Lansing CC to close

It never hosted a big tournament, unless you're talking about bocce ball, and the scorecard has to be seen to be disbelieved, but the members of Lansing Country Club will miss their 175-acre oasis from the mad swirl of the rest of the world when it's gone.

That will be after this season. Lansing's membership, which has been declining from year to year, is selling the club for \$5 million. The property has been bought by Chase Development, with the Indiana side slated to become an industrial park. Plans for the smaller Illinois portion are uncertain.

The sale was forced by Illinois' high property taxes. According to the *Times of Northwest Indiana*, Lansing paid about \$10,000 annually in Indiana property tax, but about \$150,000 annually for to Illinois, up from \$30,000 a decade earlier. If not for an appeal, the annual Illinois tab would have been \$180,000.

The members saw the writing on the wall – and the checks they were paying – and sold.

The Illinois side was the original nine, and it was a par-3 course flanked by a pair of large lakes that produced more good fishermen than golfers. Indeed, for decades from the 1940 founding the facility was known as the Lansing Sportsman's Club. Golf was No. 3 behind fishing and hunting.

The direction changed when the vacant land in Indiana was picked up and a regulation-size nine was built. Now the course measured 4,763 yards with a par of 67.

But Lansing is more famous for the death of the

great "Champagne" Tony Lema than anything else. The plane carrying Lema, his wife Betty and the two pilots crashed on the course's seventh hole, apparently out of fuel just short of the nearby Lansing Municipal Airport, on July 24, 1966, killing all aboard. Lema had finished tied for 34th in the PGA Championship at Firestone Country Club hours earlier, and was slated to play in the Lincolnshire Open the next day.

Since 2011, a plaque commemorating Lema has been at the seventh hole.

KUDOS TO JERAY: Berwyn native **Nicole Jeray**, spending much of her time on the Symetra Tour lately, finished seventh at 4-over-par 220 in the inaugural Senior LPGA Championship at the French Lick Resort's Pete Dye Course. Jeray's check for \$16,827 was one of her bigger paydays in some time.

No thanks to a rebuilding of Jackson Park

There has been a great deal written about the proposed rebuilding of the public golf courses at Jackson Park and South Shore on Chicago's South Side.

Proponents believe the rebuild, originally priced at \$30 million – of which the city would kick in only \$6 million – would both revitalize the neighborhood in conjunction with the planned Obama Presidential Center in an adjacent part of Jackson Park, plus give city residents a championship golf course.

Detractors believe the project would wipe out two current courses that are both affordable and popular with area residents, and note that everything from tennis courts to a dog park to a nature preserve to baseball and softball fields would be sacrificed for the glory of a course that might cost non-residents \$200 to play.

This being Chicago, the hidden hand was quickly identified. Michael Ruemmler worked for Rahm Emanuel when the current mayor of Chicago was president Obama's chief of staff. Ruemmler plays golf and knows how to pull political strings.

The public face is Mark Rolfing, the DeKalb native and Kapalua, Hawaii, resident who became intrigued by the possibilities when undergoing cancer treatment at the University of Chicago Hospitals.

It was Rolfing that convinced budding course architect Tiger Woods to consider the project after designers Tom Doak and Bill Coore nixed helping.

They were the smart ones.

This is a solution for a problem that does not exist.

Nobody asked for a rebuilt course with increased green fees.

Nobody asked for 27 holes to be shrunken to 18 – along with a six-hole mini-course for children.

Nobody asked for an expanded practice range.

Nobody asked for two streets to be closed to add congestion to busy Stony Island Ave.

Nobody asked for underpasses that would likely cost upwards of an additional \$20 million – all city money – for the streets that aren't being closed. (That would run the total to \$50 million before lakefront work is considered.)

Nobody asked for any of this, but here came Rolfing on his white horse, and Chicago Park District superintendent Tom Kelly alongside, saying this would revitalize golf in Chicago, create caddie work for neighborhood youths, attract the BMW Championship, and so yawn.

Nonsense.

Kelly admitted to his public at the first meeting on the topic that public golf in Chicago is struggling at the current prices, that Marquette Park's operation, to name one, runs at a loss. (The operation is contracted out to Billy Casper Golf, a privately-owned company.)

If people aren't playing golf at \$30, who would pay \$50 if they lived in the city, or come from the suburbs to play at \$200? That's insane.

One proponent of the project said the idea was to revitalize the neighborhood. Certainly, the

immediate area around Jackson Park and South Shore – indeed, one of the neighborhoods is named after the old country club – is among the poorest and most crime-ridden in Chicago. Any good idea would be welcomed.

But a \$200 golf course that is unlikely to be frequented by the monied is not a good idea. It will not bring ancillary business to area restaurants and the like. Nor would a seven-day tournament. Just ask the restauranteurs of Lemont's quarry area, which expected more business during early Western Opens down the street at Cog Hill, only to find spectators went to the tournament, ate on Pork Chop Hill, and went home.

If the president of BMW North America didn't want to keep the renamed Western Open at Cog Hill, and rejected the idea of playing at Olympia Fields because the club is south of the Loop, well, Jackson Park isn't exactly in Lake Forest.

That's where that last three Chicago-area BMWs – including this September's – have been set, at Conway Farms Golf Club. The 2019 edition is lined up for Medinah Country Club, the big west suburban golf factory.

That's a long way from Jackson Park.

If we were talking about a vacant 160 acres or so on a brownfield that could be turned from eyesore to paradise, this would be a great idea, a plus.

This is not a plus. This is a minus, taking affordable golf from the public. No thanks. Not one more penny of public money should be spent on this boondoggle.

Once Moore, with feeling?

There's a certain cachet to being a defending champion.

Your face goes on posters and billboards around the town the tournament is played in. Your name is mentioned more often. There's extra applause when you step to the first tee in the opening round. You know you've won on the course you're returning to.

It's fun, this defending champion business.

Ryan Moore knows how to handle it. He's defended successfully before, winning back-to-back titles in the CIMB Classic in Malaysia in 2013 and 2014.

Now he gets a chance in the U.S., at TPC Deere Run at the 47th John Deere Classic.

"Last time I just kind of showed up and was comfortable on the course that I had won on, and kind of went out and did the same thing," Moore recalled in advance of the Deere. "It added up to a win again."

"Every win is different. Every week is different. I've had some success here. I've played some good golf over the years here. It's a place I'm very comfortable. I've still got to show up and play really good golf again and see where that lands me on Sunday."

This time, Moore saw the billboard.

"That was pretty cool when I left my hotel and saw that," Moore said of his trip to Deere Run on Monday of tournament week. "I've never seen myself on a billboard before, so it was cool. It's great to see that and to get to be a part of that, to be appreciated for what I did here last year."

"It motivates me to try and come back and do it again."

It's rare for a defending champion not to defend, though that was the case with Jordan Spieth last year, because the Deere was scheduled against the Olympics, and Spieth, while eligible for Rio, chose not to go, and then decided not to play the Deere because of the optics involved.

Now a defending champion once removed,

he's not coming this year either, preferring to arrive at Royal Birkdale, site of this year's British Open, a few days early rather than take the Deere-provided charter and arrive Monday afternoon, Birkdale time.

He'll face a field including rising star Daniel Berger, who has gone back-to-back in Memphis the last two years, and who nearly beat Spieth in Hartford a fortnight ago, only to be derailed by Spieth's holeout birdie from the bunker in sudden-death. Tenth on the money list, Berger's a Deere rookie, using the week as a tune-up for Birkdale the way many pros do, and as Spieth has in the past.

"I may play well, I may not," Berger said. "Regardless, I know I've got something to look

forward to next week as well."

Berger's recent success comes some six months after his switch from TaylorMade to Callaway clubs. The confidence factor is finally there.

"It's just not that easy to do," Berger said. "When you're hitting shots and you think one thing is going to happen and something else happens, that can affect your confidence."

The field also features former champion Brian Harman, Kevin Kisner, Bubba Watson –his first visit since 2010 – plus Adam Hadwin and a quartet of interesting sponsor exemptions: Illinois seniors-to-be Dylan Meyer and Nick Hardy, Stanford standout Maverick McNealy, and new pro Wyndham Clark.

SUMMER PREVIEW

It's a veritable feast of golf

Stephanie Miller, Dylan Meyer and Carlos Sainz Jr. would be a formidable three-ball on any course. They're the defending champions of the three elite championships coming up in the next few weeks.

Miller is the defending champ of the Phil Kossin Illinois Women's Open, set for Mistwood Golf Club in Romeoville from July 17-19. Currently working in the golf shop at Oak Park Country Club, Miller won last year as an amateur, beating fellow am Kelly Grassel by three strokes, and this year will go for the money – a likely \$5,000 first prize – as a pro.

Meyer captured the Western Amateur last year, and will go for a second in succession at Skokie Country Club beginning on Aug. 1. He made the most of a sponsor exemption at the Lincoln Land Charity Championship in Springfield, finishing tied for 63rd at 280, 10 strokes behind playoff winner Adam Schenk, and is also in the John Deere Classic field with Illinois teammate Nick Hardy.

Sainz will be back for another crack at the Illinois Open, the feature of Aug. 7-9 at both The Glen Club, which will host all three rounds, and Briarwood Country Club, the second site for the first and second rounds. Last year, he picked up \$17,500 for beating Christian Heavens by five strokes.

The Illinois Amateur, staged at Calumet

Country Club from July 18-20, doesn't have a defending champion. Nick Hardy, who ran away from the field last year at St. Charles, winning by 10 strokes, wasn't able to fit a defense into his jammed summer schedule.

That, plus the new professional status of two-time winner Tim "Tee-K" Kelly, opens up the field. Former champs Raymond Knoll (2014),

Quinn Prchal (2012) and Todd Mitchell (2002, 2003) are itching to add another title to their resume, while Joliet's Trent Wallace, who made the NCAA final as an individual representing Illinois State, and three-time Illinois Junior winner Brendan O'Reilly are threats. The sponsoring Chicago District Golf Association reports that Knoll's handicap index of plus-5.6 is the best in the field.

63RD WOMEN'S PGA CHAMPIONSHIP

This one was for Dad

The power of belief can carry someone a long way, whether that belief is from within or someone close.

Danielle Kang enjoyed that feeling all week during the 63rd KPMG Women's PGA Championship at Olympia Fields Country Club.

First it was her brother Alex, to whom she turned when she was vexed as to her game plan on Olympia's sturdy North Course.

A veteran of the Fighting Illini Invitational from his college days, he looked at photos she sent him and together, they figured out a plan of attack.

Then she drew on the pleasant memories of conversations and encouragement from her father, K.S., who died of cancer late in 2013. Kang spoke of him in the present tense, and why not, for one of the tattoos on her right hand is "Dad" in his Korean writing.

"He doesn't talk much. However, when he does say something, it means a lot. He's the kind of guy that is very positive. Anything is possible. So I always looked at him like he's magical, because he feels I can do anything," Kang said an hour after the final round.

After, of course, proving him correct by making a two-putt birdie 4 on the final hole of the

final round on July 2 to win the Women's PGA by a stroke over fast-closing defending champion Brooke Henderson.

Kang rolled in a two-foot putt for her fifth birdie of the back nine, an inward 32, a final round 3-under-par 68, and a total of 13-under-par 271 to win for the first time as a professional – and a major championship at that.

She had won back-to-back U.S. Women's Amateurs in 2010 and 2011, so using the Bobby Jones tally system, this is her third major championship overall.

It came in dramatic fashion. She birdied four straight holes starting at the par-4 11th, rolling in 73 feet of putts – 12 feet on the 11th, 25 feet on the 12th, 30 feet on the 13th, and six feet on the 14th after a brilliant approach out of the rough 132 yards distant – to first climb back into a tie for the lead with Henderson and Woon-jung "Chella" Choi, and then build a three-stroke lead.

But Kang failed to save par from a green-side bunker on the par-3 17th, falling to 12-under. Minutes later, Henderson tapped in a 2-inch birdie putt at the last after leading a 30-foot eagle putt that short, and they were tied.

Kang's 233-yard approach from the 18th fairway finished 25 feet below the hole of the reachable par-5. Two putts meant a birdie and victory, but there was work to be done.

"The first putt, I was just more worried about getting that speed right, because it was kind of gusty," Kang said.

It finished two feet short by her estimation.

"Let me tell you, that was the hardest two-footer I've ever had to putt," Kang said. "I had to tell myself, 'Danielle, you don't miss two-footers, so just putt it.'

"It was pretty nerve-wracking, but I just did it."

It fell perfectly, the last of 40 birdies on the final hole on Sunday. Kang is the first to win with a birdie at the last in the LPGA / Women's PGA since Meg Mallon in 1991.

"I just wanted to finish it off after a rocky start," Kang said, thinking back to her three-putt bogey on the 10th hole. The four-birdie binge followed immediately.

"That was actually the turning point for me," Kang said of the three-putt. "I said, 'You know what, if I'm going to three-putt from 20 feet, I'm going to learn from it.' Let's just not hit it as hard."

Like a Fourth of July fireworks display, they went boom-boom-boom-boom into the cup the next four holes.

A critical par-save on the par-4 16th via a 19-foot putt kept her at 13-under and made the bogey on the 17th less harmful to the cause.

"It looked like a 50-footer to me," Kang said of the putt on the 16th.

By this point, it was between her and Henderson unless Choi, who bogeyed Nos. 9 and 11 to fall to 9-under, then birdied the 16th, birdied in. She did not, and finished with a par 71 for 10-under 274. Thus, Henderson's birdie-birdie finish for 12-under 272 was the only pressure Kang felt on the back nine. She answered with a flourish.

Henderson, whose defense fell just short, wasn't at all displeased.

"The birdie on 17 meant I had a chance," said Henderson, whose 5-under 66 was the best round

of the day. "On 18, that putt, I took some extra time, walked it twice to get the pace right. Missed it by an inch."

And right in the jaws. This time, Henderson did not score for Canada. Maybe it was that string of pars from the 10th through the 16th that hurt more.

"I had a mix of good putts and some that could have been a bit better," Henderson said. "I can't complain. But if I made one or two, it would have been different."

At one point early Saturday afternoon, there was a seven-way tie at 7-under-par for the lead. Kang, Henderson, Choi, Sei Young Kim, Michelle Wie, Amy Yang and Brittany Lincicome were jammed into the top spot.

When the last putt fell on Olympia Fields Country Club's North Course, only American Kang and South Korean Choi remained on top to set up Sunday's final pair.

Kang had come close before, but in 143 previous starts as a professional had never finished better than in a tie for third, and her best finish in a major was a tie for 22nd in the 2013 LPGA Championship, as this fandango was then named.

The close calls were, of course, nothing compared to losing her dad nearly four years ago after his long battle with brain cancer.

"It's been a really difficult road for me for the past four or five years," Kang said. "It's life, though. You have to pick yourself up and keep working hard at it, then believe in what you're doing."

"I know he (her dad) is here for it. What are

the odds that my first win is a major? I'm pretty sure he had something to do with it. I felt him with me every day, and I still do.

"Over that last putt, for some reason, I remembered him telling me, 'I'll buy you a TV if you make this four-footer at the U.S. Am.' I remembered it. So I wasn't even worried about the putt."

It fell. So, as she told the story, did a tear.

Around Olympia

A severe squall lashed the course and the surrounding area about a hour after Danielle Kang sank the winning putt, blowing much that wasn't nailed down through the air with winds estimated at 60 mph. Some trees were said to have been felled as well. But after that came a rainbow. The pot of gold seemed to be somewhere on the South Course, ticketed for Kang. ... Kang was pelted with pretzels, and then golf tees, by pal Michelle Wie while sitting in a radio booth in the press center and doing one last interview. Kang finally turned around and said, "How old are you?" giggling all the while. ... The field average for Round 4 was 71.853 strokes, moving the overall average of 72.305. Through three days, it was 72.383. The final average for the 2003 U.S. Open was 72.38. Thirty-five players broke par for 72 holes, with another 10 at even par 284. ... World No. 1 So Yeon Ryu finished tied for 14th with a 1-over 72 for 4-under 280, but still made \$47,606. ... World No. 3 Lydia Ko had an awful weekend, finishing 76-76 for 5-over 289. She made \$8,686. ... Attendance was spotty. Only about 300 followed the feature twosome of Wie and Ko around on the front nine on Saturday, and that was the largest gaggle with any group. Add in those in the KPMG

suites and fans parking themselves under a tree by a green, along with various wanderers, and there might have been 6,000 on the grounds over the course of the day. The ticket price of \$30 for a weekend round was a bargain for big-time golf, let alone a major championship. ILLINOIS GOLFER estimated the crowd at 6,500 Sunday, and with 5,000 on Thursday and Friday, 22,500 for the four days.

Friendly visitor

Brooke Henderson, who calls Ontario home and sports sponsorships from Canadian Pacific and the Royal Bank of Canada on her shirts, received plenty of encouragement from the gallery on Saturday. That it was Canada Day, and the country's 150th birthday, helped.

"'Happy Canada Day' a little bit over the course, which is good," Henderson said. "I'm still in fourth place, which is great. Any time you can see your name that close to the top is a really good feeling. And it's disappointing. I would really have liked to have 17 and 18 (a bogey and a par) back. I just hit it through the break."

If there was no tournament that week, Henderson would have done a very Canadian thing.

"I would probably go to my cottage and watch fireworks at night," she said. "This is a very special day back home."

Koepka throttles Erin Hills



Parade of under-par scores rankles traditionalists, but Koepka's bravura performance was modern golf at its finest

Outside of members of his family, Brooks Koepka wasn't anyone's first pick to win the 117th United States Open at the start of the week at Erin Hills.

He's the toast of the town – and destinations beyond – now.

Koepka won the big prize on June 18 with a 5-under-par 67 for 16-under 272, pulling him away from a field of close contenders and pretenders who, like him, had never won a professional major championship.

The 27-year-old Florida native excelled when overnight leader Brian Harman could manage only par 72, when Hideki Matsuyama's best-of-the-day 6-under 66 to match Harman at 12-under 276 was too little, too late, and when the rest of those in the hunt – here's looking at you, Rickie Fowler – barely got a sniff.

Whereas many U.S. Opens are won by the winner fading less than the rest, Koepka went out and won it. He'd grabbed the lead momentarily with a 20-foot birdie putt on the devilish par-3 ninth hole, a hint of what was to come. Bogey on the 10th brought him back to 13-under with Harman, who would bogey the 12th and 13th holes, sliding to 11-under.

Then Koepka made this run:

- a 6-foot birdie putt on the par-5 14th after hitting his 300-yard approach into a bunker, moving him to 14-under and two strokes ahead;

- a 10-foot birdie putt sliding ever so slightly from right to left on the par-4 15th, for a three-stroke lead and all but lock it up – recognized by a baby fist pump;
- and a 15-foot birdie putt on the par-3 16th, to go up by four.

To Koepka, it all started with a par save on the par-3 13th.

"Massive," Koepka said. "I needed to make that if I was going to win this golf tournament. That's the reason I felt I had so much confidence coming down, especially with the par-5 coming

up, knowing you needed to birdie that."

While Koepka was winning it, in part by hitting 17 greens in the final round and a mind-boggling 62 of 72 for the week, Harman, hitting only eight of Erin Hills' 14 broad fairways, was throwing his way his best chance at a major so far.

Maybe it was the wind, a good 15 mph most of the afternoon, or maybe it was him. Visiting belt-high fescue at one point, he bogeyed three holes on the back nine after not bogeying any of them in the first three rounds. With three holes to go, a birdie-birdie-eagle finish would have brought him a tie with Koepka, but Harman could manage only the one birdie, at the par-3 16th via a brilliant approach to a foot. When his tee shot on the par-5 18th ended up in a bunker, even his shot at an albatross for a miracle tie flew away.

"I just wish I was able to put a little more pressure on the course," Harman said. "I just didn't drive it as well today as I wanted to," Harman said. "That would be something I'd work on going forward."

"I don't feel as though I lost a golf tournament. I think Brooks went out and won the tournament."

True. And Matsuyama, aside from being put on the clock with John "J.B." Holmes, was in the same mental vicinity.

"If I learned anything, you've got to put four good rounds together," Matsuyama said through an interpreter. "I played two good rounds, but it wasn't enough. Hopefully in the future I can play in either the last or next to last group to give myself a better chance."

Matsuyama birdied the 18th hole via a 2 1/2-foot putt to get to 12-under 276 when Koepka was 13-under with four holes left and Harman had just fallen to 12-under on the 12th. That was a good

number to be sitting on in the clubhouse until Koepka's birdie barrage.

All this had been building for Koepka, or so it seemed. He made his way to the PGA Tour via Europe, hardly conventional for a Florida State grad. He'd won at Phoenix two years ago. He'd scored four top-10 finishes in majors since 2014, including a tie for fourth in the 2014 U.S. Open. He went 3-1 in last year's Ryder Cup.

He had length – a 379-yard 3-wood off the 18th tee drew gasps from the gallery of 35,000 – and smarts and everything needed to win. He just hadn't often won, underachieving by his standards after a handful of European Challenge Tour wins, a European Tour title, a win in Japan, and the triumph in Phoenix. Now he has a major and a share of the U.S. Open under-par scoring record. Rory McIlroy, who watched the final two rounds of the weekend from afar, went 16-under at Congressional in 2011.

"I felt like I put myself in contention so many times," Koepka said. "I don't want to say I got unlucky. I felt like I just never fully came together. I put myself in some good chances over the last few years and never really quite came through."

"I just felt like I should be winning more. I don't know why. Not a big fan of losing; I don't think anyone out here is. And I just couldn't stand the fact that I'd only won once."

A phone call Saturday night from Dustin Johnson, who missed the cut in defending his title, might have been the last piece of the puzzle.

"It was a long phone call for us," Koepka said. "It was like two minutes."

The message: "Just stay patient."

"I'll win if I stay patient and just keep doing what I'm doing."

Koepka also alluded to a better mental atti-

tude compared to early in the year.

"I couldn't get my mind to free up, but I'm past that now," Koepka said.

He certainly is. So focused was he this week he forgot a certain holiday.

Said Koepka, "I didn't exactly get my dad a card, so this works."

Before his heroics, the talk at Erin Hills was about the continuing run of low scores. Some dubbed it the John Deere National Open Classic. The red numbers were highlights by Justin Thomas' 9-under-par 63 on Saturday, which matched the low score in a major and was the first 63 on a par-72 major layout, thus setting a record for a round against par in one of the Big Four.

Thomas made nine birdies and eagled the 18th hole, and with two bogeys on his card, still snapped the single-round under-par mark of 8-under set by Johnny Miller en route to victory at par-71 Oakmont in 1973.

Thomas played more than two hours before the final twosome of Harman and Paul Casey, and gave them a reason to watch the scoreboard. He finished tied with Tommy Fleetwood, the European Tour standout, and Koepka for second at 11-under 205, a stroke behind Harman, whose 5-under 67 should have been better, but for a bold play at the last that resulted in a mere par.

"Twelve under, I'd have about a 10-shot lead in most opens," Harman said.

He's not kidding. This Open's phenomenally low scores have come about thanks to fairways wider than a CinemaScope screen and rain-soaked greens that are fast but holding. Pros drool at such conditions.

Harman, the first of the record 42 players under par through 54 holes, believed the gravy train would end Sunday morning.

"The wind is going to come out of the north, it's going to blow, and the scores could be a good deal higher," Harman predicted. "I've got a good plan for this course. I played it in a couple of different wind conditions."

It howled, all right, with gusts reaching 35 mph, but began to die down before the leaders teed off – including him – and was less of a factor than expected in the final round.

In Saturday's calm, Thomas, decked out in pink pants, played incandescently well, making birdies on the first two holes and darting up the leader board like a squirrel seeking the top branch in a tree. But he was more tickled by the par created by a 6-iron at the par-4 third.

"That ball is way above my feet, I had 204 in and off the left wind," Thomas said. "I just pured the 6-iron right at it. Something about that shot

just calmed me, and made me very comfortable for the day."

It climaxed with a 310-yard 3-wood – honestly – that finished four feet from the cup at the last. Eagle and 63.

"I wouldn't have been able to do that without the rain last night," Thomas said.

Perhaps, but, much like Miller's 63 after a rainy Saturday night at Oakmont, nobody else shot 63 on Saturday. The next lowest score was Patrick Reed's 65, which jumped him into a tie for seventh. On a day when the field average was almost precisely par – 72.015 – one needed to be in the 60s to make himself known.

But guys like Jordan Spieth (tied for 59th at 4-over 220 after a 76) were just too far back.

"I had 15 looks at birdie today and all of them were actual makable putts, and I only made one of them," Spieth said. "It just looked like I was putting at half a cup. Sometimes it looks like I'm putting to two cups."

There was a four-way tie after 36 holes, which hadn't happened since 1974, "The Massacre at Winged Foot."

That quartet was Arnold Palmer, Gary Player, Ray Floyd and Hale Irwin. Erin Hills' Fab Four were Casey, Fleetwood, Harman and Koepka.

Like the next 13 players on the leader board, none had never won one of the traditional four major championships.

Koepka won the Phoenix Open in 2015, was second in the Texas Open this year, and was 22nd in the world before triumphing. That may say more about the world than him, but the big hitter revealed something about Erin Hills that helps explain the low scores.

"Seven-iron, that's the longest club I've hit into any par-4," Koepka said. "When you're do-

ing that, you've got to be able to put it on the green."

Missing from the weekend: world No. 1 and defending champion Dustin Johnson, No. 2 Rory McIlroy, No. 3 Jason Day, and eight of the top 12 ranked players overall.

What did Dan Jenkins once write? "The tournament is at the airport."

Johnson needed an albatross at the 676-yard 18th to make the cut after a bogey on the 17th. He hammered a 315-yard 3-wood that bounced over the green on his second shot after a drive of over 350 yards. But he's out the door. Likewise McIlroy, who said those who couldn't hit the 40-to-60-yard wide fairways didn't belong, and then hit 16 of the 28 over two rounds. Likewise Day, tied for 144th, ahead of only eight players.

The Open opened on a bizarre note, not on the course but in the air, as the photos above denote. Thermal aircraft – a blimp-style hot air balloon,

essentially – pilot Trevor Thompson found the wind too strong for his airship after a mid-morning landing and suddenly was plummeting to the ground when the wind tore open one of the craft's panels. A member of the ground crew pulled him away before an explosion, but Thompson was burned and hospitalized.

On the course, the red numbers came early and often.

Rickie Fowler, who is either searching for his first major championship or chasing his second, depending on one's view of the Players Championship, was the first round leader, having gone around Erin Hills – stretched to an Open-record 7,845 yards on a windy day – in 7-under-par 65, only the third 7-under opening score in an Open. Jack Nicklaus and Tom Weiskopf shot 7-under 63s on Thursday at Baltusrol in 1980.

Half the world was right behind him and under par. Well, an Open-record 44 players were under

par – and another 16 at par 72 – by the conclusion of play, with Casey and Xander Schauffele scoring 6-under 66 to trail Fowler by a stroke with the best rounds of the afternoon. That's a record 60 players at par or better.

A gaggle at 5-under 67 included Harman, Koepka, and Fleetwood, the best player you've never heard of. (The European Tour standout is 33rd in the world rankings.) Patrick Reed and Kevin Na are among a quartet at 4-under 68.

The underlying reason for the low scores from start to finish was simple. Soft greens.

The 1.84 inches of rain that fell from Monday night through Wednesday took the course's firm greens and made them nearly as plush as "Fescue," the mascot cow on sale in the merchandise tent. While the fescue fairways continued to run, the soaking allowed the field to throw darts at the bentgrass greens, and stick them.

So, at least for one day, the Open wasn't a

torture chamber for all, but a pleasure palace for most. Throw out erstwhile Masters winner Danny Willett, whose untidy 81 raised eyebrows, and a trio of lessers who also were in the 80s, and the field found Erin Hills and its 40-plus yard wide fairways far more docile than the usual Open course, which features handcuffs on the first tee and other instruments of mayhem along the way.

Fowler had no truck with the potential problems, tooling around without a bogey.

"You don't get many rounds at the U.S. Open that are stress-free," Fowler said. "Simple day when you look back on it."

Around Erin Hills

Marshall "Chick" Jacobs, a 94-year-old man from Wauwatosa, Wis., died of natural causes at the Open during Friday's second round after taking ill in the grandstand near the sixth green, USGA officials said. Paramedics were on the scene within three minutes, performed CPR and transferred the man to an ambulance, where efforts to revive him failed. Temperatures Friday were in the low 80s. Jacobs' wife had died three days before of complications following a broken hip. "The only way that he was not going to come out here to the U.S. Open was if he passed," Bill Marshall, his son, said in a video the family released. "He was elated. So I think that he had seen Steve Stricker, and said 'I saw it all, so let's go to lunch.' " Bill Marshall told the *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel* he and his dad spent "three hours of bliss" Friday watching the game's greatest players. There was a joint funeral. ... The 1-over-par cut tied the Open low, set at Medinah in 1990. ... Gallery favorite Steve Stricker's 3-under 69 for 5-under 283 tied him for 16th, making the 50-year-old the low Wisconsin native, and should sell tickets to his Champions Tour tournament this

O Canada! Szeryk brings it home

Texas resident beats native Texan at River Forest

Maddie Szeryk had one critical edge over Dylan Kim in the stellar championship match of the 117th Women's Western Amateur on June 17 at River Forest Country Club.

When she absolutely needed to, Szeryk could summon a solid approach or sink a big putt.

That was evident several times in the course of the double-round match, and enabled her to close out Kim by a 3 and 1 margin. While Kim missed the green of the 526-yard par 5 17th hole with her third shot, Szeryk was able to drill an approach to about 16 feet and calmly two-putt for the victory, Kim missing her 15-foot par-saver.

Szeryk, a 21-year-old dual U.S.-Canadian citizen who registered from London, Ont., but calls Allen, Tex. home and will be a senior at Texas A&M in the fall, took control of the match on the second nine in the morning. Birdies on four of five holes beginning at the par-4 10th moved her three-up on Kim, a Plano, Tex., native who left Baylor after the college season and will tee it up at Arkansas in the fall.

Szeryk got as much as 4-up on two occasions before Kim rallied, including pulling to within two holes with wins on the 13th and 15th holes in the

afternoon, but that margin proved too difficult to overcome, and Szeryk lifted the W.A. Alexander Cup.

“It’s good to win a match-play tournament,” said Szeryk, who advanced to the quarterfinals last year before calling to Sophie Schubert. “It’s pretty awesome to win this.”

It was pretty awesome how she did it, scoring 5-under 67 – with the usual match-play concessions – in the morning and going around the 17 holes in the afternoon in 1-under-par. Kim scored the equivalent of 3-under 69 in the morning and 2-under in the afternoon, but Szeryk’s mid-morning timing, with birdies on the par-4 10th to go 1-up, the par-3 11th to match Kim, the par-4 12th to go 2-up and the par-4 14th to go 3 up, built an insurmountable margin.

“It’s tough when you’re 2-down with two

holes to go,” Kim said. “But it was a good week. I’m happy with the way I played, disappointed with the finish.

“It was kind of the way you want a championship match to be played.”

Both Szeryk and Kim had scored 1-under 143 in qualifying, one off the lead, and each marched through match play, Szeryk dramatically in the semifinal, when she was extended to the 20th hole by Francesca Olivarez-Ilas of the Phillipines.

A little under two years ago, Kim’s golfing future was in doubt. She had surgery to remove a benign tumor in a leg, and took the rest of the 2015-16 season to recover.

Her return was a success. She helped Baylor to the NCAA Championship at Rich Harvest Farms, where the only sour note was her making a double-bogey on the 17th hole of her quarterfinal match with Stanford’s world No. 3 Albane Valenzela, which advanced the Cardinal into the semifinals.

“You better make those, and she didn’t,” Baylor coach Jay Goble said of Kim.

Two years ago, Szeryk advanced to the quarterfinals of the British Ladies Amateur. Saturday, while world No. 1 amateur Leona Maguire was winning this year’s edition of that, Szeryk stuck closer to home and won a nationally-recognized title of her own, the biggest of her career.

Jackson Park routing reaction mixed

Objections to facility replacing wildlife area, dog park

The prospective replacement course for the current layouts in Jackson Park and South Shore features wider fairways than the existing courses, 7,354 yards in length for those who want to play from the tips, a number of holes along Lake Michigan, and the prospect of a pro tournament – the BMW Championship – there at least once in the future.

The plan, estimated at \$30 million before other improvements, also calls for the closure of part of Cornell Ave. from about 65th St. to 67th St., and Marquette Dr. from Stony Island Ave. to Jeffrey Ave.

Additionally, the South Shore Nature Sanctuary, a protected wildlife area, would be replaced by a fairway and green, and two baseball/softball diamonds on the north edge of the course would be lost.

If built as planned, there would be two underpasses, one under Jeffery and another under Richards Dr., next to the lakefront, to connect what are envisioned as three parcels for the 18-hole course plus a six-hole short course and junior golf area on what is currently the 18th fairway of Jackson Park, adjacent to the current clubhouse on Richards.

The golf course, largely designed by Beau Willing of the course architecture firm headed by Tiger Woods, would sit on three parcels of land. Also included in the plan is a six-hole short course for youth golf development, and an expanded driving range. The range expansion would eliminate the only dog park on the South Side, as well as a picnic area and some tennis courts.

"We are looking to maximize playability with ample width and low cut green surrounds while still offering a strategic test for players of all skill levels," a statement by Woods' TGR Design explained. "We want to ensure that we provide a memorable course for all ages to enjoy, but also one which will stand up to the world's best players."

Criticism of the project comes from parties interested in the "Jackson Bark" dog park, the wildlife area, and avid golfers who like the current courses.

"There are 23 dog parks in the city, and none of them are on the South Side," dog park designer Todd Agosto told WMAQ-TV News. "They need a place to play and socialize."

In the *Chicago Sun-Times*, letter writer Eric Ginsburg, a Hyde Park resident, opined of the nature area, "It's a small, quiet pocket of prairie and wetland plants and animals with an incredible lakeside view."

That view is what led Willing to design the par-3 12th hole on the spot of the sanctuary.

Willing's routing provides for wider fairways than those on the current courses. The footprint of the property meant he came up with a routing with five par-3s and five par-5s, rather than the usual four of each.

The course would start by a new building on the current site of a baseball diamond, called the

pavilion, with 10 holes on the largest footprint of the three, between Richards, Jeffrey, 67th St., Stony Island, the truncated Cornell, and Hayes Dr. Three holes would be located east of Jeffrey and serve as the connection to the South Shore property, where the 10th through 14th holes would be wrapped around the South Shore Cultural Center – the old clubhouse for South Shore Country Club – and a public beach.

If a tournament is held there, tees adjacent to the par-3 12th would be used to drive over the beach to the 13th fairway, bringing Lake Michigan into play.

From the 11th green to the 14th green, the lake will be on the golfer's right, with the 12th green on a peninsula occupied by the nature area and the 13th fairway running aside the shoreline.

The last four holes of the course would be along the perimeter of the property with out-of-bounds to the left. The par-5 18th hole would be a slight dogleg right, going north from 67th St., with Cornell in play for a really wayward left second or third shot to the final green.

One set of tees is 5,582 yards, which Ed Sherman, a freelance writer working for the Chicago Parks Golf Alliance, the group behind the replacement course, noted was close to the current Jackson Park length of 5,508 yards.

The original plan called for \$30 million for construction and an endowment of lower green fees for city residents. That does not include the underpasses or expected reconstruction or reinforcement of lakefront shoreline walls, a cost expected to be paid for by the city, and thus Chicago taxpayers. One estimate for one underpass was \$11 million.

Strangely, the CPGA hasn't posted the design on its website.

Schenk wins Lincoln Land

Birdie ends 4-way playoff at Panther Creek

Adam Schenk took another step toward the PGA Tour on June 25, outlasting three competitors in a sudden-death playoff for the Lincoln Land Charity Championship on the Web.com Tour.

Schenk made a 25-foot birdie putt on the second hole of sudden death at Panther Creek Country Club to beat Eric Axley, William Kropp and Kyle Thompson after tying at 14-under-par 270.

“What an unbelievable experience,” Schenk told PGATour.com. “I thought I lost the tournament two or three times and was just lucky to make that last putt.”

A 25-year-old Purdue graduate from Vincennes, Ind., Schenk won on start No. 37 on the circuit. It wasn’t easy.

He grabbed the lead from Thompson (whose runner-up finish earned him a PGA Tour spot next year) on the front nine but tossed away the advantage with a double-bogey at the par-4 12th. After regaining it and falling back into a tie, and came to the 18th a stroke ahead, but bogeyed the last after pulling his second shot under a grandstand and failing to save par.

The quartet matched pars on the first playoff hole, and all were on the green in regulation the next time through the 18th. But Axley, Kropp and Thompson missed their birdie attempts from long range. Schenk made his from about the same spot as he missed on the first playoff hole, and collected \$99,000 for doing so.

“I aimed 6 inches left,” Schenk said. “It rolled straight and went right in the hole.”
