Stonebridge rescues ‘Birdies’

Kudos to Stonebridge Country Club for stepping up on short notice – and on a holiday weekend – to host the Illinois PGA’s Birdies for Charity fundraising marathon on Tuesday, Sept. 4. The payoff: about \$425,000 via 1,014 birdies in one long, rewarding day.

Held at River Forest Country Club in Elmhurst since its inception in 2011, the big day was in danger of not being played because of the continual deluges the western and northern suburbs have been inundated with for over a week. Addison Creek runs through the east side of River Forest’s course, and it was more like a lake on a couple of holes as Tuesday approached. The rest of the course was soggy.

Realizing the problem was worsening by the hour, River Forest head pro **Chris Gumbach** reached out for help, and Stonebridge, where **Andrew Stevens** is the head pro, answered. Quickly, arrangements were made to move the day-long deal – play begins at 7 a.m., which the pros playing continuously all day, perhaps as many as 90 holes, going for birdies above all else – to Stonebridge.

The club would otherwise be closed on the day after a Monday holiday, so it wasn’t a matter of displacing members, but it still meant opening the locker room, and making sure the grounds staff would have the course ready. And it’s rained plenty at Stonebridge as well.

The entire day here was the brainchild of **Travis Johns**, a teaching pro at Medinah. The Australian was

in the North Texas PGA Section and was among the Aussies mulling how to create a charity event.

“There were seven other pros who were born in Australia and working in the Dallas area,” Johns told **Len Ziehm** for IllinoisPGA.com. “We felt fortunate to be working in the United States and wondered how we could give back.”

Another Aussie, **Mark Harrison**, just happened to be running the North Texas PGA. He figured a marathon day tied to fundraising – people pledging money for each birdie a pro made – would work. Thus, Birdies for Charity, the name the same as the similar fundraiser used to great success by the John Deere Classic.

In the first eight years in Dallas, the day raised over \$1 million for charity.

Johns suggested a similar day for the Illinois Section to Gumbach, and the fun began. And in Illinois, any pro could participate.

The inaugural edition in 2011 saw 14 pros playing and \$44,000 raised. By last year, when \$280,000 was raised, the grand total was over \$1.18 million.

“Never in a million years did I think we could crack \$1 million in seven years,” Gumbach said. “That was pretty cool.”

This year, 44 pros from 38 clubs teed it up, while the Central Illinois division debuted its own fundraiser at the Country Club of Decatur.

Charities include the Illinois PGA Foundation, the Ronald McDonald Houses of Chicagoland, and JDRF.

The Grill Room by Tim Cronin

Low score wins, doesn't it?

Low score wins.

Obvious, no?

Your proprietor recalls Curtis Strange mentioning the obvious for a good reason during the madcap 1999 British Open, after Jean Van de Velde threw away a regulation victory but was still alive in the playoff eventually captured by Paul Lawrie.

Balls were flying in every direction but the proper one for a moment, prompting Strange to say, "Low score wins."

If the bizarre idea that leaked out of the PGA Tour office last week comes to pass next year, that may no longer be true. At least, not in the Tour Championship, which as far as the suits are concerned closes the season.

The suits want the winner of the Tour Championship to also be the winner of the season-long FedEx Cup. A logical enough thought, we suppose. We also suppose the easiest way to do that is to dump the point system – already adjusted as the playoffs start – and just go with the scoring at East Lake. Points would qualify the 30 players, as it works now, and matter no more on Thursday morning. The winner of the tournament wins the whole shebang. What could be more simple?

That's too simple for the suits. They want to tie the points to the scoring in 2019. Supposedly, the points leader would start 10-under-par on the scoreboard before he took a swing in anger. The second in points might be 8-under, the third 6-under, the fourth 4-under, the fifth 2-under, and

everyone else would be even.

Then they would play 72 holes, and the player most under the adjusted par would be the winner of the FedEx Cup.

Say Jordan Spieth came in the leader. He gets the 10-under bonus. He shoots an actual 7-under 281 over four rounds. He gets listed as 17-under on the scoreboard.

Say Matt Kuchar, the pride of Georgia, was seventh in points entering East Lake. He shoots 12-under 276. He's properly listed as 12-under.

Say those two guys are the top two finishers. Spieth's real score of 281 isn't as good as Kuchar's 276, but Spieth wins the silverware and the pot of gold that goes with it because the PGA Tour has its thumb on the scale. Kuchar goes home with a laurel and hearty handshake, and the spillover from the pot of gold.

Say it ain't so.

What is supposed to be a legitimate golf competition turns into a Chicago election. His honor the Mayor, as Len O'Connor called Richard J. Daley, would have been proud. Maybe Kim Jong-un, the Pyongyang madman whose pop was said to be a tremendous golf slouch, smiles at the idea.

With this move, the PGA Tour makes the Tour Championship more illegitimate than most of the handicaps in the Crosby Clambake.

You could have a situation where the best five scorers in the tournament end up sixth through 10th because of the contrivance applied beforehand. Explain that to the kiddies in the PGA

Junior League and The First Tee, who are taught that every stroke must be counted and all the rules followed.

Imagine this explanation: "But, kids, if you're really good, we'll take some shots off to make it exciting for television on Sunday afternoon, because we don't want someone winning one thing and someone else winning another."

This hairbrained scheme comes along just as sports betting – over-the-table, that is – begins to increase nationally.

Golf has handicaps so you can play against a player better or poorer than you and the \$2 Nassau still remains competitive. This is not that. This is stupid.

Nobody's talking on the record yet, but we'd imagine the wizards of Ponte Vedra Beach had many a meeting to massage all the fine points. They're big on meetings there, and sometimes even venture into the outside world.

This turns the PGA Tour's big season championship into a sham, and, in the minds of the cynical, casts doubt into everything else the Tour does.

Bobby Jones grew into golf at East Lake. Once, after calling a penalty on himself in the 1925 U.S. Open, Jones was complimented for doing so and responded, "You might as well praise me for not robbing a bank."

We can only imagine what the great man would think of this idea, and of it being applied at his golf course.

He'd hope the Tour suits didn't run banks.

Old and new converge at reimagined Sunset Valley



Architect Rick Jacobson puts together a winner for Highland Park – and there's a new clubhouse, too!

After the decision to keep Sunset Valley, the question was how to renovate it. Rick Jacobson had the answer.

Taking an old golf course and effectively laying a new one on top of it while using as much of the old infrastructure – the sprinkling system, the best of the drainage, and so on – is like gutting an old house and installing new walls, flooring, electrical and water.

“It’s harder than starting from scratch,” said Rick Jacobson, the veteran golf course architect who took over a year to take Sunset Valley Golf Club in Highland Park apart and put it back together, a refreshing remodeling that has already earned raves – and a busy tee sheet.

“We tried to retain as much as we could, like on the ninth green, where the perimeter of the green complex remained the same, but the interior was all resculptured and contoured.

“What you’re trying to do is not make it look like a modern golf course,” Jacobson added. “We tried to make it look like it was from that golden age of golf-course architecture, and introduce some of the classic elements.”

The course reopened on Friday, Aug. 17, and aside from too much rain, the course has been busy since.

“People are coming back to Sunset Valley and they’re saying this is going to be my course

going forward,” Liza McElroy, executive director of the Highland Park Park District, said. “That’s really great for us to hear. The phone’s been ringing off the hook. This is our goal: We want to be a destination site.”

“The most distinguishing change at Sunset Valley is the transformation of a virtually flat golf course into a golf course that dramatically has berms, swales and undulations on each hole,” Ryan Ochs, the superintendent of golf, said.

The par-3 fourth hole has gotten a great deal of attention because of the addition of a lake, but the fifth and 13th have been lengthened, and a large amount of trees have been cleared to enhance vistas, allow morning light to land on greens, thus improving turf conditions.

Jacobsen created a dramatic new ninth green, allowing patrons to watch their friends foozle while having lunch on the patio or in the clubhouse, and the 18th green now connects to an enlarged putting green, much like Oakmont.


"The ninth hole was pitched back to front very severely, so in the clubhouse, all you were looking at was the back of the green," Jacobson said. "We made it more integrated with the clubhouse elevation, and do a Redan-style green."

There's more movement in the greens than most public courses have, specific areas for pin placements with subtle differences between them that will bring three-putting into play more than before.

"It is absolutely sensational," said Joel Hirsch, the Hall of Famer who was instrumental in getting Sunset Valley back on the map. "It's as good, if not better, than many of the country clubs in this area.

"As a kid, I used to jump over the drainage and play the second and third hole of Bob O Link. Now, I think with our golf course, a lot of the members of Bob O Link will be jumping over to play here."

Sunset Valley was a design of Stewart Gardner, whose name has receded into the record books with the passing years, but was highly regarded in his time. It was updated at times over the decades, but in time became a basic municipal golf course, with roundish greens and decent but not spectacular conditions.

TO AND FRO Sunset Valley now features subtle elevation changes, a marked difference from the original pancake-flat look where the biggest change was an elevated tee.

And the clubhouse was, by the 1990s, a bit worn. It was a good place to pay greens fees, buy a sleeve of balls and a hot dog, but not hang out.

A new clubhouse with a lively menu and an inviting presence is the capper on the \$7 million renovation.

It also became less popular as golf interest declined after the Great Recession – and because of longstanding competition with other public courses in the area that had upgrades. But for a time, the park district considered keeping Highland Park Country Club open. In 2015 it picked up that course from the city, which had bought it for \$10 million in 1993.

The intention was to run both courses and have them at least break even, but the drop in public play, even in affluent suburbs like High-

land Park, turned what once would have been a sure winning bet into a loss.

Highland Park Country Club, which opened in 1966, was the poorer of the two courses architecturally, even after Dick Nugent made some revisions in the mid-1990s. It was on poorer land compared to Sunset Valley, so the decision, helped by the vision of Joel Hirsch, who grew up in Highland Park and both caddied and played at Sunset Valley, to keep Sunset as a golf course and turn Highland Park Country Club into a greenspace was the right one.

"This never would have happened without Liza and the wonderful board of trustees in Highland Park," Hirsch said. "Highland Park Country Club is a nice club, mind you, but it's on the far north side of the city, and much more difficult to

get to for kids. And golf is in the hands of the youngsters."

The reshaping of the course in grand scale means a new set of course records, and new pro Patrick Flavin set it on August 22, when it toured it in 5-under-par 67, and had the perspective that only a scratch player with length could have.

"There are a lot of tough tee shots," Flavin said. "It forces you to be aggressive toward the target. If you're not, you're hitting it into a bunker, and then you've got no chance."

That's all part of Jacobson's plan to challenge the better player but give the average player a break.

"It really makes you think your way around," Jacobson said. "You don't just step on the tee and grip it and rip it."

A beauty – and a beast

Aronimink set to test golf's best in the WGA's pro showcase

Expect birdies on a classic Donald Ross course that packs a punch

Two hundred and sixty-four.

That number is what a player would total if he played Aronimink Golf Club in 4-under-par 66 for four straight days.

It would almost surely assure him of being in contention, and perhaps outright victory in the BMW Championship, which commences Thursday, Sept. 6, on a hilly course in a tony suburb on Philadelphia's Main Line that nearly matches Augusta National for scenic views from the veranda outside the clubhouse.

The number under discussion comes from Jordan Spieth, a certified player with four majors in his pocket but lacking this bauble, the Western Open in days of yore. In discussing the challenge Aronimink presents, Spieth volunteered, "Four under a round can win this golf tournament."

Aronimink is a par 70 concoction, designed by Donald Ross in 1928 and updated sympathetically by Gil Hanse recently, offering a layout stretching to 7,267 yards if the PGA Tour's set-up crew is in a foul humor, but will surely play shorter. Spieth noted, as many observers do, that three of the four par-3s, at 221 yards and up, "are definitely the meat of the course. Take your three and run."

"You've got par-5s and par-4s you can hit with wedges," he added with delight.

That means low scores, and while the elevation changes are dramatic – there's a 40-foot dropoff to the landing area on the first hole, which then climbs upward, a slightly less drop off the 10th tee, and return trips up the hill at the ninth and 18th holes – the 70 players in this field, the

de-facto semi-final of the PGA Tour season, know how to handle the ups and downs of typography.

What's needed at Aronimink to keep the course from being run over like a raccoon is a breeze. There's been next to no wind in the practice rounds or in Wednesday's pro-am, where the elite shelled out to play with pros to benefit the Evans Scholars Foundation and the affiliated local Platt Foundation, in 95-degree heat and a 100 heat index. That means the players can aim at ev-

ery open pin placement, and worry only about a bad swing, not a surprise gust.

The tourney has never been played this far east. Buffalo, in 1948, was the previous record.

As has been the case since the Western Open transitioned from a Fourth of July showcase to a playoff semi-final, there's not only a race for the top, but one to avoid elimination from the playoffs. The top 30 in the point standings move on to next week's Tour Championship at East Lake

HEAVEN COME ELEVEN At 425 yards, the par-4 11th hole at Aronimink isn't especially long. But as with most holes on the course, there's more to it than just length. Ten bunkers along the fairway landing area, and 10 more scattered about the green complex, make both the tee and approach shots a thinking man's proposition.

Golf Club. Spieth, 27th in the standings, needs a good week to advance, but didn't profess worry on Wednesday.

"My mind will not be set on any kind of projections, I promise you that," Spieth said. "It's not do or die for me."

At the top of the standings – and second in season money, the old indicator of success in the meritocracy that is professional golf – is Bryson DeChambeau, golf's deep thinker, who has won thrice this season, including the first two play-off tournaments in New Jersey and near Boston. He'd love to go for an Eastern Seaboard sweep this weekend.

"It's very much like Ridgewood (where he won a fortnight ago)," DeChambeau said. "It's got a lot of similarities – slopey greens. There's

really not too many (water) hazards.

"It give me that feel where you've got to drive it straight and hit your irons really well. If you can do that and conquer the greens and slopes, you're going to be right there at the end of the week. It suits my eye really well."

The latter is a phrase Tiger Woods has often used to describe courses he fancies, a list including Cog Hill. Woods, nally t, is in the tournament for the first time since 2013, has won it ve times, and aims to make it six to break a tie with Walter Hagen. Off his recent showings, it wouldn't be a surprise to see Woods win. He's in something of a feature threesome in the first two rounds, playing with Spieth and Rickie Fowler. DeChambeau, Dustin Johnson and Justin Rose are in the threesome right behind them.

Remember Fowler, who contended in the PGA Championship until an oblique injury on his right side caught up with him late? He professes good health now, the partial tear having healed.

"I feel like I'm de nitely a lot more rested and ready to go than most guys here, I'm sure," Fowler said. "It's completely different from how it feels now versus what it felt like at the PGA."

"I haven't gotten a second MRI to see how well it has healed, but I would say I'm close to 100 percent."

Fowler may also have something to prove. Generally considered the best player without one of the traditional four majors in his pocket, Fowler has four career victories.

So does DeChambeau.

By week's end, he may have ve.

Chang makes it happen

Twin Orchard assistant wins marathon tourney in playoff

It was stop and go, more stop than go for too long, and it took four days, which perhaps is among the reasons Dakun Chang, the unflappable one, captured the laurels at Stonewall Orchard Golf Club and won the 97th Illinois PGA Championship.

Thunderstorm delays and close to three inches of rain on top of an already-soggy course meant the 120 players in the field had to adapt as best as they could to a schedule that was ever-shifting. Not everyone could hang around, notably Illinois men's coach Mike Small. A stroke off the lead after 36 holes, Small arrived at the course on Wednesday morning, waited to see when the third round would begin, and withdrew when it was announced his tee time would be 5 p.m.

That would push the conclusion of the round into a fourth day, Thursday, Aug. 30, when he had to be in Champaign on his day job. It was the first day of meetings and practice for his team, and as much as he wanted to win a record 13th title, his team came first.

Chang, a 28-year-old assistant pro at Twin Orchard Country Club, had plenty of competition even without Small's presence, beginning with Medinah Country Club teaching pro Travis

Johns. The lanky lefty from Australia has contended several times in state majors, and this time was no exception. Without Small, Johns and Chang formed a final twosome behind a tee sheet of threesomes for the final round.

In the group ahead were three more threats: 58-year-old Roy Biancalana, back in Illinois and in the game after more than a decade in Florida, much of spent with his clubs in the garage as he worked his day job of relationship coach; White Eagle head pro Curtis Malm, whose Illinois Open title came in 1999; and Royal Hawk head pro Brian Carroll.

It was Carroll who emerged from that threesome to apply the most pressure of Chang. Carroll scored 3-under-par 69 in the final round, the first 10 of which were played before darkness on Wednesday, while Chang scored 1-over 73.

That knotted the duo at 4-under 212, forcing unscheduled golf in the form of a three-hole total-stroke playoff.

A pair of Chang birdies combined with bogeys by Carroll on the first and third playoff holes gave Chang a 11-15 victory.

"He had a rough first playoff hole, so I had to play smart," Chang said.

He did. It paid off in the form of his first state major, earned after he tied for third last year and tied for seventh in 2015, his first year in the Illinois PGA Section. This triumph indicates he'll be a threat for decades to come.

"I'd been contention the last couple years, so this feels really good," Chang said.

Chang won \$11,200 along with getting his name on the Jim Kemper Cup. He dropped a six-foot birdie putt on the first playoff hole, the par-5 third, and one of similar length on the par-5 18th to close things out after Carroll's last hope ended

when his approach leaked left and found a pond.

"I had 295 in, so it wasn't like I was going to get anywhere back by the pin, but I thought I could get close to the front edge and maybe make a long one or chip in," Carroll said. "But I hammed it too far left."

Chang, a 26-year-old native of Asheville, N.C., who had a good college career at Methodist University, a Division III school, came into the storm-delayed final eight holes leading by two, but bogeyed the 11th and 12th to fall behind Carroll, who birdied No. 11 just ahead of Chang.

"I had a rough start," Chang said. "I just

wanted to get back in my game plan, try not to worry about it too much."

He steadied his game with a par on the 13th and climbed back into a tie for the lead with a six-foot birdie putt on the devilish par-4 14th after a tremendous approach shot from the right rough. He was 139 yards out and in a divot. While lift-clean and place was played in the fairway all week, Chang would get no relief in the rough.

"That was a good shot," Chang said, smiling.

Carroll was on his way to parring in, and Chang did the same on the last four holes, setting

up the playoff. Carroll scored 3-under 69 in the final round, the first 10 holes of which were played on Wednesday before darkness, while Chang scored 1-over 73.

"The last three holes I had a lot of chances, but nothing fell," Chang said.

Carroll was in the same situation. His birdie on No. 11 from six feet was followed by seven straight pars.

"I was four shots out coming into the third round," Carroll said. "I got a little bit back yesterday, got one (birdie) to start the day but couldn't get another to get to 5-under. I didn't think 4-under

was going to be enough. I thought 5-under at least. I was lucky enough to be in the playoff."

His drive on the first playoff hole landed in the left fairway bunker, and things went downhill from there, but he grabbed his best finish in the section championship regardless, plus \$8,200.

"I've been trying to snag a major out here, and coming close," Carroll said. "Semi-finals in the Match Play this year before Chris Green knocked me out, a good first round in the Illinois Open two years ago. So I'll keep playing good golf and see what happens."

Curtis Malm of White Eagle in Naperville took third with a closing 1-under 71 for 2-under 214, his fifth top-three finish in the Illinois PGA Championship. Chris Ioriatti (70), Green (71) and Travis Johns (74) tied for fourth at 1-under 215. Ioriatti birdied twice on Thursday morning, Green birdied the last, and Johns, playing with Chang, missed too many birdie chances for him to recount, and couldn't get Wednesday's double-bogey on the par-3 fifth out of his mind. His approach flew into the hazard.

"I didn't deal with it very well," said Johns, who posted his sixth top-five finish since joining the Illinois Section in 2010. "I don't mind making a bad score if I hit a bad shot, which I hit plenty of, but that

one wasn't bad. I just misjudged the wind."

With Chang, Carroll and Small already exempt into next year's PGA Professional Championship, the next nine finishers made the field: Malm, Ioriatti, Green, Johns, Matt Slowinski, Steve Orrick, Biancalana, Luke Hemelstrand and Tim Streng. Slowinski's solo seventh is his ninth top-10 finish, while Orrick's solo eighth is his seventh in the top 10.

The unsung heroes of the week populated the Stonewall Orchard grounds crew, headed by superintendent Larry Flament. Working long hours in heat, cold and rain, they kept the course playable.



Streelman ready to judge again

Wilson's second 'Driver vs. Driver' TV contest slated for fall

Kevin Streelman is a down-to-earth guy who has had more success in recent years than any other Illinois-bred player on the PGA Tour – D.A. Points of Pekin his main competition in that regard.

Points has more wins on the circuit – three to Streelman's two – but Streelman, more consistent, has won more money, with \$17,208,133 to Points' \$11,786,774. Clearly, there are no losers in this competition.

Streelman recently returned to his roots, devoting a day to youth golf for the Illinois Junior Golf Association at Cantigny Golf in Wheaton, where he grew up playing. (He also caddied at Chicago Golf Club.)

"We probably had 150 or 200 kids and a bunch of parents," Streelman said at the PGA Championship. "It's one of my favorite days always, to give back to the IJGA, which was so important to me as I was getting started in the game. It worked out really well."

"He's an easy guy to root for," said Jeff Reiter of Cantigny Park and the McCormick Foundation, parent operation for the golf course.

An endorser of Wilson Staff clubs, he's also eager to see the result of the reprise of the Wilson Golf-backed television series *Driver vs. Driver*. This one, with a "2" appended to the title, will run Tuesdays beginning Oct. 2 on Golf Channel, pitting competitors who designed drivers against each other, and the winning model being put into production by the Chicago-based company.

Last time, Wilson got more publicity than it cared for, needing to recall the winning driver from stores days after it went on sale when the USGA ruled it non-conforming.

The company, in trying to keep secret the result and follow the FCC's rules for game shows – as a competition, *Driver vs. Driver* falls into that category just as much as *The Price is Right* and all the reality shows clogging network airwaves in prime time – didn't submit the winner to the USGA for testing until shortly before the already-taped broadcast aired, and the USGA found the bottom plate of the club protruded just a bit. It was like a stock car failing NASCAR tech inspection and being tossed from the Daytona 500. Oops.

This time, insiders say, all the behind-the-scenes work, including USGA submission, will be accomplished in time for the broadcasts to air without Wilson executives sweating the result of the test at Golf House.

The panel includes Wilson Golf president Tim Clarke, former Blackhawk and low-handicapper Jeremy Roenick (last time it was former Bear Brian Urlacher), and Rick Shiels, a golf pro with 400,000 YouTube followers and best known as a club equipment reviewer. Streelman was a judge last time as well.

"I've seen the final three, and I'm not sure who the champion's going to be," Streelman said, adding that he's likely to play the winning club

on the Tour. "I would say moreso (a chance he'll play it) than the first one.

"Two of the three drivers look just perfect. Clean shapes, really good-looking, great technology. Things we really haven't seen before out here on Tour."

"It's different when we get the final pieces and we get our shafts in it at the right weight. Just trying to head out with a random shaft is not how we test drivers out here. I'm excited to get the final one and dial it in."

Streelman is 39, and his world has changed since he turned pro in 2001.

"It's funny," he said after the first round of the PGA. "When you have children, things change. My kids are starting school now. They're not traveling with me as much. Things evolve and

priorities change.

"It may not be 10 hours at the course. Maybe drop Sophie off and then pick her up and take her to lunch and maybe squeeze out again. It's just life. It's the same for all of us."

People

Dylan Meyer isn't listed in our Tour Guide chart on Page 30, partly because he's from Evansville, Ind., but also because there aren't easily accessible stats for him since he isn't yet a full member of the PGA Tour. But Meyer's won \$275,109 this season, already good enough for 693rd on the circuit's all-time money list. **Doug Ghim** of Arlington Heights is 752nd at \$116,527, and **Nick Hardy**'s 796th all-time with \$54,120 earned on the big tour since turning pro. Those totals don't include Web.com Tour earnings.
