Mike Small: Illinois' miracle worker

Honestly, not even Ron Guenther, then the athletic director at Illinois, could have expected the success Mike Small's teams have achieved when he hired the former Fighting Illini player as men's golf coach in 2000.

Ed Beard, the retiring coach, was as comfortable on campus as an old shoe. He'd had some good teams, including the Big Ten champion that boasted Small and Steve Stricker as teammates in 1988.

If Small could do that and make sure his players went to class, Guenther had to have thought, the golf program would be in good shape. And he could go back to the traditional worries of Division I athletic director: Raising money for the edifice complex big-time college sports suffers from, and explaining to the alumni whose arms he would twist for the dough why the football team was so woeful.

It turns out that Small was Guenther's best hire. While Guenther was going through football and basketball coaches, the latter for each gender, Small recruited smartly, coached brilliantly, and his teams won. And won. And won. And continue to win. And his players, once graduated, also continue to win.

Champaign, charming whistle stop though it may be on the old Illinois Central, is not a natural destination for great high school golfers.

Small, first with promises and then by delivering, has made it one. The team that practiced

in the basement of Huff Gym when he arrived has the best indoor-outdoor facility in the Big Ten, if not the country, to hone their game. Small led the way in raising the money to make it happen, first with the indoor center, which allows the Illini teams – the women use it as well – to practice year-round, and then the outdoor range, modeled on Augusta National and paid in full before it opened, all \$6 million of it. Small credits Guenther for the toil, but really, Small sealed the deals – things like the annual Illini fundraiser

at Olympia Fields Country Club. That's a hefty rental, but Illinois comes out ahead – plus gets to host an early-season tournament with the nation's elite programs on the North Course set up in U.S. Open conditions – minus the high rough.

Chicago Highland pro Garrett Chaussard was in his first recruiting class. A rosterful of Chaussards would have brought some success, but Small reached higher. He brought in Luke Guthrie, who won an NCAA individual crown, and developed a pipeline to Belgium and found

Thomas Pieters, who won an NCAA individual title and whose next stroke in anger in the U.S. will be played in the Ryder Cup at Hazeltine National. Small will be there as Pieters' guest.

He plucked Thomas Detry out of the same small land, and he too is succeeding in grabbing big checks, winning on the European Challenge Tour the same day Pieters won on the European Tour – and the same day Brian Campbell, the low amateur at the 2015 U.S. Open, snagged his PGA Tour card for next season.

Detry and PGA Tour hopeful Charlie Danielson graduated this June – as opposed to too many football and basketball players, Small's guys actually pick up diplomas – and the thought was that Small would be rebuilding this fall after first appearances in the NCAA's match-play finals, more than any other school.

Wrong. Like Nick Saban, he's reloading, which is why athletic director Josh Whitman rewarded him with a new six-year deal worth more than \$2 million on Thursday, Sept. 8.

Junior Dylan Meyer spent his summer vacation winning the Western Amateur, just about as storied a title as there is in the land, and advanced to the quarterfinals of the U.S. Amateur.

Along the way, he knocked off world No. 2 Sam Horsfield of England (and Florida) twice, at Knollwood Club for the Western Am title and at Oakland Hills in the U.S. Am to boot.

Meanwhile, Northbrook junior Nick Hardy ran through the Illinois Amateur field at St. Charles Country Club, his 260 propelling him to a 10-stroke victory. He was 28-under-par in 72 holes, which ought to be illegal.

Edoardo Liparelli, like Meyer and Hardy singled out for preseason honors, is in the No. 3

spot. On top of that, Small is high on newcomer Bryan Baumgarten, a Californian who advanced to the round of 16 in the U.S. Am and calls Steve Stricker his favorite Illini athlete. Honest.

So there's three sure things and a likely fourth, if the Small Finishing School track record holds. He needs two more players who can really play to make the kind of noise Illinois golf fans have become accustomed to this season. He'll be picking from Michael Feagles, Trevor Gold, a sophomore from Eureka who is a four-time all-stater, and freshman Giovanni Tadiotto, the latest arrival on the Belgian pipeline, for that fifth spot.

And the old coach? He's hanging in there. At the ripe age of 50, he beat the field in the Illinois PGA Championship for the 12th time – nationally, only Jim White of the Nebraska PGA has won a section title more often, in his case 13 times – and did so by making birdies down the stretch. More about that on page 6.

Meanwhile, Illinois starts its season this weekend at Wolf Run in Zionsville, Ind., a few miles from the BMW Championship at Crooked Stick in Carmel. There won't be time for the Illini to visit the Stick, but rest assured they're plotting ways to get there eventually.

Illini coach rallies as Malm falters on Olympia South's back 9

Mike Small, who knows all about momentum in golf, thought the final round of the 95th Illinois PGA Championship turned on the 14th and 15th holes on Olympia Fields Country Club's testing South Course, where a brace of birdies drew him into a tie with 36-hole leader Curtis Malm.

As big was what happened next. With Small making pars, Malm three-putted the par-4 16th, missing a four-footer for par, and triple-bogeyed the par-4 17th via a pair of penalty strokes created by excursions into the jungle.

In four holes, Small had gone from two behind to three ahead of Brian Brodell and Travis Johns and four ahead of Malm.

That's a lead someone of Small's caliber will not surrender, especially in a championship he holds so dear and on a course he knows so well.

So it would be. Small's 4-under-par 68 for 10-under 208 earned him a two-stroke victory over Brodell, Malm and Johns on Aug. 31, an auspicious triumph that was a familiar result but hardly routine.

It was the record-extending 12th Illinois Section championship for the head coach of Illinois' men's team, and third on Olympia Fields South. Nobody else has won it on the layout since the

championship returned in 2010 after a 40-year absence.

All 12 of those titles have been won in the 21st century, by a total of 47 strokes, across 36

rounds in which Small is 94-under-par.

This one, though, was different in that the tables turned quickly at the end.

"I feel bad for him, because he played really

well," Small said of Malm, the White Eagle Golf Club head pro who led by three after three holes but never more than two thereafter. "He played great. But the birdies on 14 and 15 were big for me."

They followed a bogey 5 on the 13th that Small kicked himself about going to the 14th tee. At that point, Malm, despite missing a 15-foot birdie putt on the 13th, was 11-under and led by two strokes.

"If (Curtis) makes the birdie putt on 13 and I miss the bogey putt, it's a three-shot swing, tournament over," Small said. "Instead, it's a one-shot swing and I birdie the next two holes."

He made an 18-footer to cut the lead to one on the par-3 14th, and a solid 10-footer on the

15th made tied Malm for the lead and set up, effectively, a three-hole showdown for the title. It was over after two holes.

"If I don't make birdies right away, it's over," Small said. "That's momentum in golf. I talk to my team about that: Individual momentum, making birdies on top of birdies. He had control of the thing all day today on me and Travis."

Malm was, literally, bloodied but unbowed. He had three nasty scrapes on his right hand from seeing if he could play the tee ball that went wayward to the right on the penultimate hole. Instead, he gashed himself.

"I got in there and I took the club back a little bit to see if I would catch any resistance, and everything just kind of leaped on me," Malm said.

"It was an easy call to take the unplayable. Drop it, catch another tree and hit it in the junk, take another unplayable, and then almost hole it and miss another putt. It would have been the greatest bogey anybody had ever seen."

"I didn't make the greatest swing in the world on 17, but if that ball bounces anywhere but directly back, I chip out and make 5. It's a different ball game. What are you gonna do?"

Small began to win the title back on the 203-yard par-3 fifth, where his knockdown 3-iron went for the cup like an arrow, finishing eight inches from tumbling in. It was not only the only birdie of the day on the hole, it was the shot of the championship.

"It was just perfect all the way," Small re-

called. "It drew about five yards right in there."

And sent a message. Small started the final round tied for third place at 6-under, two strokes behind Malm, with Johns at 7-under. Small parred the first four holes and was still two back.

"That was huge," he said. "I'd played some good shots on the first four holes but I couldn't make a birdie."

He would make five more thereafter. Even a meaningless bogey at the last didn't take his smile away.

Malm didn't collect the first prize of \$11,200, but didn't feel all that bad when looking at the week as a whole. He'd led after one round with a 4-under 68 and paced the field at 8-under 136 after the rain-delayed second round concluded.

"For as not well as I thought I played, I finished second again," Malm said. "That's three in five years. But like I said here three years ago, some day he's going to retire and seconds turn into firsts."

Johns, the teaching pro at Medinah Country Club, had seemed to play himself out of it after opening 3-over on the first six holes, but birdied three in a row and four of five starting at the ninth to race home in 71 and 208 for a share of second. Brodell, the boss at Mistwood Golf Club, was even faster, with eight birdies and three bogeys for a 5-under 67 to reach the same total. But starting five strokes behind Malm, he had no illusions about his chances.

"None," Brodell said. "Not against Curtis and Travis and the greatest club pro in history."

There's a new title for the 50-year-old Small. And here's one more goal. The oldest to win the Illinois PGA is Gary Groh, who was 57 when he won in a playoff at Kemper Lakes in 2002.

The fellow Groh beat? Mike Small, his only

The Moore, the merrier

Victory in Silvis comes after long wait for Tour veteran

Tiger Woods used to have a saying about the U.S. Open: "Avoid double bogey."

Everybody has one about the John Deere Classic: "Avoid bogey."

Nobody did that better this year than Ryan Moore. He made only two in the course of 72 holes and none in the final 46 holes. That was the foundation of his victory in a field that was missing defending champion Jordan Spieth, who skipped it after passing on the concurrently-played Olympics, on August 14 at TPC Deere Run.

Of course, there was more to it for Moore. A slew of birdies always helps on a course with wide fairways and flattish greens. To that point, Moore thought the key to victory was a 24-foot birdie putt on the final round's fourth hole.

Bagging his second birdie of the day moved him to 20 under and kept him two strokes ahead of Morgan Hoffmann, who was about to birdie the fifth hole.

"That was huge to get (a second) birdie early, just to show the guys behind me I'm not messing around," Moore said. "The worst thing to do is to be even or 1-over after five or six holes. Then all of a sudden you've got 10 guys think-

ing, ‘All right, I can go get this today.’”

His opponents may have been thinking that, but the notion went unfulfilled. Moore scored 4-under-par 67 to finish at 22-under 262 for a two-stroke margin over Ben Martin and five over Hoffman and South Korea’s Whee Kim.

It had been two years since Moore’s last win, a successful defense of the CIMB Classic in Malaysia, and he hadn’t won in the United States since a 2012 victory in Las Vegas.

Since then, he’d battled a nagging shoulder injury, but now is completely healthy and taking advantage, as winning the Deere and subsequent top-10 finishes in the first two playoff tournaments have shown.

Those high finishes were no doubt influenced by winning the Deere. But where did that return to form come from? Part of it came from the course itself. Moore and Deere Run get along.

“It’s a course I’ve grown to like over the years,” Moore said. “Some courses set up well for me and this is definitely one of them. There are angles of play, and that means guys who hit it longer than me don’t have a significant advantage.”

He went around Deere Run in three straight 65s before his closing 67. Consistency at a high level will earn a pile of cash on the PGA Tour, and sometimes a trophy.

“Every win is a little different,” Moore said. “I like how steady this was, with no bogeys on the weekend.”

Hoffman and Martin pushed hard on Saturday, when they scored third-round 62s, finishing in the moonlight and by the illumination created by the big video screen at the 18th green. The tournament had been socked by an immense thunderstorm on Thursday that turned the schedule on its ear.

Martin could only manage 68 in the final round.

“I never got a whole lot going,” Martin said. “I just told (Moore), ‘You couldn’t make one bogey out there for me today?’ Hats off to him for just a solid round of golf. I don’t think he really ever sniffed a bogey.”

Kim’s closing 67 and Hoffman’s 71 placed them joint third at 17-under 267.

“I just wanted to make a putt, which didn’t happen all day,” Hoffmann said. “In the middle of

the round, it kind of went sideways.”

Not for Moore, who hit 13 of 14 fairways in the final round and 14 of 18 greens in regulation, including the 18th, which he two-putted from 47 feet for the victory.

The early talk of the week had been Wesley Bryan, the new kid on the PGA Tour block after winning his third web.com tournament the previous week, and thus earning his card on the big circuit. He finished in an eighth-place tie at 14-under 270, eight strokes in arrears of Moore.

McIlroy, big hitters tackle the Stick

There were two defending champions at this year's BMW Championship as the tournament got under way at Crooked Stick Golf Club on Thursday, Sept. 8.

There was Jason Day, who ran off and hid last year at Conway Farms Golf Club.

Then there was Rory McIlroy, who won at Crooked Stick four years ago, and returned to the scene of the sublime as the winner Monday at the Deutsche Bank Championship.

These two superstars answered as many questions about a third party on Wednesday than they did about their games or their chances at Crooked Stick, where the BMW – the 113th Western Open to old-timers, and 10th played under the largess of the German auto and motorcycle maker – commenced with a threatening weather forecast on Thursday morning, one that proved correct.

The line of questioning that strayed from their own game was to be expected, for the third party was Tiger Woods, who announced in the late morning that he hopes to return to competition next month. Both were eager to see the 40-year-old, who has accomplished everything in the game, including capturing the Western / BMW five times, in action after so much inaction.

"This time I think he's done it the right way by waiting and not coming back too soon," Day

said. "I'm definitely looking forward to watching those tournaments and seeing how his body holds up and how the mental side and obviously the golf side of things hold up as well."

McIlroy, like Day, was curious about now only how Woods plays, but how he plays in com-



parison to how he has played, and warned against unfair comparisons against his halcyon years.

"That 10-year stretch (of 13 major titles among 58 PGA Tour wins) is the best stretch of golf we have ever seen on the planet by anyone," McIlroy said. "I don't care what anyone says

about Jack Nicklaus' record or anyone else, that 10-year stretch of golf was the best.

"People are going to expect him to go out at Napa and play well, and it's going to take time. It's a process. Sometimes you have to take the bigger picture. I'm sure he's sort of thinking play at Napa, but the long-term goal is if he can get himself ready for the Masters next year, that's where he wants to be."

There were 69 players – British Open Henrik Stenson champion was missing, resting his bum right knee, which has a torn meniscus, for the Ryder Cup – chasing two things: The \$1,530,000

first prize from the announced purse of \$8.5 million, and the top 30 places in the PGA Tour's point standings for eligibility in the Tour Championship at East Lake Golf Club.

Of Day and McIlroy, McIlroy may have the edge. Day had never even seen the course until his pro-am time on Wednesday afternoon. McIlroy said he remembered every hole. But with almost every top player in the world on hand aside from Stenson, picking a winner is like picking a favorite cloud on a windy day. Wait a minute and there's another choice.

Day, announced as Jordan Day on the first tee

on Thursday – the announcer apologized but the gaffe made ESPN's *SportsCenter* – opened with a 1-over 73 that left him eight strokes adrift of first round leader Roberto Castro – definitely from the "another choice" wing of the field. McIlroy started with a 68.

Crooked Stick was soft after the long delay, which helped scoring. Crowds poured in early each of the first two days, eager to see stars in only the third visit of the circuit to greater Indianapolis since the last 500 Festival Open in 1968. The 1991 PGA Championship, won by John Daly, was the other visit.

IPGA's Birdies for Charity raises \$232,000

He's the fourth recipient of a BMW Hole-in-One Scholarship, which provides a full tuition and housing grant in the name of the first player to record a hole-in-one at the BMW Championship in a particular year.

In addition to caddieing for both Prairie View Golf Club and Wood Wind Golf Club in Indiana during high school, Bauschka also volunteered as a collector for Bottle Caps for Cancer, while

maintaining a 4.37 GPA. He attends Purdue University and is pursuing a degree in construction engineering management.

"The opportunity that the BMW Hole-in-One Scholarship has afforded me is immeasurable and is allowing me to pursue my degree in engineering without a financial burden," said Bauschka in a Western Golf Association release. "I am extremely grateful to BMW, the WGA and of course Jordan Spieth for the shot that made this possible."
