Emory takes Illinois Open on toughened course

The Buzz

\$5 million to new Illini course

There's something about the Illinois golf program that generates unprecedented donations. This summer, the university was handed Stone Creek, the privately-owned public-play layout in Urbana, by the Atkins family that developed it in a real estate venture. The value, including unsold real estate, was estimated at \$15 million.

In mid-September, the university received \$5 million from an anonymous donor to bankroll renovations and other changes to the course, now called the Atkins Golf Club at the University of Illinois, and the clubhouse.

"These funds will allow us to fulfill our vision of making the Atkins Golf Club a championship-caliber home course for our men's and women's golf teams, while at the same time providing an inviting environment and an entertaining experience for our local community – golfers and non-golfer alike," Illinois athletic director **Josh Whitman** said in a statement.

Plans for course tweaks won't be made until the university selects an architect to lead the planning, but basic infrastructure, including irrigation and drainage, are already high on the punch list.

The clubhouse will also get a makeover, including team-specific areas for the Fighting Illini squads and an Illini-themed golf shop.

"The financial support that Illinois golf has garnered over the years continues to humble our program,

and this gift is just another example of how generous and supportive the Illini golf family is," Illinois men's coach **Mike Small** said.

The Atkins family opened Stone Creek in 1999 but kept the course shuttered this year and were planning to turn it into a nature preserve, a plan made before the COVID-19 pandemic turned the golf world upside down. Talks with Illinois commenced and the course was saved. The current plan is to reopen the course in spring 2021, pending the pandemic and when changes can be affected.

FIRST TEE TO WAVELAND: About \$1.5 million in fundraising stands between the First Tee – Greater Chicago and a headquarters facility at Waveland Golf Course – or Marovitz, as members of Sydney J.'s family call it – on Chicago's lakefront.

The capital campaign was launched on Sept. 21, and renovation of the south half of the clubhouse is underway, slated for a spring 2021 opening, or as open as it can be in a pandemic. A specialized outdoor practice area, designed in part by **Luke Donald**, will be ready in spring 2022.

"Investing in our own Chicago home base opens the door to even more opportunities and programming that impacts these incredible kids," Chicago CEO **Lea Jesse** said.

Programs at other golf courses and ranges in the Chicago area will continue.

A Masters in an empty room

This was a different Masters for as many reasons as there are days between April and November.

The season's first men's major became the last. A rite of spring was replaced by fall colors. Bryson DeChambeau probably added 15 yards to his driving average between the seasons.

The *toonimint* created by Bobby Jones and Cliff Roberts looked different, with the golds and browns of autumn replacing the reds and purples of azaleas and sundry other flowers. Even more, it sounded different. When Dustin Johnson pounded big drives and sank critical putts to earn the right to wear the green jacket, he was rewarded by modest applause from those working on Sunday.

It was a Simon and Garfunkel tournament: The sounds of silence. The players and caddies needed to look at the big boards, which were in operation – some things at Augusta are never out of season – to check their status.

Nothing could replace the 40,000-plus who stream in on a daily basis, whether they make noise or not. Amen Corner looked like a ghost town. The 16th hole, vacant. The first tee for honorary starters Jack Nicklaus and Gary Player? Fred Ridley twisted the arms of some members and got a few green jackets out of the breakfast nook. Hey, at least nobody will have to fight traffic.



Club's pocketbook. The place could take the financial hit, especially because their other fiscal underpinnings – television money, both domestic and international, and merchandise – remain in place.

The TV deals are obvious, with the effective time-buy on CBS and ESPN – Augusta selects the sponsors and tells the outlets what they'll show and when they'll show it – continuing. The deals made internationally bring in even more money. An expanded deal with Sky took place in the UK this year, knocking out the BBC after nearly 60 years of live free-to-air broadcasts. (Peter Alliss' last Masters call was made from home, and seen in the UK on tape.) Augusta's

bookkeeper probably spells it \$ky.

The merchandise angle is less obvious but as valuable. Each "patron," as Augusta so quaintly terms the swells and great unwashed who traipse through their gates in a normal April, received a passcode to a special merchandise website the club set up mimicking the massive merchandise center selling everything from shot glasses to shirts to hats to belts to shorts that normally are sold only on site and only, with the exception of members and lucky guests, during Masters week. Each customer could go on the website twice to max out their credit card, and maxing out there surely was.

The rest of us? Well, the Masters site does

have a kiosk for sales of programs, annuals, posters and select photos. That's open year-round. Speaking of programs, Augusta remade their program cover between April and now to reflect both the date and the seasonal look. The U.S. Open and PGA Championship (and our own BMW Championship) didn't even print a program, though the two majors had already created plenty of merchandise and are peddling that on their websites.

In a normal year, it's been estimated, the Augusta golf shops – the second one, behind the fifth green, is usually less crowded – had raked in close to \$1 million an hour in sales. At eight hours a day for seven days, that closes in on \$64 million before costs. There's a healthy profit in there somewhere, and one can imagine that even a quarter of the sales this year will still leave room for a profit. Hey, they didn't even have to turn on the fancy neon signs.

The people to feel sorry for are the regular folks in Augusta, either hired by the club to work for the week, or working in restaurants and collecting extra salary and tips, or renting their houses to visitors for a significant sum for seven days – and free of income tax thanks to a Georgia law. That's where the Masters without a gallery is like a year without a second Christmas. That annual windfall can pay for much of the mortgage, or a college education, or both.

Ideally, in spring, everything will be close to back to normal, thanks to two successful vaccines. Put it this way. Next year's Boston Marathon, another April staple, has already been shoved to next fall, date uncertain. We wouldn't be surprised if the 2021 Masters is also a fall classic, albeit by then with patrons and all the happy buzz they carry in from Washington Road.

Yes, VIRGINIA, there is a Santa Claus. He exists as certainly as love and generosity and devotion exist, and you know that they abound and give to your life its highest beauty and joy. Alas! how dreary would be the world if there

were no Santa Claus. It would be as dreary as if there were no VIRGINIAS. There would be no childlike faith then, no poetry, no romance to make tolerable this existence. We should have no enjoyment, except in sense and sight. The eternal light with which childhood fills the world would be extinguished.

71ST ILLINOIS OPEN

Emory was never bored

Aurora native breaks through to capture state title

Bryce Emory managed to stay in the moment during the final round of the 71st Illinois Open.

The 29-year-old Aurora native had wanted to win the state championship for the longest time.

This was his chance, at White Eagle Golf Club, not far from home.

"This is my 10th appearance, approximately," Emory said. "I turned pro at this in 2013."

Funny how you remember those things when so much is on the line.

Emory opened Wednesday, Aug. 5, as the leader by four strokes. He closed the day as the leader by four strokes, and the champion.

There was more drama than the above paragraph may suggest. At one point, the lead evaporated, the result of bogeying both par 5s on the front while Ethan Brue of downstate Ashland played the first five holes in 2-under-par.

The tie at 5-under didn't last long. Brue was making a dog's breakfast of the par-4 seventh. Suffice it to say he one-putted for a quadruple-bogey 8 after dunking his third shot in a pond.

Meanwhile, Emory birdied the ninth and 10th holes to climb to 7-under and out of anyone's reach. The back nine was effectively a parade for the mini-tour veteran, with a \$19,928 reward at the end of the trail.

He dropped a 115-yard wedge shot two feet from the cup on No. 9 and sank a 7-foot down-

hill putt for a birdie on No. 10. Another birdie on the par-4 14th, where his approach into the right green side bunker negated a maddening pin placement, sealed the deal.

Emory hit 13 fairways and 15 greens en route to his 1-under-par 71 for a total of 8-under 208. He could almost coast home after the birdies on

the ninth and 10th holes.

"A little bit," Emory allowed. "I knew I was swinging it well. I know after I two-putted the 16th hole, I was in good shape."

The four-stroke victory is a rout in golf terms, and matches the margin David Cooke had over Nick Hardy last year at The Glen Club.

"It's definitely my biggest win so far," said Emory, with proud father and caddie Bob steps away.

The whole Emory family seemed to be out for what he termed a home game. The gallery of around 400, the largest for a local competition in years, was swelled by White Eagle members and various Emorys.

Jack Korzon of Downers Grove didn't win, but coming in second after lurking for two days was a success for the 24-year-old budding pro. He's trying the mini tours in his second summer after graduating from Lewis University. The \$12,455 he won this week is his biggest check as a pro.

"I've been trying hard for a couple of years and I think I made a breakthrough today," Korzon said.

The centerpiece of his 3-under 69 for 4-under 212 was an eagle on the par-5 17th, which moved him a stroke ahead of Charlie Netzel and Tim "Tee-K" Kelly.

"I've been digging deep," Korzon said. "It's tough out there, week-in, week-out."

Netzel and Kelly know that. Kelly his his opening tee shot out of bounds, scrambling for a bogey and settled for par 72. Netzel had three birdies and an eagle – like Korzon, on the 17th – and also was stuck at 72. Golf can be hard.

Emory knows that. He's bounced between mini tours and differing forms of status on low-

er-level PGA Tour-affiliated circuits, but still longs for hitting the big time. Wednesday, he had something of a taste of what the stars have. People were there to see him. The last time that happened?

"Probably never," Emory said. "I've played in U.S. Open sectionals with PGA Tour pros, but people were there to see the guys."

On this day, he was the guy.

That Emory and the rest were able to compete at all in the middle of the COVID-19 pandemic

is a tribute to the hard work of the Illinois PGA Section, which has run the Illinois Open since the mid-1970s.

Where other golf groups canceled longstanding fixtures on the schedule, the Illinois PGA, led by executive director Carrie Williams, managed to keep all four of its state majors on the revamped slate, and in the case of the Illinois Open, even managed to stage qualifying rounds.

But until a few weeks before, given the varying stages of quarantine Illinois was going through.

"I would say very close," Williams said of the possibility of not playing. "We were looking at precedent around the country, in other states that opened up before Illinois did."

"We were very concerned, trying to project what phase we would be in. And not only for the golf but the other elements that make the players feel welcome."

"We made the determination we could condense the championship to one site, have it highly-staffed and administer it in a way that would be safe for the field."

The original plan was to follow the two-site format of the last few years, with an expanded field of about 250 alternating their first two rounds at two courses, with the survivors playing the final round at White Eagle. The logistics of the pandemic made that impossible, so Stonebridge Country Club in Aurora took a rain check for a future year and a standard-sized field of 156 played at White Eagle, whose membership was as enthusiastic as any group of club members in memory to host a state-only tournament.

The usual large player hospitality area, a hangout with a buffet, was split into rooms that hold no more than 50 people to adhere to state

guidelines, and the buffet is gone. White Eagle members had their own tent, placed well off the 17th fairway to watch the action, with closed-circuit television of eight holes.

All that allowed something close to a normal three-day tournament.

Even before the confusion, White Eagle's membership wanted a memorable Open. When it agreed to host, club brass and the Illinois PGA agreed to set up the course hard.

"It wasn't what is the Illinois Open going to do for us, it's what can we do to make it better," director of golf Curtis Malm said. "Rarely do we get a club that really opens their club."

The membership has embraced this championship," Williams said, noting a large volunteer corps from the membership. "It's been really refreshing and positive how the membership has gotten behind this event."

Thus, superintendent Jeff Cameron had let the rough grow to four inches by the Friday before, and the rough kept growing. Cameron had gotten green speeds to as high as 13 on the Stimp-meter in the past, which will make putting on the undulating surfaces challenging.

The club showed off the renovation of the original Arnold Palmer-Ed Seay design by Todd Quitno of Lohmann-Quitno Design, which involved lowering the number of bunkers at the 27-hole complex from 81 to 56 and placing them where hackers usually won't find them but fine players might.

"The positioning is ideal for championship golf," Malm said. "This is the championship event for Illinois, and we need to make it as hard and fair as possible."

The field averaged 73.72 strokes, with both the first and 16th holes averaging a half-stroke

over par. The par-5 14th, with a treacherous pin position that saw many approaches and a few putts roll over the green into a collection area, averaged 4.80 strokes. "That pin was awful today," Emory said. "The bunker might have been the best place to be."

99TH ILLINOIS PGA To repeat: Mike Small wins a major

Illinois coach's 63 on Medinah No. 1 key to 13th section title

Mike Small almost went full Caddy-Shack in the final round of the 99th Illinois PGA Championship at Medinah Country Club.

He didn't say, "Be the ball," but "Be in the present" was close enough, and it worked.

Keeping his mind on business throughout the final round on Medinah No. 1, Small fired a 3-under-par 68 on Wednesday, Aug. 26, scoring a four-stroke victory over Mistwood pros Frank Hohenadel and Andy Mickelson.

Small's total of 200 was 13 under par for three rounds on No. 1, and that's fitting. It was Small's record-extending 13th Illinois PGA title.

"It doesn't get old and it doesn't get easier," Small said. "It's been a while since I've won. It feels good to contend."

Small led Mickelson and Hohenadel by a stroke entering the final round, birdied the first two holes – the first hole even after plunking his tee shot into a fairway bunker – and was never headed. The Mistwood duo scored matching par 71s, but treading water wasn't going to cut it with Small going under par for a third straight round, especially after a second-round 63 vaulted him into the lead.

That round proved impossible to duplicate, and Small, perfectionist that he is, tried to.

"I didn't hit it good, but I competed and a putted really good today," Small said.

He also stayed in the moment, unlike, by his admission, last year's final round at Ruth Lake, where he squandered a five-stroke lead on the back nine and opened the door for Medinah director of instruction Travis Johns to win. That was a lesson learned.

"I didn't look at the scoreboard until the 18th tee, so I didn't know (the status)," Small said. "I didn't get wrapped up in the score. ... I knew they were close. ... I was nervous. I was indecisive a couple times, then reminded myself to stay in the moment and be decisive."

He was. His only bogey was on the fifth hole. Small added birdies on the 10th and 13th holes to the opening brace and otherwise kept it in play, forcing his challengers to take chances.

Mickelson was two strokes back until a trio of birdies beginning at the 13th hole ended his hopes. He birdied the 17th and 18th to draw even with Hohenadel, who bogeyed the 17th.

"He just played a normal round of golf, and Frank and I had our hiccups," Mickelson said. "At the most critical time, I had bogeys in the wrong spots. Mike did exactly when he needed to do, came out strong early. That puts you in a spot

where you're playing catch-up."

Mickelson's birdie on No. 7 tied him with Small, but a three-putt bogey on No. 9 dropped him back a stroke, and Small's birdie on No. 10 made it two strokes.

Hohenadel's birdie on No. 11 pulled him within two, but Small answered with a birdie on No. 13 and that was that.

"Mike played solid, did his thing, and I didn't take advantage of my opportunities," Hohenadel said. "I wasn't aggressive on my putts."

Johns was fourth at 6-under 207, with Roy Biancalana of Blackberry Oaks fifth at 3-under 210. Chris Green of Glen View Club had the round of the day, a 4-under 67, to finish sixth at 1-under 212. Nobody else was under or at par.

Small's course record 8-under 63 was typical of his high standard. It was his third 63 in Illinois PGAs, equaling the 9-under 63 at Stonewall Orchard in 2007 and the 8-under 63 on Olympia Fields' South Course in 2010.

"I thought I had more than that," Small said.

No, but nobody else has more than one.

It was a competitive course record by three strokes – and matched the 63 punched in by member Tim "Tee-K" Kelly in a casual round on No. 1 a few years ago.

Small needed every one of his six birdies – plus an eagle – to take the lead over Mickelson and Hohenadel.

Out in the day's third group, Small took advantage of negligible wind and eagled the first hole via a 230-yard 2-iron to six feet, then birdied the next two holes, the start of an opening nine that featured only eight putts. That's eight one-putts and a chip-in to save par on No. 9. On the back, he had three birdies and six pars, with 15 putts for a total of 24 for the round.

It could have been better, of course. With golfers, it can always be better. Small noted lipping out a birdie putt on the 15th hole, coming close on the 11th and 18th, and failing to hit the par-5 17th green in two. Instead, he had a 50-yard bunker shot, but managed to scramble for par.

"But I'm happy," Small said. "I needed that. Best round of the year? Yeah."

Best week of the year, too.

Sluzas scores hat trick of sorts

Captures Illinois Junior to go with two IHSA titles

It was the one thing missing from Ben Sluzas's in-state resume. After twice winning the individual IHSA Championship in Class 3A, he needed an Illinois Junior, the all-encompassing state title sponsored by the Illinois Junior Golf Association, to check the remaining box.

That was accomplished in dramatic fashion on Aug. 13, when Sluzas eagled the final hole at Makray Memorial Golf Course to finish at even-par 213 in the 51st renewal of the championship, then saw Dominic Scaletta double-bogeyed it to fall to 2-over 215.

Sluzas' 3 and Scaletta's 7 flipped the first two positions, thrilling the Northern Illinois-bound winner from Lockport and stunning Scaletta, the Inverness native who was eighth in the Illinois Junior two years ago and was, like Sluzas, taking his last shot at lifting the Slovitt Cup.

The final round was something of a last man standing affair. Tyler Greenspan of Winnetka had opened the three-day feast of golf with a 5-under 66, and continued to lead on the back nine of the final round.

Then came the par-4 16th, and disaster in the form of a quadruple-bogey 8. It was followed by

a bogey on the par-4 17th knocked him out of contention. He finished third at 3-over 216 with closing 78.

Greenspan's collapse was to Scaletta's benefit, at least briefly. Scaletta had bounced around the front nine in 4-over 39, but birdies on the sixth and eighth provided a hint better things were ahead.

For the first eight holes of the back nine, they occurred. He birdied the 10th and 12th, and then birdied the par-5 15th. He was in the final group with Greenspan, and Greenspan quadruply-bogeyed on the 16th gave Scaletta the lead.

Then came the last, a 555-yard dogleg-right par 5 with water on the inside corner and trouble afoot to the left as well. Whereas Sluzas' hitting the green in two and sinking the eagle putt was glorious, Scaletta's stumble to a double-bogey was a disaster. Second place was suddenly so far from first.

This was Sluzas' fourth appearance in the Illinois Junior. He tied for seventh last year.

Finishing fourth was John Wild of Glen Ellyn, at 4-over 217. Rounding out the top five were Rockford's Marcus Smith and Thomas Baker, each finishing at 5-over 218.

The IJGA was able to play the Illinois Junior a month late, rearranging its schedule through the generosity of Makray's management.

Coody triumphs

Knocks off Dane for first major amateur title

Pierceson Coody has a memorable name. Not everybody one encounters is named Pierceson, for one thing, and a Coody involved in golf indicates a certain pedigree.

Such is the case with Mr. Coody. He hails from Plano, Texas, is the grandson of 1971 Masters winner Charles Coody, and plays up to his pedigree. That was clear in early August, where he survived the five-day grind known as the Western Amateur to win the 118th edition of the championship, the first played in a pandemic for a century.

Because of the precarious health situation, spectators were not allowed at Crooked Stick Golf Club, the Pete Dye-designed course that has hosted a pair of BMW Championships, the PGA Championship won by John Daly, and a U.S. Women's Open, but whose members are equally

crazy for amateur golf.

That's a shame, for Coody, a 20-year-old junior at Texas, put on a show in beating 21-year-old Dane Rasmus Neergaard-Petersen, of the Copenhagen Neergaard-Petersens, in scoring a 2-and-1 victory in the championship match.

He had birdied the first hole and never trailed. He finished Neergaard-Petersen off on the 17th by making par. Coody's tee shot on the par-3 17th found the right rough, but his 20-foot par-saver to pressured Neergaard-Petersen to make his 5-footer for par to get the match to the last. He missed.

"That's match play," Coody said. "His putt became a lot longer and a lot harder. He knew if he missed, it's the end of the game."

Coody's biggest previous victory was in last year's Trans-Miss Amateur.

"It's definitely a steppingstone, and it feels so good," Coody said. "It was such a tough test. The pins in the afternoon were absolutely brutal. The course is so punishing if you miss it in the wrong spots. But I had a lot of consistent play. That was the key."

Coody had qualified with a 4-under-par 284 in the grind, tying for 10th in the Sweet Sixteen. He beat Alexander Yang of Carlsbad, Calif., in the Round of 16, closing him out on the 17th hole. He had an easier time in Friday afternoon's quarterfinal match against Connor Creasy of Abingdon, Va., a 5 and 4 closeout.

Virginia freshman George Dunagmanee of Fairfax, Va., was a tougher customer in Saturday morning's semifinal, but Coody prevailed, 1 up, largely via an eagle on the par-5 15th, which tied a match he had trailed throughout. The eagle shook Dunagmanee, Coody parred the 16th for the lead, and advanced to the final against Neergaard-Petersen, who needed three extra holes to dispose

of Ricky Castillo of Yorba Linda, Calif., the second-ranked amateur on the planet. The Dane was 3 up at the turn and then withstood a Castillo rally to extend the match.

The victory was the seventh by a Texas Longhorn in the Western Am. Coody joins an elite group that includes Ben Crenshaw and Justin Leonard, as well as Cole Hammer, whose victory in 2018 came before he went to Austin for his freshman year.

Although he led from start to finish, Coody's biggest lead in the final was just 2 up, first following a par at No. 6 and then after a par at No. 14. Neergaard-Petersen, a junior at Oklahoma State and the 194th-ranked player, won No. 16 with a

par to cut the lead to 1 up. But he three-putted the 17th for a bogey to lose, and he made only one birdie in the final.

"It was a great week, and my game is trending in the right direction," Neergaard-Petersen said. "Making it to match play was the goal. Making it to the final was really nice."

Neergaard-Petersen, who won the 2018 and 2019 German International Amateur, was the first Dane to qualify for the Sweet 16 since Sebastian Cappelen did it in 2013 at The Alotian Club in Roland, Arkansas.

It was the first Western Am in Indiana since 1951 (South Bend Country Club), and the first in the metro Indianapolis area.

Sixty-six-footer finishes Johnson in playoff

Yes, Jon Rahm really made that putt.

Yes, he did so after Dustin Johnson made that other putt.

And when Johnson, whose 43-foot 3-inch putt snaked into the 18th hole on the final hole of regulation, tying Rahm at 4-under-par 276, couldn't make a 33-footer to equal Rahm's unfathomable 66-foot 5-inch birdie putt on the first hole of sudden death, the world's No. 2 player had defeated the world's No. 1 player to capture the 117th Western Open / BMW Championship on Olympia Fields Country Club's North Course.

Even now, some months after the Aug. 30 finish of the tournament and the putt that had to be seen to be disbelieved, the replays don't lie. The legend grows with every showing.

It came down to the world's top two during a final round in which the wind laid down, the course was marginally more yielding to scoring – and still played over par as a whole – and five players, the only five to finish under par, had an opportunity to win the title.

Tony Finau had a shot, closing in 5-under 30 to post a 5-under 65, the second-best score of the

week, but needed others to falter and ended up solo fifth at 1-under 279.

Hideki Matsuyama was right there, opening the final round tied with Johnson for the lead and hanging around until the end, finishing tied for third at 2-under 278.

Joaquin Niemann was there as well, climbing into a share of the lead with four birdies on the front nine, but managing no birdies, plus adding a bogey, in the final 10 holes. He matched Matsuyama at 278 and jumped into the top 30 to qualify for the following week's Tour Championship.

That left Rahm, from Spain by way of Arizona State, and Johnson, from South Carolina by way of Coastal Carolina, that football powerhouse, to duel down the stretch. They just happened to be the top two players in the world ranking, Johnson marginally ahead, and bubbled up to the top of the scoreboard by virtue of equal measures of talent and tenacity.

Rahm was two groups ahead of Johnson, and thus in the clubhouse first after a bogey-free 64 that allowed him a few moments to contemplate victory before Johnson forced him back to the range and then back to the tee.

Johnson, seeking a third title in the BMW, had birdied three of the first four holes to take a commanding lead, then faltered with bogeys on the eighth and 10th before rallying with a two-putt birdie from 32 feet on the par-5 15th and his left-to-right-to-left downhill putt at the last that Olympia members will be trying and failing to recreate, along with Rahm's, for the next century or so.

That center-cut anaconda for 3-under 67 was witnessed by millions on NBC and maybe three dozen volunteers hanging around the 18th green on the final day of the no-spectator spectacle.

That was the unfortunate part of the week, and typical of a year where the U.S. was the clubhouse leader in failing to get the COVID-19 pandemic under control. The winners were the players, who earned every cent of the \$9.5 million purse. But the Evans Scholars Foundation, which has reaped \$36 million since BMW drove up to sponsor the Western Open in 2007 (including \$4.4 million at Medinah in 2019), saw only \$800,000 land in their coffers. Not having fans, from the well-heeled in luxury suites, to the regular punter buying a daily ticket, will do that.

Back to the 18th tee he and Rahm went, and both made the 498-yard par-4 green in two, Johnson, at 33 feet distant and about pin-high, seemingly having the upper hand on Rahm, whose

drive went into the right rough. The approach, with little spin on it, hit the green and rolled to the back left, cater-corner from the cup on the front right.

Rahm looked at it from every angle. Sane people thought just two-putting from 66 feet, down and across a two-tier slope that dropped two feet, would be an achievement.

No. That would have been failure in comparison to the reality of Rahm's perfectly-paced sweeping putt that swung right and disappeared, taking with it Johnson's heart.

"That stretch of waiting for DJ, him making the putt, going in the playoff, me making the putt, then trying to stay mentally in it just in case he made the last putt, it's been a roller coaster but so

much fun," Rahm said. "I certainly don't want the stress that goes along with seeing DJ's ball in the fairway and then my ball in the rough and he hits it to 30 feet, I hit it to 60 and what's going on in my mind, but if you're going to tell me I'm going to make a 66 footer to win a tournament I'll take that any day."

He was just trying to set up a short uphill par putt, or so Rahm tells it.

"I grew up on golf courses with a lot of slope, so putts with slope is something I enjoy, I like and I'm comfortable reading and putting," he said. "It fell right in my alley. It was at least 66 feet, so making it, it's a whole different story."

"You can always break it into different parts. When I first stood behind the ball I could see the first two-thirds or three-fourths more or less of the putt were pretty much steady left to right break, and then you get to the big slope, to the top of that hill and it's going to start quick right and then at the end it's going to start turning left towards the pin."

"That's what I saw, and when I'm walking around the hole I'm basically going to the apex or the highest peak of break that I'm going to play and kind of see the ball track from there and try to find a spot, and then when I go back to the ball, I laser on that spot and really make sure I'm putting there and track the ball the way I'm supposed to."

"For people that have seen the movie 'The Legend of Bagger Vance,' that 18th putt, you can kind of see the light of how the putt is supposed to go. It is somewhat like that. That's how I feel. I kind of visualize the ball rolling like that. So if you had to ask me, yes, the putt was 60 feet but I was trying to hit a spot maybe 30 feet away at most, 30, 40 feet away."

This is where the smart golf writer would

Now Johnson had to make his to go back to the tee. A fine roll it was, but came up about four inches short and right.

"I thought I made it when it was coming down the hill," Johnson said. "It just kind of ran out of a little bit of speed and missed just low."

No. 2 had beaten No. 1 in most dramatic fashion. In the history of the Western Open / BMW, there have been many playoffs, but Rahm's putt is the longest one to win in the history of the cham-

pionship on the 72nd hole or beyond. Johnson called it "an even more ridiculous putt" than the 43-footer he made to force the playoff, and nobody argued the point.

Rahm was the steadier player of the two on Sunday, hitting 11 of 14 fairways and 17 greens. Johnson hit nine fairways and 12 greens, two wayward shots leading to his only bogeys.

Once upon a time – say, when he was finishing ninth in the 2015 Fighting Illini Invitational or advancing to the quarterfinals of that year's U.S. Amateur, both times on Olympia North – Rahm had a deserved reputation as a hothead. Not now. He was cool from start to finish at Olympia, even when shooting 5-over 75 on Thursday, in annexing his second win of the year, following a triumph at The Memorial in July. (That 75 is the highest opening score for a winner in a Western / BMW since 1926, when Walter Hagen scored 75 and went on to win at Highland Golf and Country Club in Indianapolis.)

Rahm said after winning that the fiasco of forgetting to mark a putt on Saturday's fifth hole served as accidental inspiration to play better.

"I don't know if I would have won had it not happened," Rahm said. "It kind of made me mad at myself, and I just went on with my focus after that and was able to play amazing golf and stayed aggressive. Maybe if I hadn't I would have two-putted and maybe stayed complacent."

The penalty created a bogey. It was the 10th and last of his week. He played the final 31 holes of regulation in 9-under. Then came the 66-footer for a final birdie, and a finish that will be remembered forever.

Hail and farewell, Calumet

Venerable club's sale final; industrial development planned

Calumet Country Club was formed in 1901 and moved from the south side of Chicago – the Calumet area – to Homewood in 1920, owners of a fine Donald Ross-designed course that would host happy

members and delighted guests, as well as more than a few memorable moments, for a year more than a century.

Now, Calumet's doors are closed. The group of members who bought the club from the general membership and out of foreclosure in an effort to keep it alive recently closed on a sale of the prop-

erty to Diversified Partners of Scottsdale, Ariz., for \$3.3 million. Diversified also paid off approximately \$500,000 in back taxes.

Diversified bought the property, 127 acres at 175th and Western Ave., adjacent to the Tri-State Tollway, to build a logistics center that would encompass four buildings totaling 800,000 square

feet. A portion of the western edge of the property could remain green space.

This is not a situation where Calumet will remain open to members until building begins. This is it. The closing is permanent.

Much of the kitchen, dining room and other clubhouse equipment was auctioned off in early December via online bids. Cups for a few dollars, flat-screen televisions for \$42 and up, pots and pans for \$5 or a bit more. For about \$120, you could have gotten a lifetime of matching silverware. We have no idea who won the stuffed toy bunny, hammered down for \$7.

Thus ends a 120-year history of golf in two locations, a heritage in Homewood highlighted by "Wild" Bill Mehlhorn's victory in the 1924 Western Open and Byron Nelson's winning the Chicago Victory Open in 1945, one of the 11 straight tournaments Lord Byron captured in his amazing run. Nelson returned to Calumet in 2000, when the club celebrated its centennial.

The course has changed over the years. When the Tri-State came through in 1957 – cutting into club property at the behest of Stone Container tycoon Clement Stone, if you believe the tale – seven holes were lost. Larry Packard and Brent Wadsworth needed to remodel five more to keep an 18-hole course in the Ross style. The revamping took two years.

Membership was strong for decades, but the club was hit hard by the reversals in the steel industry and economic turndown in the south sub-

urbs in the 1990s. The Great Recession of 2007 dealt it another blow. Membership plummeted, and while the club rebounded for a time with new policies – the last of which was opening to the public on a limited basis this year – debts began to pile up. A group of members thought they could turn it around, and did not.

Now the battle is with the village of Homewood over zoning and potential de-annexation, as well as the final use of the property. That has annoyed Diversified CEO Walt Brown Jr., who has tried to work with the village for months while negotiating the purchase.

"We've been at this two years, and we're all out of categories," Brown told the *Chicago Sun-Times* of the plans he's developed to replace the course. "We're trying to do the right thing."

Village officials want "reasonable develop-

ment," Homewood village manager Jim Marino told the *Sun-Times*.

The dispute over de-annexation has ended up in Cook County court. Meanwhile, a golf course is closed, everything that could be sold in the clubhouse has been auctioned off, and the potential for 800 to 1,000 permanent jobs lies in the balance. Brown believes the new development would generate \$1.5 million in property tax revenue annually.

Medinah gets 2026 Presidents Cup

Maybe the 2026 Presidents Cup will be the one the American team wins at Medinah Country Club. The big west side club, host of the dramatic comeback of the Europeans in the 2012 Ryder Cup, will host the U.S. vs. International encounter in six years.

"The club is excited about providing a terrific venue for the teams and fans from around the world to experience one of the premier events on golf's biennial calendar," said Michael Scimo, Medinah's 2026 Presidents Cup bid leader.

Before that, the often-altered course will be tweaked again. The Australian design trio of Geoff Ogilvy, Mike Cocking and Ashley Mead will put their hand to the 1920s Tom Bendelow design.

"Course 3 is laid out over some terrific ground for golf. It's a beautiful canvas for us to get the chance to work with," Cocking told *The Fried Egg* website.

Olympia Fields renovation imminent

The timetable isn't set, but the planned renovation of Olympia Fields' South Course, headed by Andy Staples, will be extensive. While most of the land was originally wooded, the plan is to remove several hundred trees on the rolling land from the clubhouse south.

BMW Championship Notes

It's almost like Monopoly money to the players, but **Jon Rahm** earned \$1,710,000 from the \$9.5 million purse. **Dustin Johnson** earned \$1,026,000 as balm for finishing second. ... **Mackenzie Hughes** made the top 30 and earned a trip to East Lake next week along with **Joaquin Niemann**. They knocked out **Adam Long** and Winfield's **Kevin Streelman**. ... The final round scoring average was 70.319. Every round

played over the par of 70, with the four-day average 71.815 strokes. Eight holes were under par on Sunday, including both par 5s. The third hole was hardest for the day, while the 18th was the toughest test across the week. Don't tell that to Rahm, whose birdie in the playoff made him even on the hole in five attempts, or Johnson, who was 2-under on it. ... Rahm's 51 greens hit in regulation for the week ranked second for the week, behind only Niemann's 53. ... **Matthew Fitz-**

patrick, who spent a semester at Northwestern before turning pro, was a pair of double-bogeys (one Thursday, one Friday) from tying for the lead. ...

Saturday, **Corey Conners** aced the 150-yard sixth hole with a 9-iron. "It was just fighting to work its way to the left, landed just right of the pin, short of the green, got a good bounce and started rolling toward the hole," Conners said. "I was kind of stretching a 9-iron for me to get it to the green there." It was the eighth of his career and first on the big circuit. ...

The BMW was played the week the NBA and NHL took two-day breaks in their playoffs to protest police violence against blacks, but the PGA Tour played on.

... "It didn't really cross my mind," said **Tony Finau** of not playing. "But I understood the magnitude of what the NBA was doing and what they were boycotting for, and I know the PGA Tour is in full support of that. It's a conversation that's uncomfortable, sensitive for our country, but if we're not willing to have those, I don't think we can move forward as a country." Said **Tiger Woods**, "We're all on board, on the same page." ...

Cameron Champ, who like Finau and Woods is biracial, wore one black shoe and one white shoe to display his feelings. "It's part of me, it's part of my family," Champ said. "I think it's a good thing we're all talking about it, because again, it's what needs to happen for change to happen." ...

Next year, the tournament goes out of town again, to Caves Valley Golf Club near Baltimore, Md. It's the second trip to mid-Atlantic area in four years, following the jaunt to Aronimink near Philadelphia in 2018. And 2022 will make it three in five, when the BMW visits the DuPont Country Club – where incoming president Joe Biden is a member – in Wilmington, Del.
