

Each is steeped in traditions.

One tradition for each is taking steps carefully, never tipping a hand until necessary.

That's why the wait for the formalization of a deal between the two to host the inaugural U.S. Senior Women's Open in 2017 is so curious.

The USGA announced the inauguration of the tournament – championship, as they haughtily call everything – at their annual meeting. The headliner in that announcement wasn't so much the creation of the Senior Women's, which had been speculated upon for some time, but the location: Chicago Golf Club.

The club of about 120 members, tucked away on a two-lane road in Wheaton, wasn't known to be under consideration. In reality, secret talks had been going on for over a year.

The USGA wanted the first edition to be at a memorable site, all the better to draw attention to the new kid in its competition roster.

Chicago Golf is memorable. It's the best golf experience in Chicagoland – one that next to nobody gets to experience. No one says, but if there are 8,000 rounds played there in a summer,

it's been a busy year.

If it was a public course – and the redesigned Mount Prospect has some holes that hint at the features – tee times would be sold out a year ahead. One must think on every shot and every putt. The Macdonald-Raynor layout is subtle, sublime and packs a punch simultaneously, And it's a great deal of fun.

Chicago Golf hosts a tournament and throws open its gate to the general public once a generation, it seems. The 2005 Walker Cup was held there, so only a dozen years between showcases almost seems like they're rushing things. (Before that, you have to go back to the 1992 Western Junior, which Tiger Woods played in, and the 1979 U.S. Senior Amateur. And that was the first soiree at Chicago Golf since the 1928 Walker Cup.)

Here's the unusual thing about that announcement. The USGA and Chicago Golf still don't have a contract. A signed and sealed deal.

The USGA doesn't announce tournament

sites until it has a signed and sealed deal.

Except this time.

The announcement was made in February. It's May. Still no deal.

It's hard to imagine what the hangup would be.

Club president Brad Kinsey gave a lengthy interview to GolfersOnGolf.com a few weeks ago, and after it was published, asked the interview be taken off that website – at least until the deal was signed.

He had said nothing inflammatory. It was all white bread, the typical chatter when such an announcement is made. He'd done the same a few weeks earlier in the USGA's release on the announcement: "As a founding member of the USGA, Chicago Golf Club is honored to support the newest championship. We look forward to making this, our 12th USGA championship, an exceptional event for players and spectators alike."

Fine. Now there's radio silence. Crickets.

Given the yawns that normally greet the senior men – a series of tournaments largely put on for and to entertain the clients of corporations, though the presence of John Daly may goose the interest that for a while – some may question whether there's a public demand for senior women's golf beyond the scattered tournaments that already exist.

Maybe some members of Chicago Golf are asking that question. The ducks are in disarray.

NCAA MEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP PREVIEW TWO down, one to go for Illini

Big Ten, regional crowns collected; national title next?

andelions don't pop up in your lawn as regularly as Illinois' men's golf team wins titles, not to mention plaudits, every spring in recent years.

Let's add it up: Since Mike Small took over as head coach in the summer of 2000, Illinois has won eight Big Ten championships.

This year? Same old, same old. The Fighting Illini roared from behind to win the Big Ten championship for the second year running and did the same thing to capture an NCAA regional title for the fourth straight time, advancing to the NCAA Championship for the ninth straight time.

Now the goal is the NCAA crown, which Illinois has never won. The Illini were runner-ups in 2013.

If Small was coaching the men's basketball or football teams, he would have a bronze statute outside Memorial Stadium and a street named after him. He'd be the talk of Twitter.

Instead, he can walk down Neil Street in

Champaign and most people won't notice him.

That, he probably doesn't mind. Small likes the success his players have reaped, but could do without undue attention on himself. He'd rather the players received it.

"Four consecutive regional wins says a lot, that is consistency over time and it's very hard to do," Small said after the Illini overcame a seven-

stroke deficit to Florida in the final round to win the regional at Blackwolf Run in Kohler, Wis.

"Our two seniors (Thomas Detry and Charlie Danielson) stood out today, they finished tied for third. They're the reason right now, but the rest of the team piggybacked and played solid."

Detry, Danielson and sophomore Nick Hardy fired 2-under-par 70s on the original Blackwolf Run-Meadow Valley course, Detry and Danielson scoring 4-under 212 and Hardy at 1-under 215. Dylan Meyer's 1-under 71 added up to a three-day total of par 216, and their total of 281 for 11-under 853 was four strokes better than Florida.

"The back nine was the story of the day," Small said. "We were treading water after nine holes, but then the back nine was just solid. Florida played better than us this week, but we finished stronger."

Illinois' top four players were 5-under on the back nine, compared to Florida's 5-over aggregate. Alejandro Tosti's score of 6-under 210 was good for second overall, but he was 3-over on the back nine when the regional title was on the line.

Arkansas, Florida State and Baylor join Illinois and Florida in advancing to the NCAA Championship, set for May 27-June 1 at Eugene (Ore.) Country Club.

Tim "Tee-K" Kelly of Wheaton and Ohio State also advanced, and stylishly, by winning the individual competition by a stroke over Tosti with a score of 7-under 209. Kelly closed with a 69 to Tosti's 72 to leapfrog the Gator.

Accomplished as Illinois' comeback was, the battle back to claim the Big Ten title at Victoria National in Newburgh, Ind., was even better. The Illini trailed Iowa by eight strokes as dawn broke on April 24, and won by 13 after an aggregate 24-under-par final round.

Detry went out and broke the course record with an 8-under 64, a card speckled with eight 3s and a deuce. Danielson was right behind with a 65. Hardy posted a 67. Meyer and Edoardo Lipparelli fired 68s, and Lipparelli's didn't even count.

The fireworks produced a total of 26-under 838, with Detry winning the individual title at 10-under 278 by a stroke over Danielson.

"It was a lot of fun to battle it out with Charlie, but getting that individual title means a lot to me, especially as a senior," Detry said. "Not only that, but the team title is a major accomplishment. We were chasing today, but everyone got off to a great start and got after it."

Northwestern failed to advance from its regional in Stillwater, Okla., finishing seventh.

Small grabs share of Crestwicke title

ike Small took a little side trip the day after the Big Ten championship. After watching his players for three days, he wanted to swing a club himself.

Sixty-nine swings later at Crestwicke Country Club in Bloomington, he found himself sharing first place with Mike Troy and Rich Dukelow.

Each scored 3-under-par 69 to grab a third of the title and split the money from the first three places in the Illinois PGA's first Monday stroke play tournament of the season. (The Illinois PGA only has playoffs in its multi-day tournaments, the rationale being someone finishing early would have to sit around for up to six hours to see if his score would hold up.)

Dukelow's 69 was a steady three-birdie trip.

Troy made up for two bogeys with three birdies and an eagle.

Small closed with a rush. He was 1-over after a bogey on the par-4 12rh, but played the last six holes 3-4-3-3-3, with birdies on four of the last five holes, to post his 69.

For their toil, each pocketed \$1,241.67, decent wages for a Monday.



Vernon Hills' Kim captures DCP title

Putt on 18 wins Boys 10-11

e was blessed with a natural swing. That was clear when he was 4. He won a tournament wen he was 8. Now, at the ripe old age of 11, Christian Kim of Vernon Hills is a national champion.

Kim won the Boys 10-11 Division of the 3rd Drive, Chip & Putt Championship on the Sunday

before the Masters at Augusta National Golf Club.

He's the second winner from the Chicago area in as many years, joining Effie Perakis, who won the Girls 7-9 bracket at Augusta National last year.

Kim piled up 18 points by taking second in both the driving and chipping portions of the competition. That made him the leader, three

points ahead of Nolan Haynes of Barberton, Ohio, and Bach Ngo of Frederick, Md.

If Kim could finish no worse that third in the putting division, he would win.

Two treacherous putts later, he won. Haynes was the best putter and finished with 25 points, but Kim's eight points for taking third gave him 26 and the title. Ngo was eighth in putting and

finished fifth with 17 points. "It's been awesome," he said on Golf Channel's coverage.

Kim's final putt, to 3 feet, 10 inches, was the difference. The reward: A silver trophy, awarded by Mark O'Meara, resplendent in his green jacket.

Kim was one of four Chicago-area youths to advance to the national finals. Eric Klutke of Crystal Lake tied for ninth in the Boys 12-13 Division, Emily Duan of Schaumburg deadlocked for seventh in the Girls 10-11 Division, and Stephanie Su of South Barrington was fourth in the Girls 12-13 Division, rallying from a tie for sixth after the driving and chipping by winning the putting competition in her bracket.

Przybylski claims brown jacket

First Will County Am win for veteran amateur

lenn Przybylski has been at this for a while. He's played the Manure Tour – the nickname for Illinois' amateur circuit – since he was in college.

He's been in five Radix Cups, won his share and lost his share.

On April 24, Przybylski broke through for the first time in the Will County Amateur, adding a 2-over-par 74 to an opening 71, the total of 1-over-par 145 good for a one stroke victory over defending champion Michael Fastert, former Illinois Open champion Brian Payne and A.J. Balulis in the 28th edition of the Chicago-area kickoff tournament.

It was Payne, who had scored 75 on Saturday, who set the pace on Sunday. While first round leader Eric Steinback (70) faltered following an opening birdie, Payne went out in 1-over 39. But a birdie on the par-3 eighth began a stretch of four birdies in seven holes to move him to 1-over for the tournament with four holes to play.

Balulis, five groups behind Payne, was 1-under at the turn and then birdied the 10th hole to edge into the lead, while Przybylski, playing in the final threesome right behind Balulis, was also

65TH ILLINOIS PGA MATCH PLAY Bauer prevails over Johns in final

Glen View pro wins 3 matches on final day

t was as long a day of golf as Kyle Bauer and Travis Johns had participated in in forever. Three matches concluded the 65th Illinois PGA Match Play Championship at Kemper Lakes Golf Club on Thursday, May 12, the result of a long rain delay two days before.

For Bauer, playing 45 holes was worth it. In succession, he knocked off Matt Slowinski, Scott Baines and Travis Johns for his first state major.

Bauer's 4 and 3 victory over Johns in the late afternoon completed his unique one-day trifecta. The head pro at the Glen View Club, he had beaten Slowinski 2 and 1 in the early morning quarterfinals, and turned back Baines 6 and 5 in a decisive semifinal match.

That earned him a short rest, for while Johns had trimmed David Pagelow 5 and 4 in his quarterfinal, it took until the 17th hole for Medinah Country Club's instruction director to eliminate Brian Brodell, 2 and 1.

Bauer advanced to last year's semifinals before bowing to Brodell in 19 holes. This time, he walked all the way, to the title.

"At my club I've never played in a golf cart,

so I'm used to walking," Bauer said. "I'm sure I'll be tired tomorrow."

Johns started quickly, winning the first two holes, and with his length looked to be in command. But Bauer halved the third, won the fourth when Johns drove out of bounds, and squared the match when Johns three-putted the fifth. A 15-

foot birdie putt on the eighth gave Bauer a lead he never yielded. Another 15-foot birdie on the 14th made Johns dormie. The end came when Johns bogeyed the 15th.

The success earned Bauer \$5,200, and vaulted him to the top of the Illinois PGA point standings, with 1,002 to Johns' 957.15 and Baines' 601.35.

Evans conquers the golf world

How Chick became the first player to win the U.S. Open and Amateur

SECOND OF THREE PARTS

CHICK EVANS' DOUBLE CROWN

ne hundred years ago, Chick Evans accomplished what had never before been done, and barely imagined. He won both the United States Open and United States Amateur in the same year.

In *The American Golfer* after Chick won the U.S. Open, someone using the pen name of Sam Solomon wrote, "Chick has won one of the big championships, and he has now cut through that streak of bad fortune in such a way that he will probably have infinately more confidence in the future. It will surprise nobody to find Chick national amateur champion in the near future; certainly it would displease nobody in the world."

Nobody had to wait long. When the best amateurs in the country convened at Merion Cricket Club in early September for the 22nd U.S. Amateur, Evans was a heavy favorite. But he wasn't the only favorite. From the south came a pair of youngsters, Perry Adair and Bobby Jones, with high hopes and like pedigrees in regional play.

From the Chicago area, as highly regarded as Evans, came Robert Gardner, who played out of Hinsdale Golf Club and just happened to be the defending champion. But he was handicapped by an infected finger and at one point his participa-



tion was doubtful.

Happily, Gardner recovered nicely.

Two notables were not on hand. Jerry Travers was both under the weather and swamped by business, so sent his regrets. Francis Ouimet, whose U.S. Open victory three years earlier sparked new interest in the game, would have played, but he was barred by the United States Golf Association, which considered him a professional because he was a part-owner of a sporting good store which – horrors! – sold golf equipment. But golfers who wrote about the sport, such as Evans, remained amateurs while they were paid for their writing.

William C. Fownes Jr, of Oakmont fame, led the qualifying with 11-over-par 153. Evans was in with 158, Gardner with 160, Jones with 163, Adair surviving a playoff after scoring 167.

Evans and Gardner would be on opposite sides of the draw. While Chick played relative unknowns and had only one really close call, Gardner had to knock off Jones along the way.

The two Chicagoans met in the 36-hole final, and Evans prevailed, 4 and 3. He then wrote about it in the *Chicago Examiner*:

EVANS BEATS GARDNER, 4-3 By Charles "Chick" Evans.

but I not yet am able to realize it. All last night I tossed in bed, thinking I might lose this one great opportunity, but it was my week evidently, and I have been very, very fortunate. It was pleasant to receive the congratulations of Jerry Travers, Bill Fownes, Johnny Anderson and many, many more, and I thank them through this medium for all their good wishes. Mrs. F.A. Gardner's congratulations touched me deeply. She watched her husband win his difficult matches this long week and accepted his defeat to-day with characteristic cheerfulness.

Now as to the match: No one can ever guess how nevrous I was when I first started out. Actually my legs were so wabbly when I finished a shot that I was afraid some one would notice. I have a huge respect for and a great fear of Robert Gardner's game. Three on the difficult first hole

One of the things that stand out in my mind

is Bob's brilliant 2 on the ninth in the afternoon after I had put what I had thought was a very good one on the green.

BUNKERS AND PUTTS WORRY EVANS.

I cannot get those bunkers and those little putts out of my mind. I can assure every one there is an awful feeling when a golfer like Gardner is catching you, and queer thoughts come up in your mind at every club he takes up. Those troubles are gone now, however, and as I sit here I look back over those years that have passed so swiftly and sweetly and my heart swells as I think that I have at last reached that beautiful goal which at first was only a far-off dream. That dream was to put the name of Edgewater on the national championship cup, My dream was a long time coming true, but perhaps it is only the sweeter for delay.

Evans would go on to win a second U.S. Amateur, beating Francis Ouimet in the 1920 final, and pile up eight Western Amateur titles to go with the 1910 Western Open. But his greatest achievement, creating a caddie scholarship fund and getting a golf association to back it, would come off the course. That's the focus of part three, next month.

JUNIOR SCENE Harada, Bruch win AJGA at Glen Club

ant proof that golf is a world game? You need only look at the results of the AJGA Preview, held at The Glen Club on April 30-May 1.

Winner Ryo Harada hails from Tokyo.

The 18-year-old's total of 3-over-par 147 on the 6,626-yard test earned him first place in the field of 57 boys by one stroke over a more local competitor, Austin Freeman of DeKalb.

Both players, as well as Stephen Kocerha of Carmel, Ind., one of the three third-place finishers, scored 1-over 73 in the final round to move into the top three spots.

First round co-leaders Tyler Leach of Spring Valley, Wis., and Michael Mattas of Streamwood opened with 73s but came back with a 76 and an 81, respectively, and finished tied for third and 10th. Jason Folker of Lake Forest (74-75–149) was also in the third-place deadlock.

The 21-player girls division was captured by Jocelyn Bruch of Carmel, Ind. Her 76-81-157 total of 13-over-par 157 earned her a five-stroke victory over Glenview's Hanna Tanaka, who was derailed in her quest to win in her home town by a closing 85. Hadley Moritz of Wheaton and Julia Bower of Columbia, Mo., tied for third at 166 with identical rounds of 80-86.

Even though the Tom Fazio design played only 5,757 yards for the ladies, only Bruch and

Tanaka were able to break 80 in either round.

he idea was to get closer to the customer, Kent Sirois was saying. A partner in a sales company that was tucked away an in industrial park in Wheaton, he and fellow professional Mike Mandakas wanted to continue to serve the public the old-fashioned way: at a golf facility.

The solution: Find one with a need for a club-fitting operation.

It was almost right around the corner, at Arrowhead, the Wheaton Park District's recently-renovated 27-hole showcase.

Discussions began, and quickly, a deal was struck. The new Pelican Golf took over unused space at Arrowhead and is responsible for all club sales, as well as custon club-fitting. The pro shop on the main floor, still headed by Bruce Stoller, continues to book tee times and sell soft goods and golf balls.

"The tools they've given us for fitting helps us put the right clubs in the hands of our customers," Mandakas said. "And we give them a little critique of their golf swing to help those clubs produce the best. That's the experience we want to give at Arrowhead."

The unveiling of Pelican's triple-threat studio was April 14. It features two club-fitting bays with all the electronic gadgets – Trackman, for one – that tell you as much about your ball flight

as NASA knows about a rocket launch, plus a putting bay that features equally modern gadgetry.

Make it a quadruple threat, because the clubs can be adjusted on site, the old-fashioned way.

Mistwood opens on grand scale

Since 2003, he'd dreamed of a reborn Mistwood, with a remodeled course that fit his vision and a clubhouse that was welcoming.

and leading the Wildcats to second place - and an individual runner-up spot for himself, falling to Stanford's Sandy Tatum in the final - in the 1942 NCAA Championship at South Bend Country Club. The pro, and then pro emeritus, at Milwaukee Country Club since 1951, de la Torre was the PGA's first Teacher of the Year, and won the Wisconsin Open five times. That followed a stint as an assistant at Lake Shore Country Club in Glencoe under his father, Angel.

• Bill Ventresca, head pro at Rolling Green Country Club for 27 seasons, died May 3 at 77 in Barrington. The six-time Radix Cup team member captured the 1974 Illinois PGA Championship and served on numerous IPGA committees.
