# The Buzz

## Deere exempts four aces

**Clair Peterson**, like **Kim Hougham** before him, thinks long-term.

Tournament directors on the PGA Tour have to be that way when trying to entice players to their weekends. Otherwise, the answer “no thanks,” which is heard more often than “you bet” in most cases, would drive people to bouts of depression.

Peterson is the boss of the John Deere Classic, and he’s succeeded turning the Qual Cities’ annual golf blowout into one of the incubators of talent on the PGA Tour. He’s followed the concept inaugurated by Hougham, whom he worked alongside, in inviting the best of the brightest of the college set to spend a week in Silvis.

“With players like **Zach Johnson**, **Jordan Spieth**, **Jason Day**, **Justin Thomas** and **Patrick Reed** having gone on to stardom, we think it has worked out very well for both the players and our fans,” Peterson said.

**Bryson DeChambeau** have come fresh-faced into the John Deere Classic, and have returned at least a couple of times after they made it big.

Spieth made it big right at TPC Deere Run, winning as a teenager in 2013. Nobody had done that on the PGA Tour since **Ralph Guldahl** at Riviera in 1931. Spieth repeated in 2015.

DeChambeau triumphed at Deere Run, albeit in his early 20s, two years ago, two years after winning the U.S. Amateur at Olympia Fields Country Club.

This year, Peterson may have outdone himself. He’s gotten commitments from the top four players in the Scratch Players ranking of amateurs at the time of their invitation. The quality quartet:

1. **Victor Hovland** (Oslo, Norway; Oklahoma State), last year’s U.S. Amateur champion, and also low amateur at this year’s Masters and U.S. Open;

2. **Collin Morikawa** (La Canada Flintridge, Calif.; California), this year’s Pacific 12 champion;

3. **Matthew Wolff** (Agoura Hills, Calif.; Oklahoma State), this year’s NCAA individual champion, also tied for 50th in the Phoenix Open;

4. **Justin Suh** (San Jose, Calif; USC), a four-time All-America player.

“We are thrilled to have such an outstanding group of top young players competing in this year’s John Deere Classic,” Peterson said. “It gives our fans an opportunity to see them up-close and makes it interesting for them to follow the trajectory of their careers.”

Peterson has four exemptions remaining. Two have to go to Tour players, but he can hand the others to whoever he fancies.

Peterson picks well. Since the 2000, John Deere Classic sponsor exemptions have featured seven major champions, five winners of the John Deere Classic and nine winners of other PGA Tour events.

“We think it has worked out very well for both the players and our fans,” Peterson said.

# A niagara of success for Illinoisans

It wasn't even three full years ago, after Dave Ryan of Taylorville annexed the U.S. Senior Open, that in this space it was asked, "Why aren't there more here like Dave Ryan?"

The question was posed because of the paucity of success Illinois golfers had nationally, from USGA championships to the PGA Tour to everything else.

Now we have an answer we like: There are more here like Dave Ryan.

There's Megan Furtney, the high schooler from South Elgin headed to Duke in the fall, who teamed with Erica Shepherd of Indiana to win the U.S. Amateur Women's Four-Ball in early May. They were on our cover last month.

There's Todd Mitchell, the Bloomington businessman who teamed with Scott Harvey of North Carolina to win the men's U.S. Amateur Four-Ball in late May. They're on our cover this month.

There's also Highwood's Patrick Flavin, who beat fellow Illinoisan Tim "Tee-K" Kelly at the Olympic Golf Course in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil back in February to win the PGA Tour Latino-america qualifying tournament, and more recently won the Bupa Match Play Championship on that circuit in his first full year as a professional.

This is good news, and more may be on the way. Kevin Streelman's already cashed nearly \$1.4 million of checks on the PGA Tour, and finished fourth at The Memorial. Scott Langley finished sixth at Pebble Beach. Luke Donald, coming back into form after a long injury lay-

off, tied for ninth at Innisbrook, where he'd won before, and made the U.S. Open field.

Doug Ghim's won \$72,900 on the Web.com Tour with a tie for third in Bogota, Colombia. Brad Hopfinger's shown flashes of breaking through, finishing eighth in the Bahamas.

Along with that, Northbrook's Nick Hardy, an Illinois standout for four years, leads a contingent of five Illinois-connected players, including Glen Ellyn's Andy Pope, Illinois grads Luke Guthrie, Thomas Pieters, and Donald, the erstwhile Northwestern notable, into the fray at Pebble Beach. Hardy, who finished 52nd at Chambers Bay in 2015, made it through local and sectional qualifiers to advance to the big show for the third time.

Neither Streelman, Langley nor Ghim are in the Open, and nor is Illinois grad Dylan Meyer, who finished 20th last year at Shinnecock Hills. That shows how hard it is to qualify for the National Open, and how deep pro golf is in general.

It's a tough road. Mitchell, who played baseball in college, barely entertained the thought of turning pro when he took up amateur golf seriously. Furtney will have that decision to make after what's expected to be a stellar career at Duke. Perhaps she'll be the one who holds the Illinois torch high on the LPGA circuit.

Furtney and Mitchell appear to be the first Illinois natives to win USGA titles in the same year. (Chick Evans doubled up with the U.S. Open and U.S. Amateur in 1916, but he was born in Indianapolis.) Otherwise, the state's been fortunate to

have one winner in a given year.

So kudos to them and their partners, and now comes the hard part: repeating. But they don't have to think about that until next year.

Our belief that the PGA Championship wouldn't be a big hit in May came to pass. Tickets were available for next to nothing on the secondary market in New York, and TV ratings were lukewarm at best, battling the Stanley Cup and NBA playoffs, and Saturday's Preakness Stakes.

Sunday's CBS telecast earned a 3.3 Nielsen rating and 5.01 million viewers, beaten by a Toronto-Milwaukee NBA playoff game (3.7 rating) on ABC. Saturday's third round rating of 2.3, with 3.36 million viewers, was beaten by the Golden State-Houston playoff (4.2) on ABC and the Preakness (3.4) on NBC. (Fox' U.S. Open final round had a 4.2 rating and 6.7 million viewers.)

It didn't help that Tiger Woods missed the cut. Friday's second round on TNT drew a 1.05 rating and 1.46 million viewers, up 6 percent compared to 2018, largely to see if *El Tigre* would advance.

The date shift from 2018 makes comparisons difficult. But last year's final round of the Players Championship, played a week earlier in May, scored a 3.6 rating with 5.77 million viewers on NBC, some 760,000 more than watched Koepka hang on at Bethpage Black.

This is too bad for the PGA of America, but don't feel sorry for the suits. Next year, a lucrative new TV deal with CBS and ESPN kicks in.

# Mitchell, Harvey gain glory

*Bloomington vet  
and Carolinian  
combine for title*

**T**he story of how Todd Mitchell finally won a USGA championship starts not at Bandon Dunes, where he and pal Scott Harvey accomplished the deed in the U.S. Amateur Four-Ball on May 29, but 11 years earlier.

Mitchell, then 30, was in the title match of the U.S. Mid-Amateur in 2008, but fell to Steve Wilson 5 and 4 in the 36-hole final at Milwaukee Country Club. With it came an invitation to the 2009 Masters. Mitchell got an “atta boy” for coming close.

Ouch.

Then advance the clock to the 2017 U.S. Amateur at Riviera Country Club in California. Mitchell had gone round in a sparkling 67 in the first qualifying round. He was in excellent shape to advance to match play. Elated, he walked out of the scoring tent – without signing his scorecard.

Oops.

Now come with us to Bandon Dunes on cliffs

above the Oregon coast, where he and Harvey, who had advanced to the semifinal of the inaugural Four-Ball at the Olympic Club in 2015, were churning their way through the field again. They had done so in workmanlike fashion their first 71 holes, with nary a bogey on their card. Even in best-ball play, where only the better score of the duo is recorded on a hole, that's stout work, especially over a long stretch.

Mitchell, an insurance salesman from Bloomington, and Harvey, a property manager from Kernersville, N.C., hit it off at a tournament some-

where on the trail a few years ago, and decided to team up when the USGA created the Four-Ball as a replacement for the U.S. Amateur Public Links. They had been regulars in match play, and this year, the experience paid off.

The 40-year-olds, seeded seventh after qualifying, were matched against a pair of 20-year-olds and East Carolina teammates, Logan Shuping and Blake Taylor, in the final. Only briefly did the kids have a glimmer of hope against the cagey veterans, that when Mitchell and Harvey made their second bogey of the week. It came on the

10th hole and allowed Shuping and Taylor, the No 17 seeds, to square the match.

Shuping and Taylor birdied the 13th to take the lead in the single-round match, but then Mitchell, who had a taste of minor-league baseball before going into business, stepped to the plate.

He birdied the short par-4 14th from the rough after Shuping three-putted for par after driving the green, squaring the match. Mitchell reached the par-5 15th in two, then two-putted for birdie from 62 feet via a lag to two feet, to go 1 up.

Mitchell then provided the shot of the match on the par-4 16th, drilling an 8-iron within five feet of the cup, a blind approach over a hill that moved he and Harvey to dormie 2.

Three straight birdies to win three straight holes.

"I finally showed up," Mitchell said. "Something needed to happen, one way or the other. I felt like there for a while early on, things were kind of on our side, and then we lost a little bit of the momentum."

Mitchell and Harvey won when the teams halved the 17th with pars.

"I don't know that I can have a better feeling from a golf and competition side," Mitchell said. "I know (Scott) won the Mid-Am by himself. As close as Scott and I have become over the past probably six years, I'm elated that it happened like this."

As was Harvey.

"Like he said out there, this is the best event going currently, and it's just more fun," Harvey said. "Everything you're doing is with someone. You're sharing every part of it with someone, and it just feels that much better."

Getting to the final wasn't easy. Just as they

rallied in the title match, Mitchell and Harvey came from behind in the quarterfinals to post a 3 and 2 victory over second-seeded Derek Ackerman and Matthew McCarty, a pair of former teammates at Santa Clara, a pair of mid-round birdies turning the tide.

Harvey ran down a 12-footer on the eighth hole and Mitchell deposited a 40-foot bomb from off the green on the 10th. The barrage continued with Mitchell's eight-footer on the 13th of Old MacDonald and Harvey's up-and-down birdie from the dirt cart path on the 15th to all but finish Ackerman and McCarty off.

"It was extremely difficult, so we're pleased with how we played," Harvey told USGA.com.

Their semifinal match was a comparative rout, a 4 and 3 victory over Troy Vannucci and Vince Kwon, the No. 3 seeds, and like Ackerman and McCarty one of the three co-medalist pairs. It came as

the marine layer faded away and the wind came up on the Oregon coast, which caused the USGA to adjust some tees for the championship match.

Mitchell and Harvey had been turned back earlier than the semis since the inaugural at the Olympic Club, but felt their games matched up well and kept qualifying for the Four-Ball.

They certainly had great success individually, from Harvey's U.S. Mid-Amateur crown and a host of titles in the Carolinas to Mitchell's back-to-back Illinois Amateur titles in 2002 and 2003.

Now, the hard work has paid off. Unlike the Mid-Amateur, the victory doesn't bring with it a Masters invitation, but they get a 10-year exemption into the Four-Ball, and it's easy to see them winning at least one more.

Their defense of the title comes next May at the Philadelphia Cricket Club.

## Woodland hangs on

*Thwarts Koepka's threeppeat bid, puts Wilson back in winner's circle*

**D**eserved or not, Gary Woodland had heard the questions. “Hey, big hitter, when are you going to win?” is generally how they went.

Woodland, one of the many of the current generation who can bash the ball from here to eternity, had taken a trophy home before, notably at Phoenix last year, but not often before the 119th United States Open at Pebble Beach Golf Links.

What he had done recently is contend in majors. He was in the final two-some with Tiger Woods in last year's PGA Championship at Bellerive. He finished tied for sixth there and tied for eighth in this year's PGA at Bethpage Black.

Under the tutelage of Pete Cowan, a Yorkshireman with a way to coax the best out of the biggest – he also teaches Brooks Koepka – he had learned how to hang around.

In reality, he had learned how to win. Trusting his judgment and his swing, he did just that at Pebble Beach, holding off no less than twice-defending champion and world No. 1 Koepka to score his first major championship via a closing 67 and aggregate of 271, 13 under par.

“He's not really a teacher; he's a coach,” Woodland said of Cowan, who was flying home to England by the time Woodland lifted the U.S. Open trophy. “He tells you, ‘This is the game plan. This is what we're going to do.’ And then it's up to me to go out and do it.

“He sent me an unbelievable text on Sunday morning that had nothing to do

with my golf swing or technique. He said, ‘Every man dies but not every man lives, and you live for this moment.’ He knows what to say and when to say it.”

Woodland switched to Cowan at the end of 2018. He switched equipment at the same time, going to Ping woods, Wilson irons and a mix of Titleist and TaylorMade wedges – and signed with Wilson, he was so enamored of their irons, and Wilson of him.

“We looked at Gary a few years back before he did the deal with the equipment company (Under Armour) that didn’t go the full term,” Wilson golf VP Tim Clarke said on WNDZ-AM’s Golfers On Golf. “When we signed him, we looked at him as he’s going to win a major. So the major bonus check is being written. I was thrilled to write it.

“For a big, strong American to win the U.S. Open at iconic Pebble Beach with an iconic brand, I don’t think we could have had a better stage.”

Woodward’s two critical shots down the stretch were his booming approach with a Ping 3-wood to the par-5 14th after slipping on his drive and the delicately devilish chip on the par-3 17th, in which he wielded a TaylorMade 64-degree Hi-Toe lob wedge to get from one side of the hourglass green to the other. That will stand with Jack Nicklaus’ 1-iron in 1972 and Tom Watson’s hole-out wedge a decade later as signature shots on the signature hole on Pebble’s back nine.

“I had the chip on 17 earlier this week,” Woodland said in his post-round debrief. “It’s the second time I’ve gotten it up and down. But I was just trying to get it over the hump. It came off perfectly.”

When it did, when he had a two-footer for par, when he could walk to the 18th tee with a two-stroke lead on Koepka and everyone else hidden

by the marine layer, realists knew the Open was his. But he didn’t get ahead of himself.

“I didn’t allow myself to dream,” Woodland said. “I never got ahead.”

Until the 30-footer for birdie fell into the cup at the last, that is.

For Woodland, the outcome moved him to the next level in golf expectations. While he was someone who was a potential factor, now he’ll be expected to be one. That’s just below the likes of Koepka, who is at least a co-favorite with Rory McIlroy entering the British Open at Royal Portrush, and very good company indeed.

If anything goes wrong, Woodland can listen to Cowan or merely check a video of how he was swinging at Pebble.

“We’ve been working on the full swing only since December and I’m hitting it as good as I ever have,” Cowan said.

For Wilson, the one-time powerhouse in golf equipment with MacGregor and Spalding – the latter two now mere brand names owned by others – it’s a return to the spotlight, at least for a while. Wilson, a division of one conglomerate currently being sold to another, hadn’t had a sponsored player win a major since Pádraig Her-

rington in the 2000s, and hadn't had a U.S. Open winner since Payne Stewart in 1991. Woodland's win also extended Wilson's record string of decades with a major winner to 10, dating to Gene Sarazen in the 1922 U.S. Open at Skokie.

All that is charming, and will look good in advertising copy, but will it sell golf clubs?

"Our market shares in Europe are bigger than a lot of brands," said Clarke, who overnights to California to walk with Woodland's group in the final round. "Here in the States, where people get caught up in the marketing rather than the performance of the equipment, maybe we get a little bit

lost, but our market share over the last seven to 10 years has been on a steady up climb. I think the best is yet to come."

For his part, Koepka didn't go away feeling badly about his double defense. He's finished 1-2-1-2 in the last four majors, two of which were PGAs thanks to that championship's controversial shift from August to May.

"It doesn't sting," Koepka said. "I played great. Nothing I could do. Gary played a great four days. Cool way (for him) to go out on 18, make that bomb. He deserves it, he works hard and I'm happy for him."

Now Willie Anderson goes back to obscurity until the next back-to-back U.S. Open champion.

"I didn't really think about it until I was done on 18 and realized how close I actually was to kind of, not making history but kind of tying it."

While Woodland was holding off Koepka and a cast of challengers ranging from Justin Rose, who faded to a tie for third with a 74, to Xander Schauffele, down the standings Viktor Hovland was serving notice that he'll be a formidable challenger once he gets his professional feet under him. Hovland, who won the U.S. Amateur at Pebble Beach last August, added the low amateur title to the one he grabbed at the Masters in April. In doing so, his total of 4-under 280 was a stroke lower than the total by Jack Nicklaus in the 1960 U.S. Open at Cherry Hills near Denver.

"It's obviously cool to perform such a thing," Hovland said. "I hope this will feed or I can feed off this going into my professional career ... be in contention of winning tournaments.

"It was nice to finish with a birdie and shoot 4-under at a course that I really like."

If all goes well, he'll return to Pebble Beach in February for the Crosby Clambake – a.k.a. the AT&T National Pro-Am.

Woodland will almost surely be there as well, and this time paid much more attention for his game than his good nature, as in his instant friendship with Amy Bockerstette, the college golfer with Down Syndrome which blossomed at the Phoenix Open.

You win a U.S. Open, you land in the feature groups automatically. He'll be paired with Koepka and Tiger Woods – who tied for 21st at 2-under 282 – and the other usual suspects, and two good reasons.

He's a tremendous player, and a great guy.

# Stricker shakes down the thunder

*Motivated by loss, he beats Kelly and Toms by 6 at Notre Dame's Warren Course*

The motivated golfer can be a handful. Steve Stricker proved this across four days on Notre Dame's Warren Course. Miffed that he lost the previous weeks American Family Championship to pal and fellow Wisconsinite Jerry Kelly at University Ridge in Madison, Wis., he took it out on Kelly and the rest of the field in the 40th U.S. Senior Open.

The Warren Course wasn't expected to be Pine Valley, but nor was it expected to be a pushover. It was to Stricker, who opened with an 8-under 62, followed it with a 64, then coasted through the weekend with rounds of 66 and 69 to finish at 19-under-par 261, the aggregate a record, the score in relation to par tying a record, and the six-stroke margin of Kelly and defending champion David Toms tying another mark.

In short, nobody had a chance, all because Stricker and wife Nicki thought they had thrown one away the week before.

Nicki, who caddied for her husband early in his PGA Tour career – including his Western Open win at Cog Hill in 1996 – is doing so again at times. She was unhappy she misread a putt in the final round of the AmFam. He was unhappy

he lost. That made the five-hour drive from Madison to Notre Dame a cathartic one.

How on were the Strickers within the glow of the Golden Dome? They all but called the chip-in on the 12th hole that all but sealed the title.

"Nicki and I had been talking that we've been looking for a chip-in," Stricker said. "I said right before I chipped it, 'I'm still looking for that chip-in,' and she's like, 'I am too.' So maybe (because of) the power of us both thinking about it, it came true."

Why not? Stricker was a wizard across Warren's handsome acreage, making only two bogeys all week.

"I just had a dream week," Stricker said. "There's been a lot of years trying to get one of these (USGA trophies). To get this gold medal and the trophy in a USGA event means a lot."

It's Stricker's second major of the year following his triumph in the Tradition. It make one wonder if Stricker, 52, should have played in the first two Senior Opens in which he was eligible. He skipped the first two after turning 50.

What he needed to do Sunday, as long as Kelly and Toms didn't go crazy, was survive a steamy day. They didn't go crazy – Kelly shot 69, Toms 68 to finish at 13-under 267 – and Stricker plodded around the landscape.

"When you come out with a six-shot lead you have everything to lose and nothing to gain," Stricker said. "I played very cautiously and tried not to make a mistake. This game is hard when you play that way."

But he did it, becoming the first Illinois alum to capture a senior major.

Quipped Kelly, "I told Steve the rubber match

is in Akron in two weeks."

That's when the Senior Players Championship will be played at Firestone.

Aside from Stricker, the other outstanding performance was turned in by Tom Watson. The 69-year-old matched or broke his age three times in four days, including Sunday's 2-under 68. As golfers go, he's the most ageless player since Sam Snead.


"At this point in my career, I don't know when I'm going to stop playing. But there will be a time when I stop playing, and I can't determine that right now," Watson said.

There's no reason for him to stop.

Said Scott McCarron, "He was literally hitting it right at every single flag. It was one of the most impressive ball-striking rounds I've seen of anybody."

# Mann leads elite sixsome to Illinois Hall

*Esposito, Ziehm, 3 more elected to state golf Valhalla*

**T**he 18th Illinois Golf Hall of Fame class is not only the biggest in more than a decade, it's also one of the best going all the way back to the founding of the Hall in 1989.

How can it not be, when it includes someone already in the World Golf Hall of Fame – that would be Carol Mann – one of the co-founders of the American Society of Golf Course Architects in William Langford, plus one of the game's great promoters in Harry Radix, and in Francis Peabody an industrialist who recognized a need for better organization of the game in the Chicago area.

Oh, and two more fellows who happily are still with us and whose involvement with golf cumulatively covers some 120 years. They are eminent professional Emil Esposito and reporter Len Ziehm, whose presence at a tournament enhances its stature.

The sixsome, formidable on any tee, was elected though the two-stage voting process of the Hall of Fame that culminated on the evening of May 30. They will be inducted in a gala ceremony at The Glen Club, home of the Hall, on Oct. 18.

Only two of the six were known as players, but the Hall of Fame – really, a Hall of Excellence – covers all aspects of the game, not just people who can get up and down from a trash can or sink

25-footers with monomous regularity.

Thus, the selection of a comparative unknown in Peabody or an architect of yesteryear like Langford.

The last cycle with as many as six inductees was 2007, though in that case brothers Robert, James and David Foulis went in as one, so there were only four plaques mounted on the wall of The Glen Club.

One must go back to 1993 to find a class with six individuals. That one also included a notable architect in Robert Bruce Harris, a standout player on the national scene in Virginia Van Wie, and an inspirational character in Gus Bernardoni.

Their current class equivalents are Langford, Mann and Radix. The new group brings the population of the Hall to 91 of Illinois' best and brightest.

Here are short profiles of the six new Hall of Fame members:

## **Emil Esposito**

Emil Esposito parlayed a fine amateur record into a 50-year-plus career as a golf professional, following in the footsteps of his father. One of the first pros to produce a golf instruction video, he won the Illinois Open twice (1966-74) and collected a memorable title in the 1979 Illinois PGA Championship, the first to be held at Kemper Lakes. That led Jim Kemper to hire him away from Mount Prospect Golf Course and to a three-decade career with KemperSports' golf division. Off the course, Esposito is one of the state's better

teachers and perhaps the most enthusiastic promoter of the game today.

### **William Langford**

A leading golf architect long after his playing days, Chicago native William Langford was co-creator with partner Theodore Moreau of several distinguished courses, including Lawsonia Links in Wisconsin, Wakonda in Iowa, Butterfield in the Chicago area and Kankakee Elks downstate. He was a founding member and twice president of the American Society of Golf Course Architects, and a leader in public golf through the USGA, and refining the course rating system. The CDGA eventually took of a number of his ideas, and through the group they spread nationally.

### **Carol Mann**

Educated in golf at Olympia Fields Country Club, Carol Mann became one of the foremost players of her time. After turning pro before her calendar hit 20, would go on to win 38 LPGA Tour tournaments, more than half of them across two amazing years. The gaudy total includes a pair of majors, the 1964 Women's Western Open and the 1965 U.S. Women's Open, the latter the first time a women's tournament was televised. Behind the scenes, Mann was president of the LPGA when it hired its first commissioner, and was the first woman to be a regular TV commentator, notably at NBC. Mann was inducted to the World Golf Hall of Fame in 1977.

### **Francis Peabody**

A century-ago philanthropist who built his fortune in coal and found his escape in golf, Francis Peabody convinced the leaders at Chicago's private clubs to unite to organize tournaments and for the welfare of caddies, prompting the formation of the Chicago District Golf Association in the fall of 1914. With Peabody doing the cajol-

ing and friendly arm-twisting, the CDGA became the leading body of local golf in Chicago, taking over the scheduling and handicapping duties first handled by the WGA.

### **Harry Radix**

More than just golf's No. 1 fan, Harry Radix created the pro tour's original ranking system in 1934 and donated the trophy for the circuit's player of the year. Eventually supplanted by the Vardon Trophy, Radix remained close to the game, and the Radix Cup Match, the annual pros vs. amateurs showcase whose roster is often used by the Hall of Fame committee to weight the merit of nominees, was created to honor him. One

of the few to get close to Ben Hogan, Radix was a supporter of golf locally and nationally, and a world-recognized notable in figure skating.

### **Len Ziehm**

Rare has been the area tournament Len Ziehm has not reported on since 1968, when he covered the Western Open. Spending the bulk of his career at the Chicago Sun-Times, he became known for the depth of his local coverage, as well as weekly reviews of public courses in era when newspapers had space for them, and continues to report for the Daily Herald, Illinois Golfer, and his own website. He also has the best cackle in golf. Hear it on a golf course, and you can't help but smile.

# What firm follows BMW?

## *German automaker's tourney exit no surprise*

The setting was Aronimink Golf Club in Philadelphia last September. While the rain fell incessantly and the BMW Championship – nee Western Open – was slowed, then delayed, some scribes waited for an announcement of a renewal of BMW's deal with the Western Golf Association. With at that time one year left on the contract, the timing for such an extension was right.

No extension came.

None will. BMW is bailing on the WGA after this August's extravaganza at Medinah Country Club, ironically the first one conducted in the new schedule that moved the BMW and the season-ending Tour Championship away from the shadow of the NFL.

After 13 years, the WGA needs a sponsor.

The bad news is executives including John Kaczkowski and Vince Pellegrino, along with WGA directors and PGA Tour brass, have to convince a big company – with a capital B – that sponsoring a golf tournament and spending from \$15 million to \$18 million, counting kicking into the purse, TV commercial time and many tournament trimmings, is worth it on an annual basis.

That's a big ask if a Fortune 500 company's executives and marketing department isn't into sports marketing, and not easy even if they are so attuned.

BMW has been a tremendous sponsor for the

WGA and the Evans Scholars Foundation. Some \$30 million has been raised for the caddies-to-college program through the tournament, one of the reasons the WGA will reach its goal of having 1,000 scholars in college a year early. BMW also donated a scholarship each time a player scored a hole-in-one. A BMW spokesman said the company would still support the tournament.

The good news is the WGA has a tremendous asset to put on the table. After a slow start under the BMW name, corporate suite sales and general ticket revenue picked up. The list of winners in the playoff era is top-notch, including Tiger Woods and Dustin Johnson each on two occasions, and including Rory McIlroy and Justin Rose, plus defending champion Keegan Bradley.

The WGA recently sent out a brochure touting corporate sales for the 2020 edition at Olympia Fields Country Club, referring only to the "PGA Tour FedEx Cup Playoffs."

That was the confirmation of what all who were watching carefully at Aronimink expected, that the name will be different next August.

Pellegrino told the *Chicago Tribune* in late June there are corporate candidates, but how far along negotiations are, and how many firms are being wooed, is unknown. The possibility exists that two sponsors could come on board under a title like, "The XYZ Championship presented by DEF."

Cumbersome, yes, but if the money is there, the Tour and the WGA would jump at it.

## *Scheffler scores ESI title in playoff*

Scottie Scheffler rallied from a six-shot deficit to claim his first Web.com Tour title at the Evans Scholars Invitational on May 30. The Web.com Tour rookie defeated Marcelo Rozo on the second playoff hole at The Glen Club. Scheffler posted a final-round 9-under 63 to force the playoff and drained a 15-foot birdie putt on the second extra hole to capture his first professional win after he and Rozo matched pars on the first OT hole.

"It feels great. It's been a good season so far and it's nice to get my first professional win out here," Scheffler said. "To get the first professional win is awesome, and it kind of gets the monkey off my back. Hopefully, it'll lead to some bigger things to come this year."

Scheffler started the final round six shots behind Rozo, but put the heat on with three birdies in his first five holes. When Scheffler made the turn, the Texas alum caught fire, and recorded birdies on Nos. 10 and 11 (a chip-in) to start his final nine. After a par on No. 12, Scheffler added birdies on Nos. 13, 14, 15 and 17 and was suddenly at the top of the leaderboard. His bogey-free 9-under 63 matched the low round of the day, and tied the course record in relation to par.

"I made an awesome 8-foot putt on No. 15, that was one that really got the momentum going," said Scheffler, who won \$99,000 and clinched his PGA Tour card for 2020.

## Hollis captures last Symetra Decatur

*Zhang beats Wu for Lincoln Land title in playoff*

Maybe it was to be expected, given the Decatur's economy has been stagnant for some time and the biggest employers in town – ADM, Caterpillar, Ameren Illinois, to name three – never really jumped at the chance to support the Symetra (nee Futures) Tour tournament that called Hickory Point Golf Course its home for 35 years.

If they had – if only one of them had stepped up to some degree – perhaps the 35th playing of the Forsyth Classic, which culminated on Father's Day with second-year pro Jillian Hollis capturing the title, wouldn't have been the last one.

The focus would be on how to make the 36th edition better than the 35th. But nobody beyond the associate sponsors pitched in this year, and none of the city's big wheels rose their hand.

As a result, the Symetra Tour's 2020 schedule won't have a Decatur stop. The last time that could be said was 1984. The Decatur-Forsyth Classic started in 1985 and occupied a place in the schedule, and on the calendars of and in the hearts of LPGA hopefuls, from that time forward.

The lack of someone beyond the Decatur Park District and city of Forsyth to back the tournament, which this year boasted a \$200,000 purse,

is the reason why.

Whereas the Quad Cities kept what is now the John Deere Classic alive until the big company came along and guaranteed its future, Decatur

as a community didn't embrace the tournament beyond the golf community itself.

So Hollis is the last winner, and a stylish one. The Ohio native had won the Women's Western

Amateur in 2016, and turned pro after graduating from Georgia. The runner-up in Decatur last year, Hollis' final round 2-under-par 70 this time placed her at 13-under 203 for the 54-hole shoot-out, good for a two-stroke victory over Mind Muangkhumsakul of Thailand, whose closing 67 brought her into contention.

Hollis managed to salvage par at the last after a near-shank off the tee.

"I just took too long to hit it," Hollis said. "I had seen the leaderboard but I wasn't sure if it had been updated and I knew I just had to make a bogey."

Instead, she rolled in a long putt from the fringe to cap off the victory and collect \$30,000. (She was No. 1 on the Symetra money list with over \$92,000 in winnings following a tie for fourth in the Island Resort Championship in Michigan on June 23. If she finishes among the top 10, she'll score an LPGA Tour card for 2020.)

"It's nice to win on a hole like that," Hollis said. "I was so excited to play this year because it is great to play at a golf course you really love and are good at. I loved (Hickory Point) and to finally win after four playoff holes last year is great."

There was a three-way tie for third between Americans Esther Lee and Cydney Clanton and South Korea's Min Seo Kwak at 10-under 206. Clanton was among those needing to play 36 holes on Sunday thanks to a long thunderstorm delay on Saturday. Clanton fired an 8-under 64 on Sunday morning to get into contention but couldn't keep up that pace on what turned into a sweltering Sunday afternoon.

Hollis told the *Decatur Herald & Review* her 70 wasn't exactly by design.

"It looked like I was trying to play conservatively today, but it was just that I kept hitting (ap-

proaches) very far from the pin," Hollis said.

Officials tried to put a brave face on the finale, but the melancholy feeling was obvious. The LPGA, parent tour of the Symetra, awarded Hickory Point and tournament officials a plaque saluting their stewardship of the tournament for a generation and more.

But there will be no more, unless someone steps up to bring what was once tabbed as the major championship on the then-Futures Tour back in the years to come.

### **Zhang defeats Wu in Lincoln Land**

Xinjun Zhang of China is one win away from the PGA Tour. In knocking off Northwestern grad Dylan Wu on the third hole of a sudden-death playoff on Sun., June 16, Zhang scored his second victory on what was still called the Web.com Tour. One more, and he gets an instant promotion to the PGA Tour.

Zhang's a lock for a PGA Tour card next season. The question now isn't if, but when, he'll be there. It sounds as if he'll be ready when he gets there. The outcome moved him to the top of the stepping-stone tour's standings.

"This means a lot," Zhang, 32, told the *State Journal-Register* via caddie-interpreter Yuan Liu after winning the Lincoln Land Championship at Panther Creek Country Club in Springfield. "It kind of confirms that we belong out here, and even on the PGA Tour. The things we're working on, ball striking and putting, it confirms that. It really puts me in a good mindset going onto the Tour next year."

Zhang, playing in the final group, had to rally to match Wu, who was five groups ahead and in the clubhouse as the leader after firing an 8-under-par 63, punctuated by a 12-foot birdie putt at the last, to finish at 15-under 269. Zhang birdied

the par-5 16th to go to 15-under and parred in to force the playoff with a final round of 5-under 66. He birdied three of his final seven holes in regulation.

Each parred the 18th twice in sudden-death, and then went to the ninth hole. Wu missed a birdie putt and Zhang sank his 15-footer for birdie to win.

Wu didn't win nor score the \$99,000 first prize, but finishing second advanced him into the tour's rota. He got into the Springfield tournament as an alternate. He had been slated to tee it up on the Canadian Tour. Now, that's in his rear-view mirror.

"Now I have the rest of the season where I could play on the Web.com," Wu said. "To shoot a 63 today and have a chance to win a tournament coming from behind, it's cool. I learned a lot this week."

Zhang almost won on the first playoff hole, but lipped out a six-footer for birdie.

"I was a little disappointed the putt didn't go in," Zhang said. "I just tried to stay positive. I had a lot of confidence coming into (No. 9) We birdied it three of four days."

A few days later the circuit was renamed the Korn Ferry Tour when the international consulting company replaced the Internet firm as the title sponsor. Some may still call it the Hogan Tour, after the original sponsor, but my any name, Wu is on it.

And Zhang is ready to leave it. First, he went home to California, and he and his wife are about to expand the family.

"This one's really for my wife for holding down the fort at home, going through the difficulties of pregnancy and taking care of our first child," Zhang said. "That adds to today."
