Oak Meadows' name game

It's not often a golf course changes names. Once a course is called Old Birdie or Hickory Hollow, that's usually it.

Now comes **Ed Stevenson** at Oak Meadows, the municipally-owned course in Wood Dale – which in incarnation No. 1 was Elmhurst Country Club – with the news that Oak Meadows, slated to reopen next spring if the winter is kind, will do so under a new moniker.

You have a chance to select it.

The DuPage County Forest Preserve District will hold a name the course competition, much like name the team affairs new sports teams often hold.

When the multi-million dollar renovation designed by **Greg Martin** is completed, players will see a 288-acre preserve with 100 acres of restored habitat, 25 acres of new wetlands, and 18 improved holes of golf on a footprint that will hold 20 million more gallons of Salt Creek rainwater than before. That should alleviate flooding upstream, downstream, and on the course.

But what to call it?

At press time, there was no link on either the Oak Meadows or DuPage FPD website to enter a name, but nominations are being taken. Call Oak Meadows at (630) 595-0071 for more information.

There's no word on the last time he teed it up at Jackson Park or South Shore, the two courses being considered for a revamping and closest to his home and the proposed presidential library.

Obama, with more than 300 round played in his term, ranks third on the presidential rounds-played-in-office list, behind Woodrow Wilson (about 1,200) and Dwight D. Eisenhower (about 800).

DUKE CUT LOOSE: Robert Duke is out as the Illinois PGA's tournament director after two years. Illinois PGA executive director **Carrie Williams**, who held that post before helming the Illinois Junior Golf Association, has started a national search for a new tournament director.

BODY FOUND: Course workers found a woman's body on the edge of the White Pines Golf Course in Bensenville early Sept. 29. Police said the 37-year-old was murdered earlier in the morning in the 11500 block of Grand Ave., near the course.

Jonathan Condrey, 44, was charged with first degree murder, according to the Cook County sheriff's department. Condrey and the woman, not immediately identified, had been arguing at their apartment, police said.

THE BARE FACTS: An outing billed as a fund-raiser for the Make-A-Wish Foundation at River Lakes Golf Course in downstate Columbia on Sept. 27 turned out to be something else again.

Organizer **Dennis Daugherty Jr.** was charged with one count of deceptive

practice by the Monroe County state's attorney's office after it was discovered Make-A-Wish had nothing to do with the outing. Suspicion was raised when reports surfaced that there were nude women on the course, some performing sex acts, according to police, the *Bellevue News-Democrat* reported.

"We are dealing with it and trying to address all of the bad conduct," Columbia police chief **Jerry Paul** told the *News-Democrat*. "We want to make sure nothing like this happens again. The majority of fundraisers are done legitimately and are done the right way. We don't want anyone doing things the wrong way like this."

Three officers were sent to the course while the outing was underway but saw nothing untoward.

"They were looking for any kind of bad conduct that day, but they missed some," Paul said.

Daugherty was arrested Oct. 18, and later freed after posting \$150 bond. The case is pending.

"There were a few girls that got out of hand and the media got ahold of the pictures," Daugherty said in a Facebook posting titled "Drama Drama Drama," in which he said he hadn't filled out Make-A-Wish paperwork. "It was in poor taste of me to mix the two but it happened. I only had good intentions with this event but I'm being made out to be this horrible person by the media, which I am not."

Make-A-Wish said Daugherty had never contacted the organization.

Why aren't there more here like Dave Ryan?

What Dave Ryan accomplished at Old Warson Country Club on Sept. 22 doesn't happen too often. Ryan won a United States Golf Association championship.

For all our criticism of the USGA, from rules fiascos to killing off the Public Links championships, the group still stands tall in golf, and to capture a USGA title is a highlight for anyone.

So why don't Illinoisans win more often?

In fact, why don't Illinoisans win more often in any national competition? Whether it's the PGA Tour, LPGA, major amateur, men or women, you name the title or the series, it just doesn't happen very often.

Bill Shean was the last Illinoisan before Ryan to win a USGA crown when he captured his second U.S. Senior Amateur, at Charlotte Country Club in 2000. He won the same title at Skokie Country Club in 1998. Now Ryan has captured the same bauble.

Before that, you have to go back to Martha Lang, who lived in Geneva when she won the 1988 U.S. Women's Mid-Amateur. (If there was someone in between, please let us know.)

Across the pond, both Shean, in 1999, and Joel Hirsch, in 1996 and 2000, won the R&A's British Seniors Amateur.

On the professional side, currently there's Kevin Streelman and D.A. Points, raised in Winfield and Pekin, respectively, and both two-time

winner on the PGA Tour. Streelman has more recently, in Hartford in 2014, while Points' last win was the 2013 Houston Open, one that created far less a stir than his 2011 victory at Pebble Beach, where he was partnered with Bill Murray on the pro-am side.

As our Tour Guide column on page 17 notes, they're on the PGA Tour with a handful of others, imported and home-grown, who are looking for that breakthrough victory.

In a men's major championship, you have

to go back to Belleville's Bob Goalby in the 1968 Masters to find a winner, and before that, Woodson's Jerry Barber in the 1961 PGA at Olympia Fields – the only Illinoisan to win a major in Illinois.

On the distaff side, there's been much less success. Nancy Scranton, who hails from Centralia, won three LPGA tournaments, most recently in 2000. More recently? There hasn't even been a regular from the state on the LPGA circuit since Berwyn native Nicole Jeray went back to the Symetra Tour a while back.

For a major, you have to go all the way back to June Beebe of Niles, who won a pair of Women's Western Opens as an amateur in the 1930s.

The senior circuit? No, sir. Transplants Jeff Sluman and Chip Beck – we welcome all – haven't exactly broken the trophy case doors down. Sluman, not yet a Chicagoan when he won the 1988 PGA at Oak Tree, last won an individual tournament on the 50-plus tour in 2011, at Pebble Beach. Beck won once in his senior career, in Japan in 2007, and is out of competitive golf, working as a club in Naples, Fla.

After that, the cup board is bare. It shouldn't be that way. Dave Ryan ought to have company, if not in senior golf, but for headlines.

Maybe it'll be Streelman, who made early noise in the Sanderson Farms Championship. Maybe it'll be someone else.

But who?

Palmer remembered around the world

nationally on two cable networks and highlighted everywhere; the continuing tributes filled magazine covers and pages upon pages. This was no surprise. The impact he made on the marketing of the game will be felt forever.

What there will not be, in Arnold Palmer's absence, is another Arnold Palmer. Like the impact he made for over 60 years, Arnold Palmer is irreplaceable.

'A guy from Taylorville' wins it all

Dave Ryan scores 2 up victory in championship to collect his first USGA title

Since becoming eligible to play senior golf seven years ago, Taylorville's Dave Ryan had piled up a bevy of honors. He'd won three Illinois Senior Amateurs, a pair of CDGA Senior Amateurs, and had been named the CDGA's Senior Player of the Year six times.

In whatever he enters, the 62-year-old is the guy to beat, and generally unbeatable.

On Thursday, Sept. 22, came his career highlight. Ryan, after storming to a big lead, hung on to beat Matthew Sughrue, 2 up, to capture the 62nd U.S. Senior Amateur at Old Warson Country Club in St. Louis.

Ryan led 4 up after six holes, winning the second through sixth holes – with four birdies and a par – after losing the first, and kept that margin through 10 holes. Just when it looked like a rout, Sughrue, a 57-year-old resident of Arlington, Va., rallied, winning the 11th through 13th with a par and a brace of birdies.

Ryan's margin was trimmed to 1 up. It was time for an attitude adjustment. It came after he missed a par putt on the 438-yard 15th hole and

saw Sughrue, an accomplished player, square the match. Now it was anything but a rout.

“I got more aggressive after that,” Ryan said. “And I got back in battle mode, I guess is what you call it.

“I was trying to hang on and that’s when you get in trouble. You start getting the old steering wheel out and start steering it instead of letting it go.”

Ryan won the par-5 16th with a par, and closed the deal with a par to Sughrue’s bogey at the 445-yard finishing hole after a dazzling par save on the 17th.

But the match turned on the previous hole, when Sughrue went for what Ryan called “a sucker pin” on the left side of the par 5s putting surface and missed the green. That’s how Ryan won the hole with a 5.

“If you go for that and miss left, you’re dead,” Ryan said.

“That was really one of my few bad swings of the day, the third shot there,” Sughrue said. “I just had the perfect club and I felt it was time to knock it close and take control of the match. I never thought I would pull it over there. It was just a shock to me when I looked up and it was going left. I couldn’t believe it.

“That’s golf.”

Of such small margins championships are decided. But the buildup, Ryan’s front nine of 3-under 32, was built on great putting. And inspiration backed by knowledge.

“My son (Zac) gave me a video to watch from Dave Stockton, and he’s a great putter,” Ryan said of the two-time PGA Championship winner and putting guru. “I took some of his tips and I – it’s like shooting free throws – you get over it, see the

line, and let it go. And it worked this week.”

Ryan watched the video about two weeks before, and used the tip to win the Illinois Senior Amateur by nine strokes, his largest margin in three victories in that affair.

That electronic schooling was the springboard to his success at Old Warson, a course not often in the headlines but with fine pedigree. It hosted the 1971 Ryder Cup and, with Bellerive and St. Louis Country Club, is one of the top clubs in the metropolitan area.

Sughrue, said Ryan, “had about five or six lip-outs. If they go in, I lose. So you got to have some luck.”

Putts by Sughrue on the 14th, 16th and 17th

appeared ready to fall, and did not.

“On 14, I can’t believe it snapped left, and the ones on 16 and 17 were clearly going down,” Sughrue said. “They were center cut. But it just didn’t happen. He got it up-and-down (on 17) and that’s a sign of a great champion.”

Luck follows Ryan around like a hungry puppy. In the semifinal, he took down medalist Tim Jackson. In the round of 16, Ryan knocked off Paul Simson in part by scoring a hole-in-one on the 270-yard par-4 14th hole. That albatross was only the third known 1 on a par-4 in USGA history.

“I was down, so I was trying to drive the green,” Ryan said. “I hit a little trap draw with my driver. When you do something like that, it’s all luck.”

Ryan went on to beat Simson in 20 holes. The ace pulled him even, but Simson won the next two holes and was dormie 2 heading to the 17th tee. Ryan won the 17th with a birdie 2, and won the last with a par 4. A par on the 20th, against Simson’s three-putt bogey, advanced him to the quarterfinals.

Simson had won the 2010 U.S. Senior Amateur, when Ryan scored his best previous finish, losing in the round of 16.

Just being at Old Warson brought Ryan full circle. It was where he first qualified for a USGA competition, the 1986 U.S. Amateur, when he was a tyke of 32.

On his return visit, he lifted the Frederick Dold Trophy.

“Unbelievable, for a guy from Taylorville, Ill., to win a national championship,” Ryan said.

Not really. Not to those who have seen Dave Ryan play.

Red Devils dominate state

Hinsdale Central wins 3A boys, 3rd in AA girls

Hinsdale Central's fingerprints were all over the largest classes in the IHSA's championships the weekend of Oct. 14-15.

Senior Brendan O'Reilly scored the individual title in Class 3A, scoring 69-73-142, 2-under-par at the Den at Fox Creek in Bloomington, earning a five-stroke victory over Ethan Farnam of Prairie Ridge.

The dominant victory by the two time Illinois Junior champ and recent Illinois signee helped his Red Devils teammates to a 23-stroke victory in the team championship – their fifth straight – over New Trier.

Hinsdale Central finished at 17-over-par 593, with the scores of Matt Wingren (149), Josh Lundmark (151), Gabe Larson (157) and Mac McClear (158) counting in one or both rounds.

The Red Devils' girls team's chance for a third straight Class AA title at Hickory Point Golf Course in Forsyth was ended by Wheaton Warrenville South, which scored 29-over 605 to beat Barrington by seven strokes and Hinsdale Central by eight.

Grace Curran of Lincoln-Way Central won the AA individual title with 70-71-141, 3-under at Hickory Point, beating Lauren Beaudreau of

Benet Academy by a stroke.

- Luke Armbrust of Wheaton St. Francis took the 2A boys crown with 74-74-147, 5-under and a stroke better than Tyler Andersen of Mundelein Carmel. Illinois State University High took the team championship on its home course in Normal.

- Trent Snodgrass of Byron won the 1A boys title, scoring 70-76-146, 2-over to win by two

strokes. That paced the Tigers to a 72-over 648 finish and an eight-stroke victory over Aurora Christian at Prairie Vista in Bloomington.

- Charleston's Lauren Chappel scored 74-75-149, the 5-over finish earning the Class A girls championship, and helping the Trojans to a seven-stroke victory over Nashville at Red Tail Run in Decatur. **Results on Page 10.**

Dustin' the field again

Johnson collects second BMW title in dominating fashion

Bulldozing the field doesn't make for dramatic golf. That depends on birdies and bogeys being bounced back and forth among the leaders on a Sunday afternoon.

When the leader yields bogeys early, then goes on a birdie binge, the drama cannot be manufactured.

It is instead replaced by awe. That's the only way to watch Dustin Johnson these days. The big hitter won the U.S. Open in June by overpowering Oakmont and outlasting the United States Golf Association's rulesmakers. He captured the big payday at Firestone, another big hitter's lay-out, in his next start.

On Sun., Sept. 11, his final round 5-under-par 67 at Crooked Stick Golf Club allowed him a three-stroke victory over Paul Casey in the BMW Championship. His total of 265 wasn't a tournament record – and the numbers go back to the first Western Open in 1899 all the way to this 113th edition – but his score in relation to par, a gaudy 23 under, is.

He was 15-under on the par-5s, the best known

number by a winner. He's won the old championship twice in the last seven playings, including his one-stroke victory over Casey on Cog Hill's Dubsdread course in 2010.

The numbers tell the story. Johnson used a combination of power (first in driving distance this week, averaging 308.6 yards), accuracy (hitting 52 greens in regulation), and, having selected a new putter, precise putting (only 103 putts during the week, fewest by a Western Open / BMW winner since at least 2003, and only two three-putt greens, both on Sunday). What's not to like?

"I've got a lot of confidence," he said on the 18th green after a tap-in wrapped up his \$1.53 million triumph. "This week, the putter really worked."

Everything worked. Johnson was two strokes off leader Roberto Castro after 18 holes, tied with him through 36, and led Casey by three entering the final round.

Johnson led by four after a birdie at the first. A few minutes later, it looked like a battle, as Johnson bogeyed the second and third and Casey birdied them. It appeared that Casey, who lost a three-stroke last Monday at the Deutsche Bank Championship, had a chance at his first PGA Tour win in seven years. But Johnson birdied four of the next five holes and began the runaway, cheered on by the gallery of about 28,000 on a sunny day.

It was sealed at the par-5 15th, which he eagled for the second time in three days moments after Casey did so. Johnson's opponent had thrown his best punch and the big guy never felt it.

"That was the turning point," Johnson said.

The duo parred in and Casey matched Johnson's 67, as did Castro, who finished at 17-under

271, which would have won eight of the last 12 Western / BMWs. Instead, it got him third place, and five strokes ahead of the quintet of Ryan Palmer, Adam Scott, Matt Kuchar, J.B. Holmes and Charl Schwartzel in fourth.

Schwartzel's bogey-free 8-under 64 was the round of the day on the third straight day of lift, clean and place in fairways and closely-mown areas, one reason the scoreboard glowed red.

Johnson likely would have won no matter what the rules. The wedge game that he worked so hard over the winter on is the key to his big year.

"I know if I'm driving it well and hitting it in the fairway and get a wedge in my hand I'm going to have good looks at birdies," Johnson said. "Today I hit a lot of great wedge shots. It started on the first hole."

His 122-yard sand wedge stopped 4 feet 7 inches from the cup. He sank 21 and 7 footers on the fourth and fifth holes, dropped a 120-yard wedge 4 feet from the hole on the seventh, and sank a 5-footer for birdie on the eighth. He was 21-under with 10 holes to play. Casey would have been excused if he had melted away, but he hung in there, to no avail.

Deere raises \$10.5 million for charity

Record surpasses 2015 by near \$1.8 million; covers 491 causes

Maybe playing in August wasn't so back for the John Deere Classic after all.

Tournament officials announced Mon., Oct. 31 that the 2016 playing helped raise a record \$10.5 million for 491 local and regional Quad Cities charities, ranking it among the top three in charitable giving on the PGA Tour.

The total of \$10,503,791, contributed by 17,848 donors, is nearly \$1.8 million more than the previous record of \$8.73 million set last year, officials said at a news conference at John Deere World Headquarters in Moline.

In addition to being a record John Deere Classic charity total, it's the fifth consecutive year in which the tournament has helped raise over \$6 million for local charities.

Tournament officials also announced that all 491 charities participating in the Birdies for Charity program will receive a 10 percent bonus over and above the funds they raised, double the promised five percent.

This means a charity that raised \$10,000 via the Birdies pledge program would receive an additional \$1,000.

"Everyone associated with the John Deere

Classic is extremely proud and appreciative that individual donors, companies and family foundations stepped up in a big way to make this year's charitable contribution by far the largest in tournament history," said John Deere Classic tournament director Clair Peterson.

This year's charity number brings to more than \$81.3 million the total amount of charitable contributions provided to the Quad Cities

community since the tournament began its annual run in the Quad Cities in 1971.

The \$10.5 million total works out to \$28.10 for each of the Quad Cities' 375,000 residents, making the John Deere Classic No. 1 in per capita giving on the circuit, a distinction it has held for many years. The tournament moved to among the top three in charitable giving from among the top 10.

The 17,848 donors averaged \$588.51 per contributor.

A combination of increased tournament revenues, direct donations to the Birdies for Charity Bonus Fund, and a John Deere Foundation matching grant of \$325,000 to the Bonus Fund enabled the tournament to provide the 10 percent match for the fourth consecutive year, officials said.

Moreover, Deere & Company underwrites the administrative costs of the Birdies for Charity program, including staff, thereby guaranteeing that 100 percent of every dollar donated goes directly to the donor's designated charity.

Peterson noted the 10 percent bonus in explaining how charitable giving spiked \$1.8 million just one year after increasing by more than \$2 million, praising the generosity of Quad City residents and sponsor John Deere.

Want to buy a (another) golf course?

In September ILLINOIS GOLFER reported on for-sale signs going up at WeaverRidge Golf Course, the upscale public course on the west side of Peoria. The 19-year-old course is listed at \$4.5 million by Links Capital Advisors.

Now LCA has added another course to its listings: Antioch Golf Club, a 94-year-old 18 hole facility in Antioch, can be yours for \$950,000.

The difference in price is largely because Antioch, a 6,200-yard layout with an 8,000-square foot clubhouse and a full-size range, has both a smaller footprint and was paid off generations ago.

Additionally, owner Doug Brucker has put Railside Golf Course in Gibson City on the block, though he's not promoting a price.

"We want to sell it as a golf course," Brucker, Railside's third owner, told the *Champaign News-Gazette*. "I mean, we don't want to do anything else."

Railside, which opened in 1993, is the only golf course in Ford County.

Brucker said if he couldn't find a buyer, there the option was there to close the course, which has been losing rounds in recent years.

"It just takes 5 1/2, 6 hours to play a round of golf, and the millennials don't want to play as much, I guess," Brucker said.

The news of these three courses on sale is also a sign of the times. Balmoral Woods has been

for sale for \$1.35 million for more than a year, to name a prominent course.

Seven courses in the greater Chicago area have changed hands in the last few years. Five others have been closed (including the about to close Blackhawk Trace at Indian Lakes Resort golf facility, for which the last online tee time is Nov. 15) since 2014, either with or without a sale.

If golf was booming, or even holding steady, this wouldn't be happening.

In other words, the shakeout continues.

There's no reason to think that Antioch, Balmoral Woods or WeaverRidge won't continue operations with or without a sale.

The churn in the business since the Great Recession of 2007 is something that hasn't been seen in golf in this state since the 1930s.

That's when the Great Depression forced the closure of many courses, fun places with forgotten names like Crystal Lawns, Oakshore Beach and Casa Del Mar.
