Sun-Times joins Jax ‘no’ chorus

“A scheme.”

That’s what the *Chicago Sun-Times* editorial board calls the proposed reconstruction of the golf courses in Jackson Park and South Shore.

That blunt assessment was made in an editorial on July 28, one that noted the concept was “being rushed to the finish line in classic Chicago style, with final decision and ground-breaking scheduled before anybody knows the score.”

As far as ILLINOIS GOLFER knows, there’s no literal ground-breaking scheduled yet. The plan has been slowed by opposition and an inability by the sponsoring Chicago Parks Golf Alliance – which came out of nowhere to spring the concept on a community that didn’t know it was needed – to raise quickly the \$5 million in seed money necessary to fund the construction of a sample hole on the South Shore property to show off to the pros before next month’s BMW Championship.

Nevertheless, count the *Sun-Times* with the *Tribune* and ILLINOIS GOLFER on the “no” side of the aisle.

“Call us naive, but we’d like to believe that ordinary people, not the elite, come first in this town,” the editorial said. “If so, this project will be slowed down. Because, honestly, nobody knows nothing.”

The *Sun-Times* noted that Jackson Park and South Shore are the third and fifth most-played of the Chicago Park District’s six courses, and that the proponents of the reconstruction had compared their play only to Marovitz – a.k.a. Waveland – which, with its

The question of the protected “Bird & Butterfly Sanctuary” also came up, and the group had no specific relocation plan.

The editorial noted the Park District has an October deadline for a final plan, and that the CPGA wants to get the bulldozers out by the end of winter. (The idea is to have a course available for the 2021 BMW Championship, should the Western Golf Association and the auto firm decide to give the area south of Madison St. another whirl. Given BMW’s idea to play the old Western Open in high-rent zip codes, that’s doubtful.)

“(O)n this one,” the paper editorialized, “we’re with the Friends of the Parks, which has called on the Alliance and the Park District to slow down, do a better job on their homework and make a better case.”

The ungiven gimme, and a lesson for all

It was the gimme putt that wasn't, the concession that was unconceded.

It cast a pall over the U.S. Girls Junior, and immediately critics – your correspondent included – tried to determine who, if anyone, was in the wrong, and who, if anyone, acted admirably.

There were more of the former than the latter.

Here are the facts. The semifinal match between Erica Shepherd and Elizabeth Moon had gone to the 19th hole. Shepherd had already missed her birdie putt, Moon conceding the par. Now Moon had a five-footer for birdie herself, and saw it curl away, missing on the left side of the cup. It stopped no more than eight inches past the hole.

Shepherd had closed her eyes, waiting for the sound of it dropping. Hearing nothing, she looked up to see Moon raking the putt back. Time it, and it's 1.13 seconds between the ball stopping and Moon reaching to rake it back.

By the time Shepherd saw that, was too late for a verbal concession.

Now wide-eyed, she turned to the left, apparently at her caddie and coach, Brent Nicoson, the coach of the University of Indianapolis golf team, and Shepherd's swing coach. One report had Nicoson asking, "Did you give it to her?" The Fox broadcast clearly has her saying, "I didn't say that was good." Seconds later, Shepherd said, "I wanted to but she was dragging it back."

At that point, the United States Golf Association's referee came in and explained the rule that prevents a concession after another stroke, and

told a shocked Moon she had lost the match. Call Shepherd shocked as well.

In theory, had not Nicoson piped up – aren't caddies supposed to show up, keep up and shut up? – Shepherd might have just walked to the next tee when she saw Moon's rake job, effectively conceding the par and keeping the match alive – presuming the referee would have gone along with it. But she didn't, and the match was over, with an unhappy loser and an unhappy winner.

While Shepherd, 16, was distressed by the turn of events, still unhappy when she arrived at Boone Valley Golf Club in Augusta, Mo., for the championship match she would win – "I just sat in bed crying," she told the *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* – it was Moon who was hardest hit.

The 17-year-old threw away a chance to win on the next hole, or a subsequent one. The ball she raked back in gimme range for even a stickler like Jason Day, who plays match play like it's stroke play, in which everything must be holed out. Shepherd would obviously given it to Moon, if she was given a chance to do so.

Moon did what we all have done. Miss a short one, and you're ticked off. You're thinking in the instant it goes by the hole, "There's no way that could have missed." So you reach for it and give it another try. (Annoyingly, almost 100 percent of putts that no longer matter go in.)

Moon did a very human thing and paid the price.

Therein is the problem. While there is the con-

cept of equity in the game – do what's fair – it only applies to areas not defined by the Rules of Golf or the many decisions that have been made over the years. And conceding putts in match play is an area that has been thoroughly covered.

The way the rules are written, the common sense idea of Shepherd being allowed to give Moon the eight-inch putt for par to continue the match after it had been raked back isn't allowed.

It should be allowed. For one thing, it's the polite thing to do, just as a routine concession is. It's one player saying to another, "Hey, you would have made it. Let's play on."

Shepherd wanted to be polite, fair, a good sport, and wasn't allowed.

Is there any wonder why the USGA is held in disdain by so many in the game?

Every time a ruling comes along that falls along the "do as we say, or else" side of the world, not only do some people give up on the group, but others who now play casually and might otherwise be inclined to become more involved look and say, "Why get involved with a game where you get beat over the head for trying to do something right?"

That, along with the amount of time it takes to play in a hurried world, and in many cases the price, can't be helping to grow the game.

The R&A and USGA are in the middle of contemplating a major renovation of the rules. Nothing in that renovation addresses what could be called the Common Sense Concession Principle.

It should. It's just common sense.



115TH WESTERN AMATEUR PREVIEW

It's Meyer vs. the world

Rarely since the beginning of the jet age has the Western Amateur, one of the world's top three gambols for the no-cash set, featured as formidable a field as the one that will assemble for the 115th playing, set for Aug. 1-5 at Skokie Country Club in north suburban Glencoe.

A glance at the World Amateur Golf Ranking finds 12 of the top 20 names checked in the affirmative, beginning with No. 1 Joaquin Niemann, a phenom from Chile who advanced to the Sweet Sixteen last year as a 17-year-old and made the U.S. Open field this year, and No. 3 Braden Thornberry, the individual NCAA champion at Rich Harvest Farms. A slew of competitors who starred at the NCAAs in Sugar Grove follow.

This is the result of considerable work by Western Golf Association officials to coax high-caliber amateurs from all continents to play in the championship that helped everyone of Chick Evans in days of yore to Jack Nicklaus, Tom Weiskopf, Lanny Wadkins, Ben Crenshaw, Tiger Woods and Phil Mickelson burnish their reputations.

That also goes for a fellow named Justin Leonard. He's semi-retired and commenting on television now, but Leonard was a formidable

force early in his pro career, including capturing a British Open. Before that, he won back-to-back Western Amateur titles in 1992-93, and was knocked off by Phil Mickelson in 1991.

Leonard was the last to successfully defend his title – many champs are pros by the following spring and are filling their pockets, or trying to – but Dylan Meyer of Evansville, Ind., and the Illinois golf team is back after winning last year in an upset. A repeat title by Meyer would be anything but.

Last year at the Knollwood Club, Meyer beat then-No. 2 Sam Horsfield of England, who was honing his game as a Florida Gator. He's a pro now, and recently tied for 55th in the John Deere Classic, but Meyer, who missed the cut in the Deere, has a year to go at Illinois, and enters the 115th Western Amateur as a co-favorite at the least with Niemann and Thornberry. He's No. 4 in the world ranking.

"This is an exceptionally deep and talented field," said Vince Pellegrino, WGA senior VP of tournaments. "We strive each year to attract the best amateur players in the world, and we're excited that so many of them want to play in our event this year and test the iconic course at Skokie Country Club."

There are players from 18 countries on hand, including Argentina, Australia, Canada, Chile, the People's Republic of China, the Republic of China (a.k.a. Taiwan), France, Italy, Mexico, New Zealand, Norway, Philippines, Scotland, South Africa, Thailand, the United Arab Emirates and Wales, along with players from across the United States. The only recognizable names not on hand are Maverick McNealy and Will Zalatoris, No. 2 and 9 respectively in the world ranking.

They'll miss a competition that could decide Walker Cup picks for both the U.S. and Great Britain and Ireland sides, as well as act as a form chart for the U.S. Amateur, which is a fortnight away, to say nothing of the stamina of the players. The Western Am is two tournaments in one, with a 72-hole stroke-play competition over three days to determine the 16 players advancing to match play. The latter is conducted over two days, so the two finalists end up playing eight rounds – 144 holes, more or less – across five days.

Several players are coming off successes, including Doug Ghim, the Texas Longhorn from

Arlington Heights. He captured the Pacific Coast Amateur, one of the top regional titles, two weeks ago. That's where Nick Hardy was, rather than defend his 2016 Illinois Amateur title.

Eleventh-ranked Connor Syme also has to be considered a threat, given his appearance two weeks ago in the British Open at Royal Birkdale.

An added attraction is Tony Romo, about to start his CBS Sports football analyst work after a standout career quarterbacking the Dallas Cowboys. Romo is an accomplished player, though his last appearance in the state saw him miss the cut in this spring's Will County Amateur at Bal-moral Woods. He had won the WCA in 2009.

"I don't suspect there will be too many crazy low scores on courses like these, and saying that, that makes it fun," Romo said the day before hostilities commenced. "You've got to grind on every shot and put together a lot of good swings. I can already look at this green right here. Hopefully your short game is on point."

Romo isn't the first crossover notable to play in the Western Amateur. Most famously, Michael Jordan teed it up in 1991, and missed the cut, making one birdie in 36 holes while drawing thousands to Point O'Woods in Millberg, Mich. A few years later, Mark McGwire, just retired from baseball, had to play his foul balls at the Point. Decades earlier, Bing Crosby, among the best players in the entertainment set, played in a Western Am, but like Jordan and McGwire, failed to make match play.

Amazingly, admission for this extravaganza – consider it a PGA Tour preview – is free. The last time the Western Am played through Skokie, Jordan Spieth and Patrick Reed were in the field that saw David Chung win.

68TH ILLINOIS OPEN PREVIEW

An old home beckons

Hockey gloves, rather than golf gloves, should have been the preferred hand covering the last time the Illinois Open was played at Briarwood Country Club. Or maybe mittens.

It was May 8, 1966, and a mid-spring cold snap brought the temperature down to 34 degrees for the first round. Snow flurries floated through the air occasionally.

Maybe that's why an Esposito won. No, not Phil, then centering for the Black Hawks.

Emil Esposito, then 29, a pro for five years and about to gain admittance into the PGA of America, scored the victory with a chilly first round of 71 – the only player to match par – followed by a 75-74 windup the second day for a total of 220. But Esposito didn't get the trophy and the \$1,000 check until he knocked off Don Stickney, an assistant at Onwentsia, with a par on the first hole of a sudden-death playoff.

"I had 165 in, had a 5-iron, and caught it just a little thin, but right at the stick," Esposito recalled. "I chipped it up to three feet and made it."

How cold was it? Very, Esposito said.

"I remember Jack Fleck, the same guy who beat Hogan (in the 1955 U.S. Open), he had an overcoat and a stocking cap on," Esposito said.

"It was cold. But it was a good feat."

This trip down Memory Lane is relevant because the Illinois Open is returning to Briarwood, a Deerfield bastion of fine golf, for the first time

in 51 years. On Aug. 7-8, the club will co-host the first two rounds of the 68th state golf championship in conjunction with The Glen Club, which, after some 264 players battle both courses across

two days, will host the final round on Aug. 9. It's the third year of the expanded field and two-course host situation, one expected to continue with The Glen Club the constant in the equation.

The game has changed considerably since Esposito scored the first of his two Illinois Open victories. Metal woods have replaced persimmon, the multiple-piece ball goes miles further than the old balata, and greens are faster than ever.

But the challenge remains the same. Out-score the best in the state across 54 holes to hold the same trophy Esposito lifted, and for a larger purse. Last year's first prize was \$17,500 from a purse of \$100,000, the first six-figure kitty since 2003. This year's purse hasn't been determined, but Illinois PGA executive director Carrie Williams is aiming for another six-figure total.

Among those chasing the title, though not the purse, is 15-year-old Dominic Scaletta of Inverness, the youngest contestant in memory. And he'll have an 11-year-old as a caddie.

If it seems unlikely that Scaletta would contend, he may be running out of people his own age to beat. He reports that four years ago, then merely 11, he won 15 straight Illinois Junior Golf Association tournaments, and by his count closer to 20 when non-IJGA play was included.

He missed the cut in the recent Western Junior at Park Ridge Country Club after opening with a 70.

Here's one more way things have changed since 1966: Young Scaletta has his own website.

"I golf every day," the homeschooled 0.9 handicapper wrote in his bio. "My practice routine includes 2-3 hours of short game, 1 1/2 hours of hitting balls, and nine or 18 holes of on-course play for the remaining practice."

That adds up, he wrote, to between six and

eight hours a day.

To much of the rest of the field, that's an unreachable luxury. The club pros in the field are in their shop or giving lessons much of the day, and the top amateurs generally hold down real-life jobs unless they're in college.

Even the touring pros, including defending

champion Carlos Sainz Jr., won't put in that many hours, and at some point, neither will Scaletta.

Sainz, who is rarely home in Elgin these days, has been on the PGA Latinoamerica and Canadian tours, but will be able to defend the title he won last year at Royal Fox and Royal Hawk country clubs.

"I'm very excited to return to compete in the Illinois Open and play a great course and venue in The Glen Club," Sainz said. "The Illinois Open was the biggest win for me in the state and I look forward to having my family there to support me."

Sainz has been all over the map – literally – in playing the PGA Tour's two stepping-stone circuits, knowing that a series of big finishes would get him on the Web.com Tour next year.

"It's tough to get used to the grass in North America after playing this season in South America," Sainz said.

He'll be up against a solid field that includes amateur Nick Hardy of Northbrook, who made the cut in the John Deere Classic this year and tied for fourth in last year's Illinois Open, garnering low amateur honors.

He may end up playing with future teammate Brendan O'Reilly, a three-time Illinois Junior winner who tied for 13th in the Western Junior at Park Ridge, and will be joining Hardy at Illinois in the fall. At 18, O'Reilly is an ancient compared to Scaletta.

Two other amateurs, recent Illinois Amateur Patrick Falvin of Highwood and Ethan Farnam of Crystal Lake, may also make noise.

Tim "Tee-K" Kelly of Wheaton is also in the field, and with a victory in Puerto Rico on the Latinoamerica Tour that Sainz spoke of, may have the best game coming in.

DeChambeau pulls it off

*Captures 47th Deere for
first career Tour title*

This one was for the golf nerds.

You know them. The guys who futz and fiddle in their basement, working on their grips, bending the shaft of their putter, testing every combination of swing weight in their \$600 drivers they can think of.

You may be one of them.

Bryson DeChambeau is a golf nerd squared. He thinks in four dimensions when there are only three. He wears a Hogan cap when he might well wear a wizard's hat decorated with stars and half-moons instead. If he designed courses, he would be Pete Dye.

Attention was paid, eyebrows were raised and his logic was questioned during his college and amateur career, when he debuted a set of irons all cut at 7-iron length. Like those who looked at the contraption of Orville and Wilbur Wright and said, "Boys, it'll never fly," DeChambeau was dismissed as a gadfly with a nutty idea.

HARDY EFFORT

Nick Hardy finished 55th in his first start at the Deere, building on experience gained in two U.S. Open appearances.

In 2015, he won the NCAA Championship representing Southern Methodist, and the U.S. Amateur, the latter at Olympia Fields, with those same-length irons.

Earlier this season, futzing and fiddling with his swing, he missed eight straight cuts, the last at the U.S. Open, a 74-76 showing at Erin Hills.

After all the surety, there were doubts.

"Yeah, absolutely," DeChambeau said. "It was more trial and error, right? I'm going to test this and see if it works. It was going more into a longer swing, trying to hit it harder and farther and maybe I could time it out, and it just didn't work for me."

So, it was back to square one.

"So I finally backed off that about four weeks ago and said, 'Look, just go back to what you were doing in college. You did pretty well. Let's see where it goes from there. Maybe I can understand a little bit more of what I was doing and why I played so well because of it.'

"I gained immediate confidence back."

With confidence came instant improvement. He tied for 26th in Hartford, 17th at Avenel, 14th at the Greenbrier, and alternately contended and lurked for the first three days of the 47th John Deere Classic at TPC Deere Run.

On Sun., July 16, with a barrage of seven birdies in the last 11 holes, he overhauled leader Patrick Rodgers on the final holes and scored his first victory on the PGA Tour. DeChambeau's 6-under-par 65 for 18-under 266 beat Rodgers by a stroke and Wesley Bryan and Rick Lamb by two.

No more doubts.

"Feels like a long time coming, even though I'm 23," DeChambeau said. "It's pretty special to win here at the John Deere."



There were multiple reasons why beyond proving some detractors – including Nick Faldo – wrong. He'd been given a sponsor's exemption to the Deere two years ago. And, he found out during the trophy ceremony, fellow SMU standout Payne Stewart's first Tour win was at the Deere – when he debuted his plus-four look.

"That broke me," DeChambeau said. He cupped his face in his hands, crying, when Deere chairman Sam Allen mentioned that Stewart, whom DeChambeau watched as a little kid, broke through at Oakwood Country Club in 1982.

He broke Rodgers at the end of the round almost without breaking a sweat.

DeChambeau was four strokes behind at daybreak, and dropped a stroke when he bogeyed the par 4 fourth. Visions of a comeback for a title were far from clear. But his birdie binge began at the eighth with an 11-footer, and it never really stopped. And it needed to keep going. That bird moved him to 12-under, and he was still out of the top 10.

Birdies on the 10th and 11th opened the back nine properly, and at 14-under, he was in the neighborhood. So was a third of the field, with 26 players within three strokes when CBS hit the air at 2 p.m. At one point, after 50-year-old Steve Stricker completed an attack with 14 birdies in his last 30 holes and a final round 64 to jump to 15-under 269, he was tied for the lead with Rodgers, Wesley Bryan, Steve Stallings and Daniel Berger.

Stricker would eventually finish fifth. But DeChambeau kept coming, sinking a 10-footer for birdie on the 13th and a kick-in bird on the 14th. At that point, he was 14-under, but 14-under does not win the John Deere Classic.

But 16-under can, and birdies on the last two holes got him there.

His hybrid from a downhill-sidehill lie from 259 yards out on the par-5 17th set up a two-putt birdie from 40 feet, but it wasn't easy.

"Oh my!" DeChambeau smiled. "That first little putt, if you hit it three feet by, is off the green. I was a little tedious with it and left it three feet short."

His four-footer hit the center of the cup.

"Sweet, huge," he said.

His approach to the 18th was similarly stout, a 7-iron right over the flag to 14 feet behind the hole, which was cut in the traditional back-right spot, the pond looming as danger.

"I wasn't trying to, either," he said of attacking the pin. "I was able to take pretty aggressive line, but knew if I pulled it a little bit it wouldn't go in the water because of the wind. So I pulled it just a little bit, pulled it enough to get close."

And sank it, tying Rodgers, to a roar from the gallery, which might have numbered 19,000. Many were following Rodgers at the point, and, thanks to a misadventure on the 17th, he would soon be following DeChambeau.

Rodgers pulled his tee shot into the trees on the left, chipped out because he was stymied by a tree, hit the front of the green with his third but found the front bunker between his ball and the cup, and had to chip from one point of the green to the other. He lipped out the eight-footer for par and dropped to 17-under.

"I felt like I hit an OK putt," Rodgers said. "I don't really have a ton of regrets. I'm proud of myself for staying aggressive all day."

At it turned out, Rodgers bogeyed the 14th and 17th holes – the 16th and 11th easiest on Sun-

day, respectively – and that was the difference. Pars on both, he wins. Par on either of the two, he's in a playoff, even though DeChambeau birdied both.

"I didn't make many bogeys this week, so to have two of them on some simple holes probably cost me the golf tournament," Rodgers said.

He made seven bogeys in four rounds. DeChambeau made six.

Call it the revenge of the golf nerd.

The Deere opened with two hurt guys taking the lead with 8-under 63s. Charles Howell III was coming off a serious rib injury, while Ollie Schneiderjans was out nine weeks with back trouble.

Howell set the target score Thursday morning and Schneiderjans matched it in the afternoon.

They led local hero Zach Johnson, Rory Sabbatini, Rodgers and Chad Campbell by two strokes, and a sixsome including perennial Deere contender Daniel Summerhays and DeChambeau by three.

"With my injury, all I could do was putt," Howell said of his several weeks of enforced idleness after surgery. "It drove me nuts, just not being able to play golf. But I realized how lucky I am to play golf for a living. I missed competing out here."

Howell sank 123 feet, 9 inches feet worth of putts en route to his bogey-free 63, with eight birdies. His highlight-reel putt was a 26-footer that curled in on the par-3 seventh.

Impressive though that was, Howell was correct in saying the week was young.

"To contend, you have to putt well for four days," Howell said. He finished tied for 19th.

Schneiderjans' back tightened up at Colonial thanks to a too-cold hotel room, and he ended up

pulling a muscle. That sidelined him post-Memorial until the Deere, but you couldn't tell it, considering his nine-birdie showing.

"It's still sort of there," Schneiderjans said. "It lingered and I tried to play through it. It's been fine the last three weeks."

A second-round 74 sank his chances and he finished in a tie for 39th.

The star of the second round was Kevin Tway,

who bagged nine birdies across 10 holes. Then the rest of the afternoon wave came through.

It was more like a tsunami. Thus Tway, even after a career-best 8-under-par 63, was tied for fifth going into the weekend.

Tway birdied seven straight holes, just like daddy Bob Tway once did on the circuit, advancing from 1-under – which would have missed the cut – to 8-under, and got to the lead at 10-under

before a bogey dropped him to 9-under-par 133.

The 63 placed Tway four strokes behind Rodgers, who made Tway's binge look like kid stuff. Rodgers sank 146 feet of putts en route to a 7-under 64, including a 51-foot putt on the par-3 seventh and a 27-footer on the par-4 eighth. He also chipped in for birdie on the third, a bonus bird that offset his bogey on the ninth, his last of the day and only bogey of the week.

At 13-under 129 Rodgers was the leader at the halfway point. DeChambeau, who added a 65 to a 66 for 11-under 131, is second, with 2010 champion and tournament board member Zach Johnson tied with Charles Howell III for third at 10-under 132. Then there was Tway and his pals at 133: Chesson Hadley, Campbell and J.J. Henry.

"I was kind of hoping it would never stop, but it did," Tway said. "You've got to make a lot of birdies around here, so I'll just keep trying to do that."

Rodgers is 25 and seems to have been playing in the Deere since he was 12. It's actually his sixth appearance, with 11 rounds in the 60s out of 16. He tied for 15th as an amateur in 2013, and briefly led on Saturday.

"My dad took a screenshot of the leaderboard, and framed it," Rodgers recalled.

Saturday's big Moving Day advance belonged to Berger, Scott Stallings and Rick Lamb, though Rodgers stayed in front, his 3-under-par 68 for 16-under 197 placing him two strokes ahead of Berger and Stallings entering the final round.

"I hope I get everybody's best golf tomorrow and I hope I play just a little bit better," said Rodgers.

"Probably the most comfortable I feel any time on Tour is up here at the top of the leader board," he added. "I had a lot of experience winning in college and amateur golf, and I expected to come out here and win right away. Probably my biggest frustrations as a pro have been not getting it done yet. Part of the frustration so far has been not having as many chances as I would like."

Johnson and DeChambeau, Rodgers' partners for the day, each scored 1-under 70, failing to put runs together despite flashes of brilliance, such as Johnson's chip-in eagle 2 at the par-4 14th.

Then came Sunday, and the finish that saw DeChambeau crash the winner's circle for the first time on the big tour. He had won a Web.com tournament in 2016, and that was good, but this was better. Life-changing better. It's amazing DeChambeau even needed a plane to fly to the Open Championship.

*Farnsworth holds off
Northwestern's Kim by 1*

Mistwood Golf Club goes all out for the Phil Kosin Illinois Women's Open, its signature event. That includes live scoring online and a crew manning leader boards on the course.

All of which was superfluous to Alexandra Farnsworth of Nashville, Tenn.

"There's a lot of leader boards out here, I really focused on not looking at them, and I really think it paid off," Farnsworth said Wed., July 19.

By staying in her own world, the Vanderbilt senior managed to fire a 5-under-par 67 to win the 23rd IWO, finishing at 8-under 208 and beating fellow amateur Hannah Kim of Northwestern and Chula Vista, Calif., by two strokes. Pros Vivian Tsui of Canada and Samantha Postillion of Scottsdale, Ariz., who grew up in Hinsdale, tied for third at 5-under 211, and split first and second money to collect \$4,250 each.

Addison's Dana Gattone, heading into her senior year at Illinois, was the low Illinois resident, scoring 1-under 71 for 2-under 214.

Farnsworth, two strokes behind 36-hole lead-er Tsui after rounds of 67-74 for 3-under 141, was in the penultimate group, which played into her hands.

"I like coming from behind, and it was definitely a help to myself," Farnsworth said. "It made me focus on myself. I could kind of tell (she was leading) because of the group of carts around us."

Farnsworth scored six birdies, offset by a bogey on the par-3 14th. But she birdied the holes before and after to get to 8-under, while Kim

birdied the 15th and 17th after her bogey on the 14th.

Kim went out in 3-under 33, but a double-bogey 6 on the par-4 10th put her into catch-up mode. She scored 2-under 70 for 6-under 210.

"That created a mental block for me," Kim said of the double-bogey. "It was hard for me to get back to getting birdies. I just tried to play my game and get the putts rolling in again."

Farnsworth had been winless in college play, and hadn't hoisted a trophy since high school. She said she put more pressure on herself than she

should have last year, thinking she had to hit cer-tain scoring standards to realistically have a shot when she turns pro. That changed a few weeks ago after talking with friends.

"This breakthrough really, really means a lot to me," Farnsworth said. "It's frustrating being in the hunt a lot and not being able to pull through. I think I've learned from experience to focus on myself, don't worry about the other people, and that really helped."

"I'm fully back to enjoying the game again." Postillion's check was the biggest of her

young career. She bogeyed the 14th and 15th holes, but birdied the par-3 17th to score 2-under 70 and get back into the tie with Tsui for low pro. Tsui also bogeyed the 14th, but played the last four holes in each par to finish at 72 for 211.

"For the most part, I handled the adrenalin well," Postillion said. "Other than one hole today (the 15th, a sculled chip), I played a lot of great golf. I was never too worried about making bogeys and I was always patient about making birdies. It did not feel like a grind."

The tournament's no-boundaries policy – the opposite of the Illinois Open – created an international leader board. Aside from Tsui (from Markham, Ontario, by way of North Carolina State), it featured Lili Cammisa, who tied for 15th after challenging early, registering from Argentina, and Katja Pogacar of Ljubljana, Slovenia, as well as Ohio State. She finished solo sixth.

Around Mistwood

For Kim, the IWO was more than a competition. It was also to check the finer points in her game in advance of the U.S. Women's Amateur, which will be held in her home town of Chula Vista., Calif., at San Diego Country Club, a posh place that Kim didn't see as a junior golfer. ... Farnsworth is the third straight amateur to take the title, following Stephanie Miller last year and Madasyn Pettersen in 2015. Miller played as a pro this year and finished 27th. ... Amateurs have won 13 of the 23 editions of the IWO. Emily Collins was the last professional to win, in 2014. ... Farnsworth had five straight 3s on her card on the back nine of her opening 67, and nine 3s in all. A pair of bogeys prevented her from breaking the women's course record of 66. ... Kim fired a 67 with a single bogey in the second round.

Flavin overhauls Hahn in dramatic final round

Conor Flavin doesn't play much golf these days. Upcoming medical school takes up much of his time and thoughts these days.

But he knows the game, and he knows his brother Patrick. That combination, plus some tremendous play by Patrick Flavin, led to a moment to savor in the final round of the 87th Illinois Amateur.

Flavin, a Highwood resident entering his senior year at Miami of Ohio, had opened the final day four strokes in arrears of leader Jordan Hahn. Normally, he and the rest of the field would have 36 holes to catch Hahn, but a pair of drenching thunderstorms, the second hitting Calumet Country Club just after dawn, turned the July 20 schedule on its ear. Officials of the Chicago District Golf Association realized a 36-hole day was impossible and amended the schedule from 72 holes to 54. One round would finish it.

"I had to go out and get off to a really good start," Flavin said.

He did, which leads to the final hole, and a spot to the left side of the fairway. A spot that

would make a nice spot for a picnic lunch. Unfortunately, Flavin had to play a shot. One that could – one way or the other – determine the winner.

Hahn, a lanky lad from Spring Grove who is entering his junior year on Wisconsin's team, was in the middle of the fairway. He also trailed Flavin by a stroke after a 17-hole thrill ride across Calumet's leafy acreage.

Flavin needed a par. He studied the situation.

Then Conor spoke up.

"Hey, it's fine," he told his younger brother. "Don't worry about it. We've got this."

Flavin pulled a 6-iron and fashioned a shot that would have done Roy McAvoy proud.

"I had 188 into the wind and I had to hit it below a branch and over a tree, and hook it," Patrick Flavin explained.

Well, when you explain it that way...

"I hit a perfect 6-iron and fortunately it landed soft on the front fringe and trickled out to about 30 feet," Flavin recalled.

He called it the shot of the day. It was, after he and Hahn two-putted, the shot that won the Illinois Amateur.

"I had a nice window," Flavin said of his spot in the trees.

Flavin finished at 10-under-par 200 after a closing 67, Hahn a stroke back after finishing with a 2-over 72.

Hahn and Flavin weren't the only players on the course – 40 made the cut – but by the turn, who would grasp the Louis Emmerson Trophy was a two-man question.

Flavin had made up his four-stroke disadvantage with a pair of birdies on the fourth and fifth holes, combined with Hahn miscues. Flavin birdied the seventh hole – his fourth bird of the round – Hahn the ninth, and they were tied.

Doesn't the Illinois Amateur always begin on the back nine on Thursday? This one did.

It got serious on the par-5 13th, when Flavin smacked his tee shot to the left, into the fifth fairway, knocked his second down the fairway, and rejoined Hahn on the green, sinking an eight-foot birdie putt while Hahn bogeyed.

Instantly, Flavin led by two, and the margin was three when Hahn bogeyed the 14th. It stayed there, Flavin having made a fine par save from a greenside bunker on the 16th, until Hahn sank a 25-footer for birdie at the 17th.

Then came the recovery shot that had to be seen to be believed, and Flavin, after finishing

sixth, both solo and with company, the previous two years, finally snagged the biggest amateur prize available in the state.

Flavin had started out white hot, making birdies on the first five holes – Calumet members will have to birdie Nos. 5 through 9 to duplicate the feat, as the routing was shifted forward five holes to avoid a traffic jam at the normal first and 10th tees, which are adjacent – and opened with a 63, one off the course record at the time.

"I hit a bunch of good shots at the start, got comfortable fast and made a bunch of putts," Flavin said after his opening round. "I was giving myself lots of chances and fortunately I got them

all to go in. It calmed the nerves real quick, it was great to get off to a good start.”

But Flavin was not alone. Trent Wallace, a Joliet resident who will be a junior at Illinois State in the fall, also crafted a 63 for a two-stroke lead on fellow Redbird Zach Burry.

“I kept the ball in play all round, kept it below the hole, which you need to do out here, and just trusted the putter,” Wallace said. “When I got (here), my teammate (Burry) had just come in at a 65, so I thought that was pretty low, and then I got out there and the greens were perfect, so I just tried to take it as low as possible.”

Wallace would finish tied for third with Charlie Netzel and David Perkins at 5-under 205, with Perkins’ closing 67 the fastest finish of the three. It matched Flavin for the final day’s best round.

Hahn’s 61 was, he said, “(O)ne of those

rounds where the pros talk about being in the zone,” Hahn said. “I just felt comfortable over the ball. I felt confident and just freed myself up and was happy with whatever the result was because I knew I was committed to the shot.”

Hahn birdied four of the first five holes, but his ace on the 210-yard seventh – a one-hop 7-iron – made him 6-under through seven holes.

“It was a little downwind, it landed 3 feet short of the hole, jumped up and looked from the tee like I jarred it,” Hahn said. “I just threw my hands up. I didn’t see (my first ace) go in, so it was pretty cool to see this one go in.”

Hahn turned in 7-under 28 and settled for 61 after a bogey at the 17th following three birdies earlier on the back nine for the four-stroke edge on Flavin and Burry that proved, after Flavin’s final push, not enough.

Golf in a total eclipse? Of course!

August 21 sky spectacular crosses Carbondale, clear skies or not

Have you ever been in the dark on a golf course? Can't find your way? Can't see the green to save your bogey?

Then Mon., August 21 will be your day.

Go to the south end of the state and tee it up there at midday. Soon enough, you and everyone around you will be in the dark – literally.

That's the day the moon will cross in front of the sun in one of the solar system's amazing – and predictable – celestial events, a total eclipse of the sun. The path of totality will run from Oregon to South Carolina, and around here, from the southern edge of St. Louis, across the state to between Brownfield and Golconda before crossing the Ohio River into Kentucky.

That path runs right through Carbondale. The bash of bashes is slated for Saluki Stadium at Southern Illinois University, the football

palace being given over to the wonder of science for the day, a presentation by the university and Chicago's Adler Planatarium for \$25 admission, the price including eclipse glasses which you can look at the sun before and after totality.

But the precise center of the path is steps from the back of the clubhouse at Keller's Crossing at Stone Creek, the Makanda course that reopened this year after two years of dormancy.

Needless to say, they're throwing a party at Keller's Crossing. The total eclipse shotgun tournament tees off at 8 a.m., and everybody will be in – and gathered around the clubhouse and ninth green, which is on the other edge of the center line from the clubhouse – scientists have this figured to the millimeter and split-second – for the run-up to 1:21 p.m., when totality begins.

It will run for 2 minutes 41.2 seconds, the longest run of any point on the path. A few miles east and west will enjoy about the same time under

the moon, so to speak, so Hickory Ridge in Carbondale and Kokopelli a few miles northeast in Marion will also be places to play and gawk at the wonder of it all, though so narrow is the path Kokopelli will have only about 2:25 of totality. But Keller's Crossing is ground zero when it comes to eclipse-rich golf courses in Illinois.

"Everyone's saying it'll be crazy, and the police chief said, 'Don't count on any help from us,'" owner Jason Chrzan said a month out of the great darkening. "Some people say everybody's coming, and some say nobody's going to come."

Chrzan expects his 100-person tournament to sell out, and for families of players to be on hand as well. (Call (618) 351-4653 to reserve a spot, if any remain. Breakfast, lunch and a tee gift are included.)

Since Keller's Crossing is on the edge of a private neighborhood, players will get a parking pass, lest the expectations of hundreds of thousands of eclipse fans cramming into the path of totality, many of them chasing the point of greatest totality, come true. It could be the traffic jam to end all traffic jams.

Two years ago, rooms in the Carbondale-Marion area sold out at maximum prices, and for multi-night stays. Over three months ago, the only rooms left as far north as Effingham were in hotels that critics suggested were akin to the Bates Motel. Many will probably make it a one-day trip, given the 5-hour distance from Chicago to Carbondale on a typical non-eclipse trek.

Hickory Ridge has nothing on its website about a special event on Eclipse Day, so it may be possible to tee it up for the regular \$30 weekday price – twilight doesn't start until 4 p.m., so don't be funny – and be on the course when everything goes dark. The Links at Kokopelli similarly is

mum on any specials, though that course is close to Interstate 57 and thus wouldn't be nearly as secluded – and dark – as Hickory Ridge, on the north edge of Carbondale.

Mouw the cat's meow in 100th Western Junior
Californian rolls to eight-stroke victory

William Mouw, a 16-year-old from Chino, Calif., made his long walk look easy on the final day of the 100th Western Junior. He showed stamina and skill in mastering the 36-hole final and posting a record-tying, wire-to-wire victory at Park Ridge Country Club in Park Ridge on June 22.

Mouw, who held a two-shot lead heading into the final day, strolled away from the field with a pair of 3-under 67s for a 72-hole total of 266. In second, a distant eight shots back at 274, was Karl Vilips, 15, of Australia.

In winning, Mouw tied the 72-hole record set by Hunter Mahan in 1999 on the Tradition course at Treetops Sylvan Resort in Michigan. He said he prepared by walking 36 holes six straight days to prepare for the arduous final day. That preparation helped him best the heat and humidity that blanketed Park Ridge throughout the day, and paved the way to his win.

"It was one of the toughest golf days I've played, but my legs are doing well," said Mouw, a junior at Ontario Christian School in Ontario, Calif. "I drank 20 bottles of water and a couple of Gatorades and think I ate about six bananas."

Mouw, who built his lead to 6-under after 54 holes, said he kept his focus by setting a goal to beat himself.

"I was going to go as low as I could today," he said. "My goal was 67 and I hit my goal both times."
